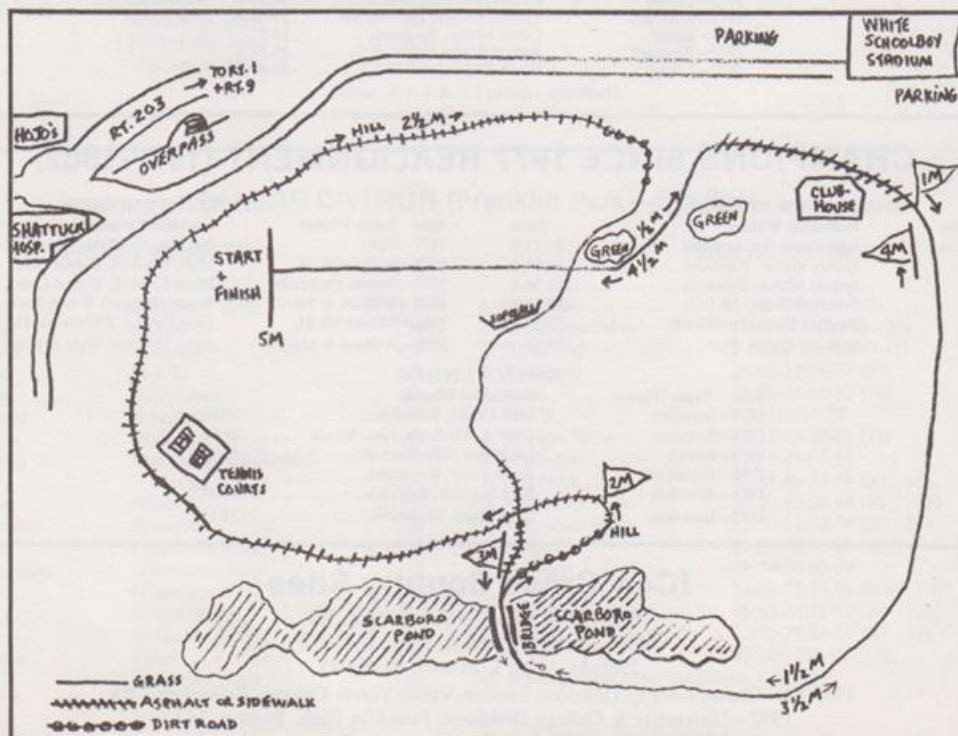

I.C.A.A.A.A. CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP CUP

Cornell University won the inaugural I.C.A.A.A.A. championship trophy in 1913 with five victories in six years. It took twenty-three meets before Michigan State captured the second trophy in 1937. Michigan State also retired the third championship cup in 1957, with a record of five triumphs in 1948, 1952, 1953, 1956 and 1957. The fourth cup went to Villanova, winner in 1962, 1966, 1967, 1968 and 1969. The fifth cup went into competition in 1970. Villanova has four legs on another cup with wins in 1970, 1971, 1978 and 1979.
