Profile of an IC4A Champion - Cover Story:

Rob Pendergist, Mt. St. Mary's Perennial Pentathlete

Most people in attendance this weekend will be looking to see if Mount Saint Mary's College senior Rob Pendergist will win his fourth consecutive IC4A pentathlon championship.

Most people, that is, but one. And that person is Pendergist himself.

The Ellsworth, Maine native, who has earned NCAA All-America honors in the decathlon and qualified for a berth in last summer's Olympic Trials, is approaching this competition as he does all others, and that approach has nothing to do with winning and losing.

"I have never competed in a pentathlon or a decathlon where my goal was to win it," Pendergist said. "Before each competition, I set a number to shoot for, and if I score that number, I am happy. If that number is good enough for the first place, all the better, but if it isn't, I am still thrilled to death."

It is precisely that competitor-against-himself mentality that has endeared Pendergist to the multi-events.

Originally a jumper, he literally stumbled upon the event in high school after spraining an ankle his junior season. Sideline from the jumps, he began running sprints and middle distance events. From there, a friend suggested he try the multi-events.

After a few meets and a lot of success, Pendergist realized that he may have found his niche.

When you experience success at anything, you tend to want to do it again," he said. "but beyond that, I really liked the fact that it didn't matter what anyone else did. If I didn't score well, it was because I didn't perform well; I had no one else to blame."

Pendergist was a scholastic All-America at Ellsworth High School where he won the national pentathlon championship with 3,837 points. He was named Maine's Outstanding Track Athlete his senior year after collecting 12 state titles in seven different events during his career.

Recruited by most of the major collegiate track powers in the country, Pendergist and his father sought the advice of none other than decathlon great Bruce Jenner. Though they never did speak with Jenner, his agent recommended that they take a look at Mount Saint Mary's. The Mount, which had just moved from NCAA Division II to Division I, had a rich tradition established in the multi-events. When Pendergist arrived in the fall of 1989, the Mount boasted a list of nine decathletes who had scored over 7,000 points in their careers, including Bill Motti '85, who was at one-time the collegiate record-holder in the event.

Taking the advice, Pendergist visited the Emmitsburg campus and immediately fell in love with its small size and its legendary track coach Jim Deegan.

"I'm a small-town person, and the Mount's size is perfect for me. I've gotten to know all my professors, and the people throughout the school are genuinely nice people.

"And athletically, I have had one of the greatest coaches in the country," he added. "I couldn't have asked for anything more."

Pendergist and Deegan have developed a special bond, one that the understudy says is more friendship than anything else.

"The thing about Coach Deegan," Pendergist said, "is that he gives you the freedom to make your own decisions. I can set my own goals, and he is there to assist me in reaching them. He doesn't put any pressure on me, rather he gives me the responsibility and with that the room to grow."

It is that approach which Pendergist believes makes Deegan a great multi-event coach. "Most people who compete in the multi's know what they need to do. It is such a demanding sport that you don't find too many prima donas; most of the guys have

a true understanding of what it takes to be successful. Coach Deegan may understand that more than anybody.

"You can say he has had a lot of great athletes in his program," he added, "but when you look more closely, you realize that each and every one of them got better under him."

As a freshman, Pendergist won the IC4A pentathlon with 3,945 points. He entered the 1,000 meter race needing to win by more than six seconds, and he won by seven. In the decathlon, he posted the best score among all collegiate freshman, and though he reached the provisional qualifying score, he missed the NCAA standard by 29 points.

Plagued by illnesses and injuries in his sophomore season, Pendergist managed to win the IC4A pentathlon by 250 points. That spring, he won the IC4A decathlon with 7,540 points and qualified for the NCAA Championships. The NCAA meet was his fourth of the spring, and he was forced to the sidelines due to tendinitis in his left ankle.

Last year the pieces began to fall together. Pendergist won his third straight IC4A pentathlon with 4,030 points, and he opened up the outdoor season by winning the decathlon at the prestigious Florida Relays. He again qualified for the NCAA Championship and this time placed seventh with 7,875 points to earn All-America recognition. The score was also good enough to qualify him for his ultimate goal, the Olympic Trials in New Orleans where he finished 17th.

And his senior year opened with a bang when he won the pentathlon at the Princeton Relays, breaking Motti's Eastern Collegiate record by a point.

"I really like the pentathlon," Pendergist said. "It's primarily a speed event to get yourself fit for the outdoor season, but it's only one day. After you compete, you don't have to go back to your room and even think about coming back out the next day."

