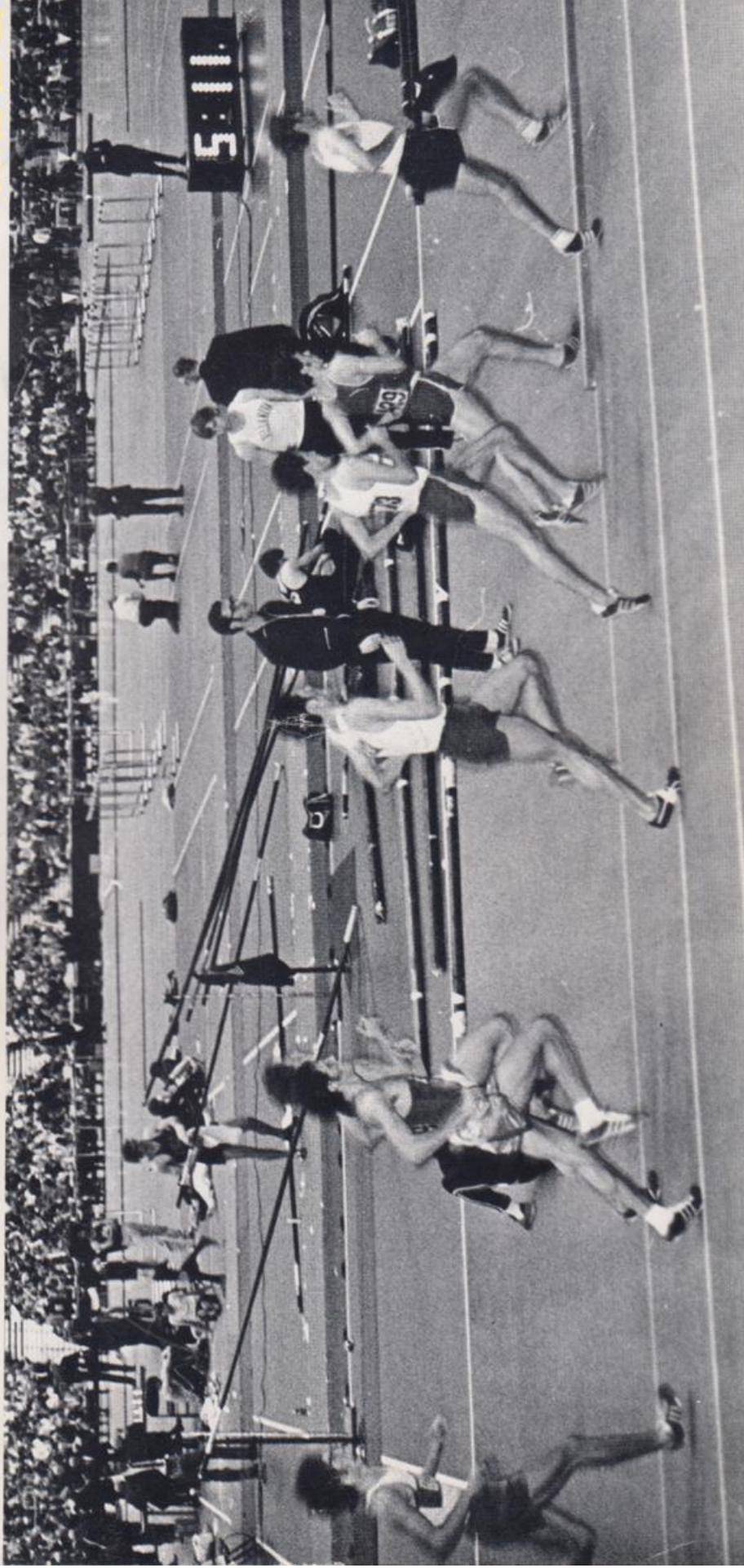

Changing of the Guard

With this 51st Indoor Championship meet of the I.C.A.A.A.A., there is a changing of the guard, a rare event in this, the country's oldest track and field organization and its largest regional track group. The baton of Meet Director is being passed from George Shiebler to Scotty Whitelaw.

Since the I.C.A.A.A.A. joined the Eastern College Athletic Conference 34 years ago, there has been only one other Meet Director—Asa Bushnell, of course.

