**SIXTH ANNUAL INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ATHLETIC MEETING**

The Sixth Annual Indoor Championship Athletic Meeting was held at the 102nd Engineers' Armory, New York City on March 5, 1927. It was eminently successful from the standpoint of finance, management and the excellence of sport. The number of spectators was the greatest in the history of the meeting and there was a notable smoothness in the running off of the events. The floor was the clearest it had ever been of those who did not belong there and there were no untoward incidents to mar the sport.
