was doing the looking. 2004 is a huge goal for me. I want to be in position to qualify for the Olympic team whereas 2000 I was just happy to be at the Trials."

On why he came to UConn

"I'm from Connecticut originally so Coach Roy was recruiting me - he saw me run as a sophomore. He sent me stuff before other coaches so that sparked interest. I had a couple of injuries where coaches stopped recruiting me and Coach Roy didn't. That pretty much gave me a lot of faith in him and the program. So that made the decision a lot easier because coaches kind of forgot about me when I was hurt and Coach Roy didn't."

On injuries

"I never lost sight of where I wanted to go. When I was hurt, I would do a lot of cross-training and keeping in mind of what I wanted to do and who I wanted to be as a runner so that kept me on the right track."

On Coach Roy

"I think if I went to pretty much any other school, I think I would have moved up in distance and been a 5K runner. Coach Roy was the first one who told me I was a miler and gave me the confidence that I could do that at the national level. Over the past couple of years, our relationship has just gotten better and better. We see things the same way. For example, I'll go into his office and I'll have something to tell him and he'll say the exact same thing to me. We get along really well which has really helped me improve year by year."

On Olympics

"I'm definitely looking forward to 2004. I didn't run very well at the Trials. But it was a huge stepping stone - it gave me a ton of confidence. Running the time I ran to get in there would have made me second at NAAs that year, but I hadn't even qualified for them. So it was a huge improvement and it just got me onto a new level. Now, going to meets, I'm one of the people to look out for whereas before I

"I enjoy it. Everyone does. I don't get too much publicity because I'm a runner. It's not like I'm a basketball player, but it's still nice when people know who I am and respect what I do on the track."

On memorable moments

"The Penn Relays victory was definitely the highlight so far. That was huge. Also, I won the BIG EAST mile as a freshman. That was kind of a surprise to everyone, I think, but Coach Roy and myself because we were planning on trying to win it. In the race, no one even knew who I was. The day before people didn't give me any recognition, but I didn't deserve it."

On personal/team goals

"My personal goal heading into the year was to be in a position to win a NCAA Championship, so that is still one of my main goals. As far as the team's goal, I just want to score as many points for the team as possible...The way I kind of look at it is if everyone does their part...I'm not counting on other people; I just know if I do what I can do for the team then we should do well and if everyone has that attitude, we should do well."

On goals for post-UConn

"2004 and 2008 are my main goals. I definitely want to be in position in 2004 to possibly make the team and definitely be in the final at the Olympic Trials and then in 2008, hopefully the same...It is a ways down the road, but I still plan on running and competing then. Basically, every year I have goals where I just want to get a little faster and improve in different events and I'll keep that going. But the main goals are definitely the Olympics."
