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Profile of an IC4A Champion: Cover Story - Tony Barton

Four years ago, Tony Barton had no aspirations to become one of the premier high jumpers in the nation. In fact, he wasn't even interested in competing in track and field.

Jesse Hannon, the track coach at Milford High School in Baltimore, talked Tony into joining the track team during his senior year. Up until that point, Barton had wrestled, played baseball, lacrosse and tennis. Jeff McDaniel, the indoor track coach, suggested that Tony try the high jump. He cleared 5-8 in his first meet and 6-7 by the end of the high school season.

Since then, Tony has won three IC4A high jump titles, placed second at the 1990 NCAA Indoor Championships with a 7-6-1/2 clearance, and then opened his outdoor season with an Eastern Collegiate record leap of 7-7 at a meet in Jamaica, West Indies.

Tony has no ready analysis to explain his success. "I guess it was just meant to be," said the 6-foot, 3-inch junior physical education major. "Things have happened so fast that I haven't had much time to think about them. I am just continuing to work hard and pray that things will work out."

During the outdoor season of his senior year, Tony won the Maryland State Championship. He spent a year at Virginia State before transferring to George Mason. In the summer of 1988, he won the National Junior Championship with a leap of 7-feet, one-half inch, and competed in the World Junior Championship in Canada.

While competing at the World Junior Championship, Tony met Istvan Bagyula from Budapest, Hungary, now a teammate at George Mason. Bagyula won the pole vault at the World Juniors and this year, as a Patriot sophomore, he won the NCAA indoor title.

Barton won both the indoor and outdoor IC4A high jump competitions in 1989. Tony cleared 7 feet, 1 3/4 inches to win both championships. In this year's IC4A indoor, he took both the high jump and triple jump titles, clearing 7-2 1/2 in the high jump and leaping 51 feet, 6-1/2 inches in the triple jump. He will compete in both the high jump and triple jump in the 1990 outdoor championship.

Tony's success has made track and field a main focus in the Barton household. His younger sister, Sheron, is a sprinter and hurdler at Milford Mill. His father, Winston Barton, a financial analyst for the Chessie System, and his mother, June, a nurse at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore, try to follow Tony's progress at major meets in person.



Dan Ghormley, Assistant Commissioner

After more than 20 years as an athletics administrator, teacher and coach, Dan Ghormley has joined the staff of the nation's largest athletic conference. Ghormley was named ECAC Assistant Commissioner/Director of Legislative Services and assumed that position on July 10, 1989.

Along with directing the ECAC Legislative Services, which includes eligibility, rules interpretations and compliance, Ghormley will also administer several ECAC and affiliate sponsored championship events and oversee the conference's officiating bureaus in soccer, gymnastics and fencing.

Since 1985, Ghormley has served as Associate Athletic Director at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst. At U. Mass., Ghormley was instrumental in directing the athletic program of 26 Division I sports and represented the university in conference and NCAA matters. He was also directly responsible for compliance with NCAA rules, event management, scheduling, policy formation, budget recommendations, travel and supervising coaches and staff.

From 1982-85, Ghormley served as Athletic Director at Illinois State University, where he directed a 16-sport NCAA Division I program and from 1976-79 was the assistant Athletic Director at the University of Hawaii.

Prior to entering athletic administration, Dan was involved with track and field as a participant, coach and administrator. As an undergraduate at UCLA, he was considered an outstanding Olympic Decathlon prospect. He won the Junior College Hurdle Championships and later participated in the NCAA Division I National Championships in the hurdles and Sprint relay. He was also the starting running halfback for the UCLA Bruins football team. Ghormley coached both track and cross country for six years at Washington State, where he earned both his Bachelor of Science and Master's degrees. He was also the Associate Executive Director of the Track and Field Association - USA prior to its merger with The Athletics Congress.

JACK WARNER and ROY CHERNOCK . . . necessitates expressing my personal feelings about these two native New Yorkers (like myself), each of whom I have shared a warm and lengthy professional relationship.

