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Profile of a Champion: Cover Story – John Trautmann

"To win the 1991 indoor national team championship" was a major goal cited by Georgetown's two-time All-American John Trautmann, when asked what his biggest objectives were for the 1990-91 track and field campaign. In a sport dominated by individual accomplishments, that kind of objective for one of the country's premier athletes is not commonplace. However, that response is indicative of the character of John Trautmann, who is currently fulfilling his eligibility in indoor and outdoor competition while attending classes on the Hill-top.

Consistently heralded as one of the top distance runners in the country, the Central Valley, N.Y. native is never satisfied with merely crossing the finish line in first place. His team's accomplishments, bettering his personal marks, and looking at the bigger picture are always in the forefront of Trautmann's mind every time the gun sounds. Even winning a national championship wasn't enough for John to declare himself the number one 5,000m runner in the country. After winning the 5,000m race in Durham, N.C. at the Outdoor Nationals last June, claiming the first title for a Georgetown athlete in an outdoor NCAA championship meet since 1972, Trautmann couldn't help but wonder what the outcome would've been had the pace been different. *"I really don't know what would have happened had the pace been faster,"* said Trautmann in his post-race interviews. Quite a humble response from the Georgetown senior who outkicked favorites John Nuttall and Reuben Reina in the last 180 meters to win the race by 10 meters in 14:07.47.

Trautmann sees everything as a stepping stone to something else, emphasizing that "he is never really completely satisfied with his performances." And his list of "stepping stones" is almost endless. One of the top middle-to-long distance runners in the country when he was a senior at Monroe-Woodbury, he set a national record in the 3,000 meters (8:05.8) that still stands. As a freshman, the Georgetown rookie finished 10th in the NCAA Championships in both the indoor and outdoor 1,600 meters. Also known as one of the premier harriers in the country, Trautmann won the 1988 and 1989 BIG EAST Cross Country individual titles, setting a new meet record last season as a senior when he finished the Van Cortlandt course in 24:38.3, leading Georgetown to the team victory. With that race, the Hoya harrier became the first male runner in conference history to win back-to-back individual titles, and only the third runner to win the race twice. As a junior in 1989, Trautmann led the Hoyas to their first IC4A cross country title in 24 years with his second-place performance.

Only one of an elite few in America who can run from 1,500m to 10,000m, Trautmann's accolades don't stop with cross country competition. Trautmann is a three-time indoor BIG EAST champion in the 5,000m race, having captured the event in 1987, 1988, and 1989. He was not able to defend his title in 1990, as he redshirted last year's indoor campaign. In his junior season, Trautmann was voted the BIG EAST Championship meet's outstanding performer, as he garnered the indoor 5,000m as well as the crown in the mile in a then meet-record 4:09.42. In addition to his BIG EAST success indoors, Trautmann won the 5,000m race outdoors as a freshman, and captured that event last year as a senior, as well as competing at the IC4As as the reigning champion in the outdoor 5,000,



having won that event in a meet-record time of 13:45.69 last spring at Yale University, bettering the NCAA qualifying mark by more than 10 seconds.

Georgetown's success is always at the nucleus of Trautmann's endeavors, as winning three Championship of America titles at the prestigious Penn Relays is another of his major objectives for the 1991 season. Leaving the University of Penn's Franklin Field with a relay watch is familiar to the Hoya trackster. As a freshman, Trautmann ran the 1200m lead-off leg of the world record-setting distance medley relay (9:20.96) at the 1987 Carnival. Last year, Georgetown took home two Championship of America titles, winning the distance medley relay and the 4x800m relay, while taking runner-up honors in the 4x1500m. Trautmann anchored the DMR, finding his way clear of a pack of seven runners entering the final turn, and chased down NCAA champion Reuben Reina in the final 120 meters to give the Hoyas the victory in an unusually tactical race. He clocked the 1,600m leg in 4:01.5 seconds, giving the Hoyas a 9:31.47 triumph over the Razorbacks of Arkansas, winners of the last two DMRs and six of the previous seven.

In addition to winning races, John wants to continue to improve his times and become a better runner. While he redshirted last winter's indoor season, he thrived in competitions as a member of the Sallie Mae track club. At the TAC National Championship in Madison Square Garden last February, Trautmann finished fourth in the 3,000m in 7:53.61, his most significant performance since his freshman year in that event, as he shattered his national high school record by 12 seconds. During his tour this summer in Sweden, Trautmann broke 3:40 in the 1,500m, running a personal best 3:39.2, his best time since his freshman year. After he completes his collegiate eligibility this May, Trautmann will continue to train under his mentor of more than four years Coach "Gags", Georgetown's eight-year head coach. Although he has his sights set on an indoor and outdoor national championship, Trautmann's ultimate personal goal is the 1992 Olympics in Barcelona, Spain. *"If there's one thing that all this is geared for, it's the Olympics,"* Trautmann said. *"As a little kid, I've always thought about it."*

It seems as though John Trautmann is well on his way to realizing his boyhood dream. One only wonders if an Olympic medal will convince this modest champion just how good we all know he really is.