Just a week ago Shiebler, who had been assistant, then associate commissioner, retired as Commissioner of the ECAC after 25 years with the conference and 45 years over-all in college athletics. George will continue his activities as an official in track and in other sports with which he has been so busy all his adult life.

It all began, for George, in the Golden Age of Sports, which is how historians identify the '20s.

The '20s, too, were the era of New York University's explosion to national renown in football under Chick Meehan, in track under Emil Von Elling, in fencing under Hugo Castello, in basketball under Howard Cann.

George Shiebler, you could say, was present at the creation. He was graduated from N.Y.U. in 1927 after three varsity years as a lacrosse player, a campus correspondent for the Brooklyn Eagle and the New York Journal, a founder of the sports column in the Brooklyn Tablet, a Catholic weekly. Naturally, immediately upon graduation, George became N.Y.U.'s first full-time sports information director. Meehan's ambitious football program needed such a man. George was the right man in the right place at the right time.

What an exciting time that was for a new SID. A year later the Violet was winning what Grantland Rice described as the greatest football game of the season, the triumph of Ken Strong and Co. over Carnegie

Tech. The SID played his part in attracting crowds of 77,000 in the Yankee Stadium for the Battle of The Bronx with Fordham. That same academic year Von's Violets were winning the first of their I.C.A.A.A. team championships.

"Strong was the greatest," says George. But his quarter century in ECAC administration necessarily made him a disinterested observer of the sporting scene. "I don't want to overlook so many others who were great guys, too."

To go back down memory lane with George is to review one's own past. I had been a member of the Herald's and Herald Tribune's sports staff for three years before George became N.Y.U.'s press relations officer. He was the one who had the stats just becoming so vital to reporting.

"You know what a public-relations master Chick was," recalled George. Good as Rockne. "With so many writers making the rounds of the campuses, we decided it would be more profitable and also time-saving for Chick and Jim Crowley and, soon, Lou Little, too, to meet downtown each Monday with the writers."

That started the Football Writers Association's weekly sessions, and, in season, similar writers' luncheons in track and basketball and rowing. I reckon George paved the way for me to become founding father of the Track Writers Association.

George also pioneered the football brochure, the pre-season booklet providing useful background information and the inevitable statistics for the press—and alumni as well. And as an unexpected spin-off the brochures were employed eventually, for better or worse, to promote All-America candidates.

As SID of the leading track power in town, George also helped in launching the Metropolitan Intercollegiate Track and Field Association, which was organized by Von Elling, Manhattan's Pete Waters and Columbia's Carl Merner. Later, in his

ECAC tenure, George was the Mets. meet director for years.

As I.C.A.A.A. press steward, George came into close contact with Bushnell and ultimately, when the ECAC expanded and needed an assistant commissioner, Shiebler left NYU and took over that post.

From Phil Edwards, an early N.Y.U. track star from British Guiana, who, representing Canada, was an 800 and 1500 meter finalist in three straight Olympics, to Leslie MacMitchell, who never lost an I.C.A.A.A. mile or cross-country race, George publicized dozens of Violet trackmen for 20 years. Von Elling inspired many track enthusiasts besides Shiebler.

"You can hardly run an I.C.A.A.A. championship meet without officials who were Von's pupils," says Shiebler. "Look at the list—John and Joe Trachy, George Barker, who was my classmate, Harold Eichhorn, Arthur Gleberman, Jimmy Herbert, Dr. Frank Martin, Stan Saplin, Harold Bogrow, Charley Grossberger, Phil Siff, Bill Gant, Heliodoro Rico, Jeff Petrak, Duke Marshall, George Faber, and Ray Lumpp, who was our basketball star at N.Y.U. but has become a track buff. I guess we were all bitten by the same track bug, listening to Von talk track in the little wooden house he made his headquarters at Ohio Field."

With 45 years of sports memories behind him, loaded with honors and awards he picked up along the way for his services, innovations and achievements, George can look ahead to continued activity as elder statesman and official. He will have leisure time now in Rockville Center, for his civic and religious commitments and to enjoy his senior-citizen role with attractive, charming Kay; their son, three daughters and 11 grandchildren. Involved as he has been with ECAC, NCAA and Olympic duties, George will now be able to see his first Olympic Games—live—in Munich.

