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Jerry Roney and JMU's 4x100m Relay

This weekend's IC4A Championships have brought together what almost certainly is the best group of athletes ever assembled on the James Madison University campus, and JMU's Jerry Roney can claim a position at or near the top of the list of outstanding performers.

Roney, in fact, may be as versatile as any of the hundreds of competitors in this season's meet.

The Baltimore native is one of the leading performers nationally in the 110-meter high hurdles, he's an accomplished sprinter, and he is a key member of strong JMU relay teams. Those credentials are impressive for someone with two seasons of collegiate eligibility still remaining, but Roney's athletic resumé includes more. Much more.

In addition to his prowess as a sprinter and hurdler, Roney came out of Woodlawn High School as a national caliber decathlete, and it was a football scholarship that first brought him to JMU.

Roney confesses to loving football and to always wanting to be a decathlete. But he also realizes as JMU coach Bill Walton says, "You can't do everything."

Not that Roney hasn't at times tried, and with success. He lettered as a defensive back and special teams player on JMU's football team as a true freshman in 1988 and ran on his own as a "red-shirt" during the 1989-90 academic year but last summer returned to football. He worked out with the football team until early in the season but then returned to track.

"I love to play football," Roney says. "I'd play football over track, but whenever I participated in football my grades suffered. And I never had a season with just football. Splitting time between sports obviously hindered his development, and Roney found himself working behind two more-experienced players during last summer's football preseason.

"I was disappointed because I wasn't playing as well as I thought I could," he said. "There were seniors in front of me and the coaches told me to 'wait your turn.'"

Knowing he could excel elsewhere pushed Roney back to track but not without leaving some to wonder what he might have accomplished had he concentrated only on football.

"He has a speed to play defensive back that you don't see in a lot of professional players, and physically he's tough," says JMU defensive coordinator and secondary coach Jim Pletcher. "We were disappointed that he gave up football when he did. The only thing that hurt him was that he missed (practice) repetitions when he was only in track. I think he had a great deal of potential as a football player."

But the potential to be a track standout also was there as Roney quickly demonstrated. In his first true season as a track performer Roney won the indoor IC4A 55-meter hurdles, placed second in the 110-meter high hurdles at the Penn relays and the outdoor IC4A meet and missed only by one position of qualifying for the finals at the NCAA outdoor championship.

Roney added another indoor IC4A hurdles title this past winter and is hoping the experience he has gained will serve him well in this season's major meets. His first-round race was the event's second fastest (13.63 seconds) at last season's outdoor NCAA

meet, but he then missed the finals after not matching the effort in the semi-finals.

"It was a lack of experience," Roney says of not advancing. "Coach Walton said the reason I didn't do well was that I wasn't consistent. I hadn't had enough races at that level."

To get the needed experience Roney has since competed internationally and has run against many of the world's top hurdlers. A meet in which he faced a Japanese foe stands out as he recalls his experience in international competition.

"I didn't speak his language and he didn't speak mine, but we became friends," Roney says. "We communicated with hand signals and after the meet we traded gear."

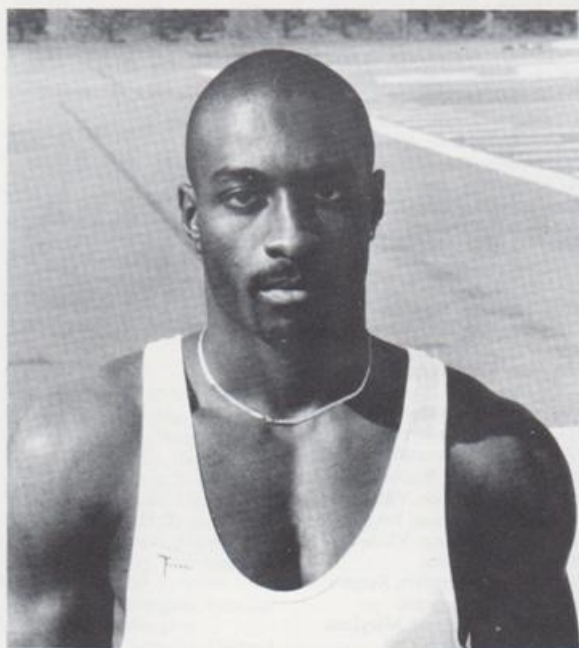
He also must communicate with team members in the 4x100 meter relay, as the Dukes foursome, anchored by Roney, are the defending IC4A champions, having won this event in 40.58 last year at Yale.

"I get the most fun out of the relays," he says. "We get so wired up and have the attitude that nobody can beat us -- you have to be that way to be successful."

Getting to where NO ONE beats him will take some doing, but if Roney doesn't get there, it won't be because of a lack of effort.