The Ismail Brothers: The Best Duo Ever?

Raghib and Qadry Ismail may one day be considered the greatest two-sport brother combination in history. Raghib, the Rocket, is perhaps the most exciting football player since Red Grange or Gayle Sayers. Some say, had he been utilized more fully by Lou Holtz, Notre Dame football coach, his name would already be on a par with those legends. In this year's Orange Bowl game against Colorado, only a highly questionable clipping call prevented Notre Dame's Irish from winning a possible national title. More significantly, it also stopped fans from nominating Ismail for sainthood, a highly unlikely spot for a youngster who can quote the Koran fluently and was raised a devout Muslim.

But, Raghib is more than a football player. Coming out of Meyers High School in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, the immensely likeable youngster was the nation's leading high school indoor sprinter in 1988 with a 6.28 clocking for 55m. On February 9 at Purdue University, he achieved world class status with a 6.07 clocking for the 55m distance. This ranks Ismail 11th fastest of all time and establishes him as the 1991 World Leader. Putting this in perspective, the Rocket is .4 faster than Herschel Walker, Georgia; 1.1 seconds better than Bo Jackson, Auburn; and possibly faster than Bob Hayes. Hayes ran a world-record 5.99 in 1964. However, at the time, electronic timing was in its infancy and the mark has always

carried the notation, "Timing not confirmed as fully automatic."

By exhibiting world-class speed, Ismail has increased his market value significantly. Of more interest to track fans is his Olympic potential. Such conjecture is purely hypothetical since Olympic rules preclude a professional from taking part in track and field. Forget about tennis and basketball. The IOC rules are such a mass of contradictions and confusion that we mere mortals dare not question the directors of sport's greatest playground.

The aforementioned Messrs. Walker and Jackson deeply regretted not having a chance to win sport's highest honor, a place on their country's Olympic team. When asked about Raghib's Olympic potential, Joe Piane, Notre Dame coach responded, "I think it's unfair for a coach to say a kid can make the Olympic team. So many things can go wrong. It's a one in a million shot. But I'll tell you this, he'd have as good a chance as any kid in the country."

But, perhaps not as good as little brother Qadry. The younger Ismail, nicknamed "Missile" by one of the nation's more imaginative sports writers, is on the pad ready for launching. Jim Cross, the retired track coach of Meyer's High School in Wilkes-Barre and mentor to the Ismails, had this to say, "I always thought Qadry was the better track prospect. I still do." Cross bases his belief on the younger Ismail's high school performances.

In 1988 his 13.71 for the 110m HH ranked third in the United States and his 37.56 for the 300m Intermediates is still the Pennsylvania State record. But, the younger Ismail hasn't yet blossomed at Syracuse. Used sparingly by now-departed football coach Dick MacPherson, Qadry has shown flashes of greatness. In 1989, he was named to the ECAC All-Star squad as a kick returner and had outstanding performances against Penn State and Pittsburgh, both of whom contained brother Raghieb far more handily. The 1991 season may see Qadry assuming the role of Raghieb as the featured performer in the punt and kickoff return highlights films.

Track may be the vehicle that carries The Missile to equal prominence with The Rocket. He holds the Syracuse record with a fine 13.67 in the 110m hurdles, despite a commitment to spring football. According to SU Assistant Coach Andy Roberts, "There's no telling how far he could go if he could concentrate solely on track. He recently ran one of the fastest times of the year for the 55m hurdles, 7.27, on just three days of practice!" Despite his success in the highs, Qadry may be in the wrong event. Says Cross, "I always thought he'd be a better intermediate hurdler." Roberts concurs. "Qadry is such a great athlete. The kid can do anything. The only reason we haven't taken him up to the 400m intermediates is football. He just doesn't have the time to get all the base work you need to be successful at that distance."

So, there you have it, the tale of two brothers, both great athletes and fine human beings. But, can they be the greatest brother act of all time? Interestingly, the Ismails have an ace-in-the-hole that could elevate the family to superstar status. There is a third brother, Suleiman. The youngest Ismail was only five when his father died. As a result, he never benefited from a father's influence. Qadry

states unequivocally, "Suleiman has more talent than either of us." Coach Cross issues partial agreement. "He's good, maybe as good, but he has trouble getting focused. If he ever settles down and takes himself more seriously, he could be a great one." Hopefully, he will, but even if he does, the Ismails will have to go a long way to beat this reporter's "Best Bro" combo, two guys named Robinson, Mack and Jackie.

Mack, an Oregon grad and member of the '36 Olympic team, won the NCAA 220y Dash championship in 21.3. Little brother Jackie, UCLA, took the collegiate Broad Jump title in 1940 with a jump of 24' 10-1/2. He also played a little baseball.