The changing of the guard will be accompanied with minimum fanfare. Under the competent, able and conscientious leadership of Robert M. Whitelaw, who is known as Scotty to all except his mother, who alone calls him Bobby, the ECAC carries on its multitudinous affairs of administration and organization of championships. A native of Quincy, Mass., Scotty is a graduate of Springfield College, was a football, baseball and track man, coached all three at Andover, became freshman basketball coach at M.I.T. and then assistant athletic director there before he joined the ECAC team in 1960.

As I.C.A.A.A. Meet Director, Scotty will have a breeze. He doesn't have to go looking for athletes. I have some advice for him. Just rely on your officials, Scotty. That's what I do as Director of the U.S. Olympic Invitational. Welcome to the club, Scotty. They call us Meet Heads. •

When Does A Foot Race Begin?

This being an Olympic year, every track meet assumes extra importance. All runners are thinking of one thing, making the Olympic team.

Since there is so much more emphasis on the sport in such a year, naturally many discussions, some new and some old, are held. One concerns the very important subject of when does a race begin.

Did you ever stop to realize that in track and field, there are as many as three beginnings to each race? That's not so in horse racing, where the competition begins when the first horse breaks the electronic beam shortly after he charges out of the starting gate.

That's when time begins also for the horses. But then, everything is more complicated for human beings. Actually, at those meets where there is the Bulova Accutron Phototimer there really are four beginnings to the race.

There have been some discussions about simplifying the judging of foot races so that the head crossing the finish line will determine the winner similarly to the way the nose is the determining factor in which a horse wins at the racetrack.

In a recent discussion concerning the actual beginning of a race, Harry B. Henshel, Bulova president and timing advisor to the National A. A. U., said the answer depends on whose point of view you take. His conclusions are based on his experience with time at Bulova and the years he studied the timing of races through his association with the A.A.U.

"From whose point of view are you talking, when you try to determine when a race begins," said Henshel. "Is it that of the runner on the starting line, or the timing official who is at the finish line. Is it the starter, poised with his gun to signal the beginning of the race. Or, when the Bulova Accutron Phototimer is there, is it the camera?"

"For the runner," added Henshel, "the race starts when the sound of the starter's gun reaches

his ears and he reacts by propelling himself forward. For the starter, it is when he pulls the trigger. And for the timer, it's when he presses his finger to start his timer, which is when he sees the smoke curling from the gun.

"The Phototimer reacts to the heat generated by the shooting of the gun because its electronic starting equipment is connected to that gun through an electronic control which fits over the barrel."

Even at the very short distance from the starter to the runner, there is an imperceptible time lag between the shooting of the gun and the hearing of the sound by the racers. In fact, it is likely that the timer at the finish line sees the smoke before the runner hears the explosion.

Incidentally, the difference explains why the Phototimer picture, which shows both the runner and his time simultaneously, catches the athlete in slightly slower time than the human timer. The Phototimer reacts so instantaneously that it is ticking away the time in hundredths of a second before the human timer has started his machine going.

Actually, Henshel believes that the true beginning of a foot race, if it were possible to perfect the proper equipment that would trigger all timers, should be at a specific point beyond the starting line. That then would be the true beginning of a race.

This all is part of the fascination with time which never ends. The Bulova Watch Company's natural interest in time accounts for the presence of the Bulova Accutron Phototimer at all major track meets throughout the United States, including the IC4A championships here.

That odd-looking black box perched high in the stands which is the Bulova Accutron Phototimer camera has been the court of last resort in deciding many of the greatest races ever run, and many which were quite unusual. It is now in its 24th season of providing that service. •

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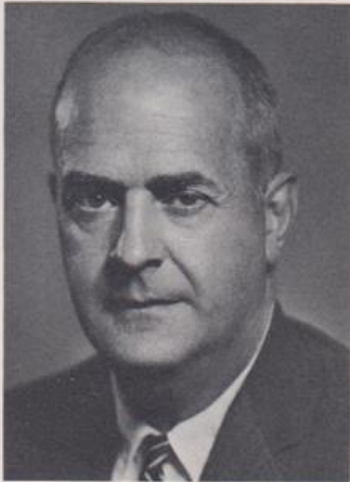

