WHAT HAPPENED IN 1969

ART DULONG, the Holy Cross senior who had won the event as a sophomore in 1967 and had finished second to Georgetown's Steve Stageberg as a junior in 1968, completed his varsity career by winning the individual title again last year in the 61st annual University Division race of the ICAAAA over the Van Cortlandt Park course.

Completing the five-mile course in 24 minutes 6.8 seconds, 2.4 seconds away from the record he posted as a sophomore, he won by a convincing 125 yards, 22.2 seconds faster than the time returned by the runner-up, Donal Walsh of Villanova. Keith Colburn of Harvard was third in 24:32, Jerry Richey of Pittsburgh fourth and David Wright of Villanova fifth.

AS EXPECTED, VILLANOVA took the team title for the fourth straight time, totaling 28 points to second-place Harvard's 69. The Wildcats placed second, fifth, sixth, 19th and 28th in achieving their winning total, which gave them outright possession of the fourth ICAAAA Cup.

More than 550 runners, representing 67 of the Association's 85 members took part and the college varsity division individual winner, for the second year in a row, was C.W. Post junior Ron Stonitsch, who posted 25:03.3, just under 29 seconds faster than Dale Keenan of Lafayette. Third was Dan Thomas of Lafayette, followed by William Rodgers of Wesleyan and Timothy Steele of Lehigh. The Engineers took the team title with 36 points, followed by St. Joseph's with 98, Lafayette with 107, West Chester with 113 and Springfield with 156.

IN THE TWO FRESHMAN events, at three miles, Phil Banning of Villanova took the individual and William & Mary the team title in the university division and Dan Moynihan of Wesleyan and West Chester scored in the individual and team college division competitions.

I.C.A.A.A. CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP CUP

Cornell University won the inaugural I.C.A.A.A. championship trophy in 1913 with five victories in six years. It took twenty-three meets before Michigan State captured the second trophy in 1937. Michigan State retired the third championship cup in 1957 with a record of five triumphs in 1948, 1952, 1953, 1956 and 1957. The fourth cup went to Villanova, winner in 1962, 1966, 1967, 1968 and 1969. The fifth cup goes into competition this year.

The Spartans with thirteen team championships from 1933 through 1961 are out in front in total team victories and Cornell is second with nine, from 1908 up to 1921. Penn State with seven and Manhattan, with five each, follow in that order.
