

THIRD ANNUAL INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ATHLETIC MEETING.

The Third Annual Indoor Championship Athletic Meeting was held in the One Hundred and Second Engineers' Armory, New York City, March 1, 1924. The University of Pennsylvania won for the second time with 21 1-3 points. Princeton and Yale tied for second with 20 points each. The competition was exceedingly keen. Two records were broken, the two-mile run by Verne Booth, Johns Hopkins, '24, run in 9m. 36s., and the shot put by Ralph G. Hills, Princeton, '25, with a put of 46ft. 3-4in. A new record was established in the 70-yard high hurdles, a new event, by Charles H. Moore, Penn State, '26, by winning the first heat in 9 seconds. Three contestants—Kenneth P. Libbey, Dartmouth, '25, Benjamin M. Owen, Pennsylvania, '25, and Sylvan S. Scholpp, Yale, '24, equalled the pole vault record by vaulting 12ft. 6in. In two events the winners came within 1-10th of a second of the record, and in the two-mile relay the dropping of a baton prevented a record. In this race George Marsters, Georgetown, '25, was unofficially credited with 1:54.4 for the half.
