

30<sup>th</sup> IC4A Indoor Championships

February 24, 1951

Madison Square Garden, Feb 24— Joe Deady of Georgetown cracked the 1000 yard record and Manhattan won its first IC4A championship with 29 points to 27  $\frac{2}{7}$  for Seton Hall, and 22 for Georgetown.

Deady, who has run only two open races indoors, won his second straight in the record time of 2:11.7.

The meet had more than its share of iron men. Andy Stanfield won the 60 in 6.3 and the broad jump at 24'5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Harry Carter of Seton Hall won the 600 in 1:12.9 and anchored the mile relay winner. He ran heats in both events. Meredith Gourdine upset Pete McCreary in the high hurdles, and was second to Stanfield in the broad jump. John Ogle won the shot and placed 2d in the 35# Wt. Bob Carty improved over a foot in the finals of the broad jump to score the winning two points for Manhattan, after having been barely shut out in the 60 and as anchor man in the mile relay, six heats in all.