I met Jack at Butler Stadium at Quantico, VA in March of 1953, when we were running mates on the Marine Corps Schools track team. Just a few weeks ago we both recalled an incident from that season, when one of the spectators at the Quantico-Camp Lejeune dual meet, the ex-Commandant of the Corps, Clifton Cates, jumped up in the stands and yelled at the starter . . . "Shoot that gun" . . . in a distance race that had one lap to go. The startled official, awakening to his error, and glancing up at the shine of those stars on the man's collar, promptly fired the "gun-lap" signal, to which the General replied, for all the crowd to hear . . . "That's better," and sat down to watch the rest of the meet. Later that year, Jack was appointed as coach of the Quantico cross-country team, and I, having "retired" from competition, served as Lieutenant Warner's assistant.

In the ensuing years, I managed to cross paths with Jack, at the Drake Relays when he was the "weights" coach at University of Kansas, and later visited the Colgate campus on several occasions during the 60s when Jack was the coach of the Red Raiders.

About the time Jack became head coach at Cornell, I was beginning my apprenticeship as a high school and later a collegiate official, and met up with Jack at many scholastic meets in Ithaca, and for the past 15 years, in the circle of IC4A officials and coaches. Throughout these years, there has always been that close camaraderie of having spent some very gung-ho times together . . . a feeling that only those who have served under the Eagle, Globe and Anchor can truly appreciate.

So, Jack, the best of everything to you and Betty in the many years to come, and we can always look back . . . with fondest memories . . . to Butler Stadium and Cliff Cates . . . Semper Fi, from the "old Sarge!"



I knew Roy Chernock in passing, during his competitive years at NYU in the late 40s, on an IC4A Championship team that included: Larry Ellis, Irv Mondschein, Irving Kintisch, Bruce MacDonald, IC4A Coaches all, at one time or another . . . and subsequently during Roy's ultra-successful reign as coach at Oceanside High School on Long Island, during the 60s, where his teams won four New York State titles.

But I really got to know, and develop a 20-plus year friendship with Roy, when he was coaching at C.W. Post (my alma mater) and I was an assistant at a local high school, Chaminade; and Roy was gracious in allowing our 4 x 100m relay and jumpers to work-out at Post. After developing a Division II powerhouse at Post, Roy moved on to Bernard Baruch College, a mid-town New York "campus" in the City University system. Working for Met Life at the time, I was just a block from Baruch, and would occasionally slip into the world famous 69th Regiment Armory . . . and watch Roy's runners work-out on a tiny track, ducking tennis balls from the courts on the infield.

From the "Sidewalks of New York" I followed Roy's career onto the ivy covered campus of Old Nassau, as Larry Ellis' assistant for two years, and finally Williamsburg, in 1977, as mentor of William & Mary, where I was a visitor at a number of Colonial Relays, a very popular and successful early-season outdoor meet. On many occasions in the past two decades, Roy and I have discussed the merits of scholastic track and field prospects, and I've always felt honored that Roy sought out my advice and recommendations in such matters.

Now, as Roy and Ethel move south to enjoy the golf and sunshine in Palm Beach County, I will miss him. At times, he's been the "Royal opposition", but always in the best interest of our sport. Especially the IC4A will remember Roy's contributions for years to come. Mazel Tov, my friend!

Now in its 51st year of existence, the Eastern College Athletic Conference is a voluntary association of 258 colleges and universities throughout New England, the Middle Atlantic states, the District of Columbia, Virginia and North Carolina.

The ECAC, which is the nation's largest athletic conference, is unique in that institutions of Division I, II & III are members, from the largest state-supported universities to the small private or church affiliated colleges, lending the conference an unparalleled diversity in membership and philosophy.

A Conference of conferences, the ECAC umbrella covers dozens of conferences and other associations. Colleges and universities from the ECAC North Atlantic, Northeast Conference, Atlantic 10, The Big East, the Colonial Athletic Association, East Coast Conference, Ivy League and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference, to the Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, New York and New Jersey State Conferences, along with numerous other Division I, II and III conferences, hold active membership in the ECAC.

Over the years, the ECAC has developed a strong voice on not only the regional level, but also on the national scale with the National Collegiate Athletic Association. Since over twenty-five percent of the NCAA is made up of ECAC members, the Conference membership has the ability to play a leading role in the development of national athletic policy and action.