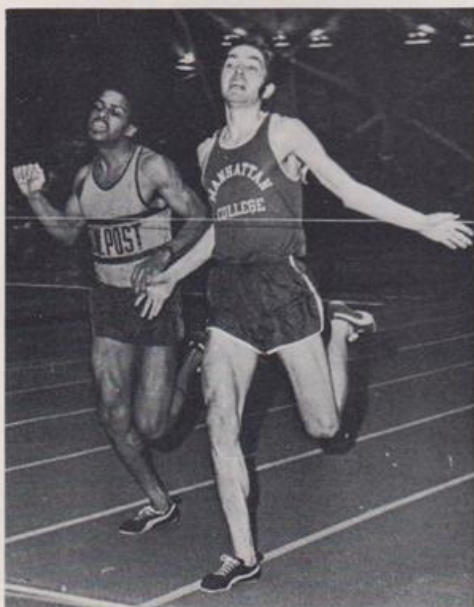

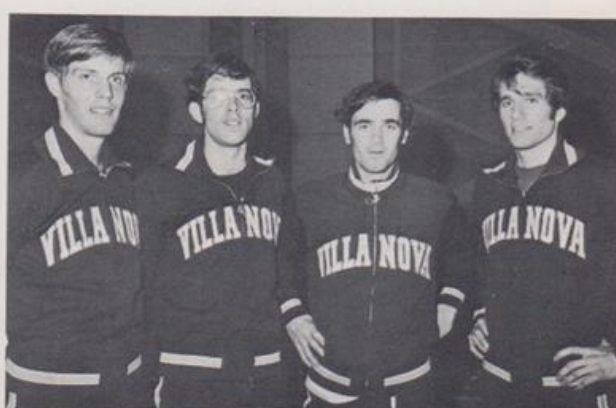

**N.C.A.A. RULES OF COMPETITION WILL
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Track measures four laps to mile.

All events are scratch, i.e., none is handicap.

Firing of revolver denotes beginning of final lap in
all races.

In all races there is no penalty for first false start,
but competitor is disqualified for second false start.
However, starter's recall no longer nullifies false start
by any competitor.

In hurdle races competitor is not disqualified for
knocking down hurdles.

In all relay races baton must be carried in runner's
hand and must be passed to next succeeding teammate
within clearly marked 20 meters zone, extending 10
meters in both directions from leg finish line.

Governing rules provide that, in races around turns,
any competitor willfully jostling, running across or
obstructing another competitor so as to impede his
progress, shall be disqualified. If in any race competi-
tor is disqualified for any of these reasons, Referee
shall have power to order race to be rerun with dis-
qualified competitor excluded or, in case of heat, to
permit any competitors affected by act resulting in
disqualification, other than disqualified competitor, to
compete in subsequent round of event.

Any competitor may be disqualified if, in opinion of
Referee, he has in any way been aided by coach,
teammate, or anyone connected directly or indirectly
with team concerned, such as, running along-side of
teammate, being stationed at various points near
track, or located nearby any of field events for pur-

pose of aiding or coaching competitor after race or
field event has officially been started.

Each member college is limited to following num-
bers of actual participants in various events in the
Outdoor Championships:

3 Mile Run	2*
Relays	One Team
All other events	5

Nominee or qualifier who fails to compete in any
running or hurdling event for which he has been nomi-
nated or has qualified will be ineligible for any fur-
ther participation in meet.

In four weight events (shot, discus, javelin, and
hammer), broad jump, and triple jump, each contest-
ant shall be allowed three preliminary trials. The first
six men in the standing at the completion of the trials
will qualify for the final. Each finalist will then receive
three additional tries.

All performances made in field event trials shall be
counted with performances in final in determining final
place winners. Each competitor shall be credited with
best of all his efforts.

Competitors must be on time, field contestants en-
tering enclosure five minutes before scheduled start of
their event, and track contestants entering enclosure
upon completion of race next preceding theirs. As
soon as their event is over, competitors will kindly
leave track and infield without delay.

Spikes longer than $\frac{3}{8}$ inch not permitted.

In each event 16 points are scored: 6 for first place,
4 for second, 3 for third, 2 for fourth, and 1 for fifth.
