FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

Amelia Baptist Family,

"And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers." (Roman 8:28-29)

If you've ever ridden a roller coaster, you know how intense the experience can be. At the beginning there is great anticipation for what lies ahead. But as the coaster plummets down the first big drop, your stomach feels lodged in your throat and the sharp turns jar your body from side to side. You feel helpless as you are at the will of this machine coursing along the tracks. As a child, I can remember my first ride and wanting nothing more than for the wheels to stop so I could get off and onto stable ground. Well beloved, for many of us 2020 has felt like an endless roller coaster. In just 12 months the world was thrust into a global pandemic and our country came face to face with political, social, and economic unrest. For the most part travel has been at an all-time low and we've become well acquainted with the walls inside of our homes. This recipe has made us all weary and long for the year to come to a close. We have desperately wanted the chaos to stop and to step onto stable ground. So, here we are in 2021; a New Year with new hopes. But even as we start 2021, we are reminded that we are still in the throes of this season. So, it begs the question, what good can come from this? How are we to endure yet another year of struggle? How are we to understand what we've been through thus far? Well, in all of this, I'm thankful that our God has an answer for each of these questions.

In the Apostle Paul's "magnum opus" letter, Romans, he sought to unpack the depth of the gospel in all of its beauty. He wanted the Christians in Rome to not only understand all that went into Christ's crucifixion and resurrection, but he also wanted them to grasp how exactly this gospel transforms and helps us to persevere when all seems dark around us. And at the heart of this letter, in chapter 8, Paul shares a truth that we must cling to as we look back on the hardships of 2020 and to the uncertainties of what lies ahead in 2021. He says that for those who love God and have been called by Him (believers), God works all things for their good. Did you catch that? Paul said "all things".

He did not say "some things" or "only those things that make us feel comfortable." Rather, he said "all things." This means that God will use both the seasons of hardship and ease, of lack and plenty, of pain and health for our ultimate good. This means that God does not waste the seasons of life on you nor does He haphazardly bring them about. There is always a purpose for God's work. Now what is that purpose? And what does Paul mean by the word "good?" In verse 29, Paul continues his thought by making clear that God saved us so that we would be conformed to the image of His Son. Another way to put it is that God will use any and all means to make you more like Christ. He will use pandemics, social-political-economic unrest, the weather patterns, painful days, and even death to root out the idols that reside in your heart. But He will also use birthdays, anniversaries, the birth of a child, a vacation, the holidays, a walk in the warm sunshine, a financial blessing, or good food to remind us that all things flow from His gracious hand. You see, God works ALL THINGS for your good so that you would grow in godliness. Isn't that an amazing thought? Your Father in heaven, is always acting with His children in mind. That is nothing but pure love. This truth is simply astounding and one that provides us a foundation of stability and one to persevere when life is at its hardest.

So beloved, with all sincerity, Happy New Year! Our God has used the last 12 months to grow us and He will use the next to do the very same thing until we see Him face to face. Praise God for His sovereign and fatherly care!