What lies ahead for him? He's the first to admit that unless you're Dan or Dave, there's not much of a living to be made in the decathlon. But, he won't worry about that until after 1996.

"For the past several years, I was aiming for the Olympic Trials last spring," he said. "Now, the push is on for Atlanta. I really haven't sat down and mapped out the course, but I expect to do it after graduation this May."

And, does he think he has a chance to compete on the international level? "Most definitely," he responded. "I haven't even learned to pole vault yet. When I get that down, the sky's the limit."

Over 50 Years of Tradition, Pride, Diversity & Service

Founded in 1938, the Eastern College Athletic Conference is the nation's largest collegiate athletic conference with 268 member colleges and universities ranging from Maine to North Carolina in Divisions I, II and III. ECAC member institutions sponsor over 2500 varsity teams involving 125,000 male and female student athletes.

The ECAC manages over 90 championships in 19 men's and women's sports for its membership and is responsible for over 20,000 officiating assignments, a public relations/news bureau and a legislative services department.

The ECAC headquarters, the Asa S. Bushnell Center, is located in Centerville, Mass., on Cape Cod. The business of this non-profit organization is conducted at its annual ECAC Fall and Spring Conventions. Over 300 athletic administrators annually attend the fall convention, which includes tournament and membership committee meetings, professional seminars, a schedule-making session and an awards luncheon.

A Conference of conferences, the ECAC includes within its organizational structure dozens of leagues and other associations, colleges and universities from the Atlantic 10, Big East, Colonial Athletic Association, East Coast, Ivy League, MAAC, North Atlantic, Northeast and Patriot League, along with schools from the Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York and Pennsylvania State conferences, all hold dual membership in the ECAC.

Over the years, the ECAC has exerted leadership on not only the regional level, but also on the national scale with the NCAA. With over 25 percent of the NCAA made up of ECAC members, the Conference plays a leading role in national athletic policy and action.

Several ECAC administrators have served as both NCAA and ECAC Presidents, including Bill Flynn of Boston College, John Toner, of U. Conn., and Eppy Barnes of Colgate. NCAA Executive Director Dick Schultz, former Cornell Athletic Director, served on the ECAC Executive Council.

The ECAC was founded 52 years ago as the Central Office for Eastern Intercollegiate Athletics with a charter membership of 53 colleges. Under the leadership of Commissioner Asa Bushnell, the conference addressed the concerns of its members in much the same fashion as today.

Bushnell molded and guided the organization from its inception until his retirement in 1970, at which time his long-time associate, George L. Shiebler, was appointed Commissioner. Robert M. (Scotty) Whitelaw, who joined the ECAC in 1960, replaced Shiebler upon his retirement in 1972. After serving as ECAC Commissioner for 17 years, Whitelaw retired in 1989. His place was taken by current Commissioner Clayton Chapman, who joined the ECAC in 1971.

One of the most significant events in ECAC history occurred in 1983 with the consolidation of the Eastern Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (EAIW) into the ECAC structure. With the addition of women's sports, the ECAC doubled the number of its championships.

Some of the more recognizable ECAC championships include the ECAC Holiday Basketball Festival at Madison Square Garden in NYC, IC4A Track, Rowing Championships of the EARC and IRA and ECAC Men's Golf Tournament. Also included is the ECAC Division I Baseball, Women's Cross Country and Ice Hockey Championships, each of whose champions receive automatic NCAA Tournament bids.

The ECAC also offers championships for its members in Divisions I, II and III in baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, fencing, field hockey, football, men's and women's golf, men's and women's gymnastics, men's and women's ice hockey, men's and women's lacrosse, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's swimming and diving, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's track and field and women's volleyball.

The ECAC assigns over 4,000 officials in baseball, men's and women's basketball, fencing, football, gymnastics, ice hockey, men's and women's soccer and wrestling, as well as the affiliate championships in crew, cross country, swimming and track.

The Conference office maintains a legislative services department for its membership, responding to questions on eligibility, interpretations of NCAA and ECAC regulations and letter of intent. The office also sponsors legislative workshops and seminars.

Through its public relations and service bureau departments, the ECAC assists in the promotion of its members' athletic programs and student-athletes through weekly and seasonal player and team awards, selection of all-star teams, compilation of statistics and championship publicity. The Conference also publishes a Directory and Record Book and media guides in football and ice hockey.

The ECAC is currently staffed by 20 full-time employees with an additional staff of 21 part-time employees who serve as supervisors of officials and directors/coordinators of ECAC Tournaments.