"He's intensely driven," says Walton. "He's one of the few athletes I've coached that I've had to hold back in training. He takes care of himself -- rests and eats as he should -- and does all the little things that you must do to be successful."

That attitude already has taken Roney farther than most. And by concentrating his efforts only time will tell what he may yet accomplish.

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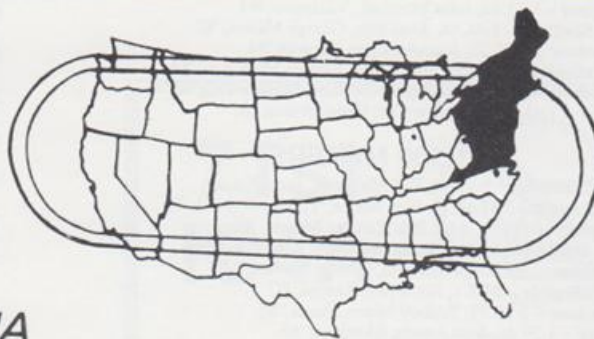

University Profile-

James Madison University

James Madison University has the reputation as a public ivy -- a public school with Ivy League quality.

JMU was ranked in the top 15 comprehensive institutions in *U.S. News & World Report's* regional surveys in 1990, 1989, 1987, 1985 and 1983.

Money magazine's "Money College Guide 1990" ranked JMU 51st in its top 100 public schools for the education dollar.

In 1986 *Money* named JMU one of "Ten Public Colleges with an Ivy Twist." A book by Martin Nemko, "How to get an Ivy League Education at a State University," lists JMU as a sound alternative to costlier private schools.

In March 1988 *Changing Times* rated JMU one of the "Best of the Bargain Colleges." The article listed 24 public colleges and universities that offer excellent academic quality at less than average cost.

JMU is also included in listings of prestigious schools published by Barron's, Peterson's and the *Yale Daily News*.

Founded in 1908 and primarily a women's teachers college until the mid-1960s, JMU is a blend of the traditional and the progressive. The original front campus is built around the Quadrangle, where the buildings are native blue limestone and ivy covers the older buildings.

The back campus features modern athletic facilities, residence halls and a large student activities complex. The construction is red brick, and the style is contemporary.

JMU's academic programs offer the best of the old and the new. They combine the liberal arts tradition with preparation for technology in a rapidly changing world. Critical thinking and writing skills are stressed in required liberal studies courses, and computer literacy is taught within the framework of each student's major course of study.

Students thus receive preparation in the arts, letters and sciences as well as skills necessary for professional success.

JMU is committed to superlative teaching and continually seeks new ways to challenge and motivate students. A freshman seminar encourages critical thinking as students are exposed to classic texts. The course is taught by professors from various disciplines, and classes are small to facilitate discussion and debate.

A focus on international education gives students a global awareness in both liberal and major studies. Studies Abroad offers opportunities to study in London, Paris, Florence or Salamanca, Spain. Foreign students and visiting professors provide diversity within the student body and enhance on-campus exposure to other cultures.

JMU still has a large teacher education program and provides many public school teachers in Virginia. Other programs, however, now attract larger numbers of students.

Approximately one third of JMU students enroll in the College of Business, which has full accreditation at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Other outstanding programs are in music, communication and the sciences, where students often participate in original research with their professors.

JMU students can choose from more than 1,500 courses in nearly 100 fields. The six colleges are the College of Letters and Sciences, the College of Education and Psychology, the College of Business, the College of Fine Arts and Communication, the College of Health and Human Services and the Graduate School.

An extensive student development program provides extracurricular activities and support services to complement the scholastic programs. There are approximately 200 student organizations that range from fraternities and sororities to sports clubs and service groups.

Student enrollment is 11,000, with the number of men and women about equal. The campus comprises 472 acres and 90 major buildings.

The institution became James Madison University in 1977.

An athletic program has existed at JMU almost since the institution's founding, but a men's program didn't begin to fully develop until after JMU became co-educational in 1966-67.

Today, the University sponsors 25 intercollegiate sports -- 13 for women and 12 for men. All compete at the Division I level, and most offer scholarships. JMU is a member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) and the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).

JMU's football team, a division I-AA independent, will begin competing in the Yankee Conference in 1993.

JMU has had tremendous success in its relatively brief athletic existence.

The University's football team has competed in the Division I-AA national playoffs, the men's basketball team has made three NCAA Tournament appearances and has won the Colonial regular season title the last two years, the baseball team is the only Virginia team to have played in the College World Series and the women's basketball team is among the more successful programs in the region.

JMU's women's basketball team this season reached the NCAA "Sweet 16" for the fourth time in six years with a victory over top-ranked Penn State.
