In view of the successful experiment at the 48th games, slow motion pictures of all finishes were again taken, and in spite of the extremely adverse circumstances, due to the heavy rains on Friday, the pictures were successful.

Through the courtesy of the Philadelphia Music Festival it was possible to have for the first time throughout the meet a mechanical power announcer, and the results obtained were remarkably successful, the regular announcers taking turns at the microphone.

Two records were broken: the Shot Put by Ralph G. Hills, Princeton, '25, with a put of 49 feet 9 5-8 inches, and the Discus by Clarence L. Houser, So. California, '26, with a throw of 150 feet 2 1-4 inches.
