- Efficiency Upgrades Referrals can be made to Efficiency Nova Scotia.



Housing Services – Eligibility

- Ownership and Tenancy Status
- Previous Assistance
- Type of Repairs
- Total Household Income
 - One Bedroom \$57,500 (individual or couple)
 - Two Bedroom \$66,000 (individual or couple + one other)
 - Three Bedroom \$78,000 (individual or couple + two others)



Housing Services – Considerations

- Applicants are required to engage the contractor(s) of their choosing.
- The relationship for the completion of repair work is between the applicant and the contractor.
- Housing Services performs inspections for program compliance only.
- You may be required to contribute if the cost exceed program funding.