From the viewpoints of both philosophy and personnel, the ECAC's impact upon the NCAA is well documented. The ECAC and its member colleges have been prime movers in the development of divisional structure and autonomy which was also adopted by the NCAA. John Toner, former University of Connecticut athletic director and Boston College's athletic director, Bill Flynn, have served both as NCAA and ECAC Presidents to head the list of prominent ECAC administrators who have served key leadership roles in the NCAA. Former Cornell athletic director and ECAC Executive Council member Dick Schultz is now the executive director of the NCAA.

Founded in 1938 as the Central Office for Eastern Intercollegiate Athletics, the ECAC began with a charter membership of 53 colleges and has grown into its present membership of 258. From the start, under the leadership of its Commissioner, Asa S. Bushnell, the conference addressed the concerns of its members in the same fashion as it does today. Bushnell and the Central Office were able to meet and resolve athletics scheduling issues, administer the assignment of officials and lend its management skills to various tournaments and championships.

In 1947, the Central Office officially became the Eastern College Athletic Conference and another assignment was taken on by the ECAC -- that being the maintenance of minimum standards of eligibility for student athletes and the establishment of basic principles for the ethical conduct of intercollegiate athletics, by member colleges. While recognizing the right of each individual college to set its own academic standards programs and operate under its own code of ethics, the membership of the ECAC legislated certain minimum standards of eligibility which now apply to all Conference members in such areas as amateurism, recruiting, academic standing, financial aid, years of participation and outside competition, all of which are now consistent with standards also adopted by the NCAA.

Bushnell molded and guided the organization from its inception until his retirement in 1970, at which time his long-time associate, George L. Shiebler, was appointed Commissioner. Robert M. (Scotty) Whitelaw, who joined the ECAC in 1960 as Assistant Commissioner, succeeded Commissioner Shiebler upon his retirement in 1972. Under Whitelaw's leadership the ECAC has continued to prosper as the largest and one of the most dynamic and diversified athletic conferences in the country. After serving as ECAC Commissioner for 17 years, Whitelaw retired on June 30, 1989 and his place was taken by Associate Commis-

sioner Clayton Chapman, who joined the ECAC in 1971.

One of the more significant events in ECAC history took place in 1983 with the consolidation of the programs of the Eastern Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (EAIW) into the ECAC. With this consolidation, the ECAC expanded its services, doubling the number of ECAC championships.

Today the ECAC has evolved to the point where its member institutions not only enjoy the benefits such as the professional management and coordination of its numerous tournaments and championships, expertise on eligibility and rules interpretations and the assigning of officials, but also public relations department and service bureau to promote the membership's teams and student athletes, all in an atmosphere of mutual trust which was always commonplace among ECAC institutions from the start.

The ECAC now assigns officials for regular season and championship events in the sports of baseball, men's and women's basketball, fencing, football, gymnastics, ice hockey, men's and women's soccer and wrestling, as well as the ECAC affiliate championships in cross country, indoor and outdoor track, crew and swimming.

In addition, the ECAC professionally manages over 90 championship events for its member colleges -- including those for Division I men's basketball, ice hockey and baseball tournaments whose winners receive automatic berths into their respective NCAA Championships, and terminal ECAC championships for all three divisions in the sports of baseball, men's and women's basketball, cross country, field hockey, football, men's and women's golf, men's and women's gymnastics, men's and women's ice hockey, men's and women's lacrosse, men's and women's soccer, men's and women's swimming and diving, men's and women's indoor and outdoor track, softball, men's and women's tennis and women's volleyball.

The ECAC office also helps manage the championship tournaments of its affiliates in cross country and track (IC4A), wrestling (Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association), fencing (Intercollegiate Fencing Association), swimming (Eastern Intercollegiate Swimming League), crew (Eastern Association of Rowing Colleges & the Intercollegiate Gymnastics League). The ECAC Holiday Basketball Festival, held every year at Madison Square Garden in New York City, is sponsored by the ECAC and is the premier Christmas tournament in the country.

With the help of its public relations and service bureau departments, the ECAC helps to promote its members' athletic programs and athletes through weekly and seasonal players and teams of the year awards, selection of all-star teams, compilation of statistics and publications, as well as publicizing its championships.

The ECAC current headquarters, the Asa S. Bushnell Center, is located in Centerville, Mass., and was dedicated to its first commissioner in 1974. The ECAC is currently staffed by 20 full-time employees with an additional part-time staff of 21 serving as supervisors of officials.
