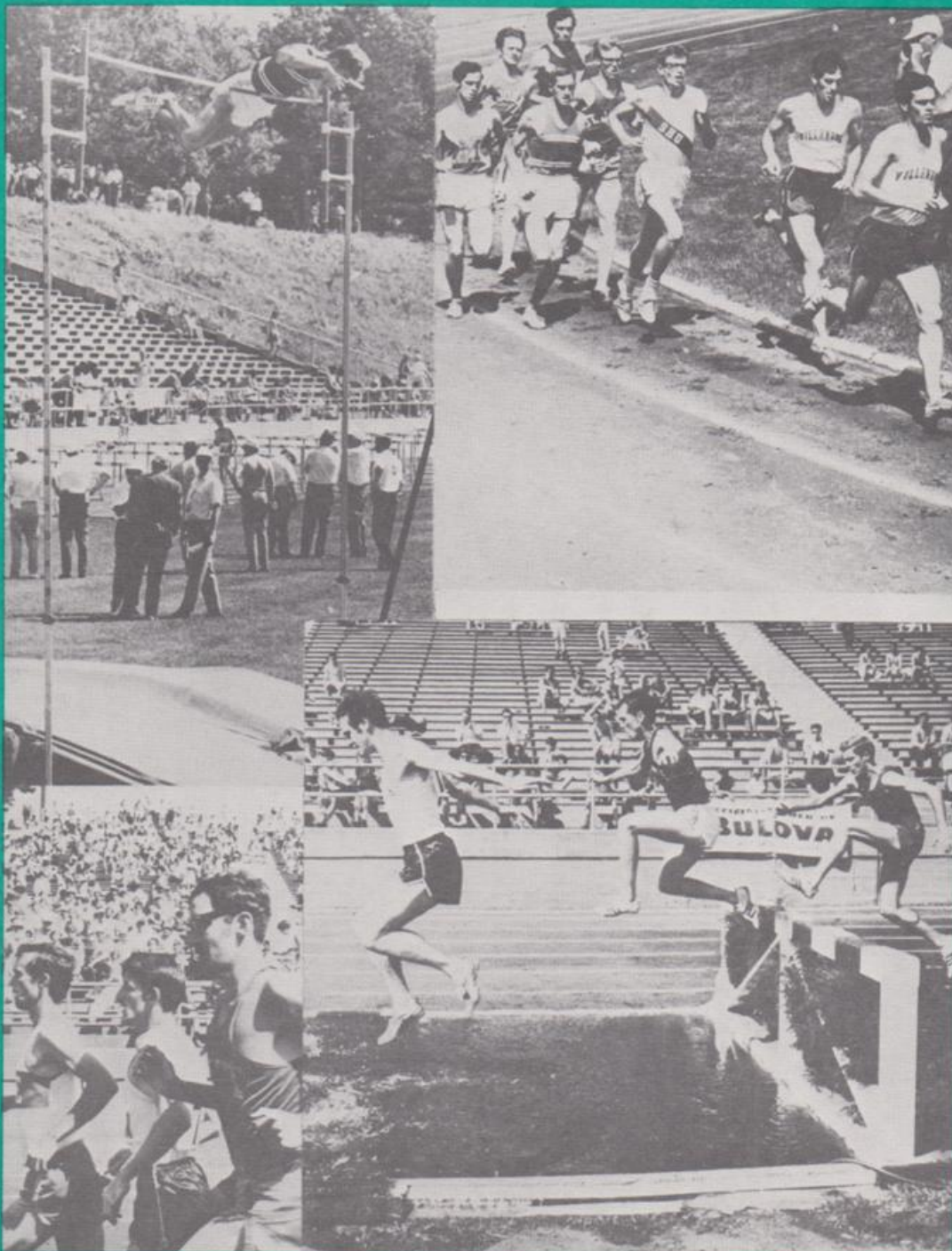

Ninety-six years of I.C.A.A.A.A. History Have Seen Championships Won by 17 Different Colleges—Harvard Leads with 13 Victories

Championship Cup — No. 8



Pennsylvania, which last won a team title in 1920, gained its first leg on the eighth I.C.A.A.A.A. Championship Cup a year ago by scoring 53 points to 40 by Penn State. Pittsburgh was third with 25, while Villanova, which retired the seventh Championship Cup in 1970 and had also won the team title in 1971, was fourth with 23.

Villanova retired the seventh Cup by taking its fifth team title in nine years and it was the second straight time that the Wildcats had retired the Trophy. They captured their first after their 1962 triumph and to earn that one they took the team titles in 1957, 1958, 1960, 1961 and 1962.

In winning the 1972 crown, Pennsylvania took seven first places. Its closest rivals for individual event championships were Penn State, Notre Dame and Pittsburgh, each with two. The Pennsylvania championships were scored in five track events and two field events, with Bruce Collins posting a double in the 220-yard dash and the 440-yard hurdles.

Of the five former cups, two were won by Harvard (which leads in team victories with 13) and one by Yale, Cornell and Southern California.

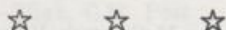

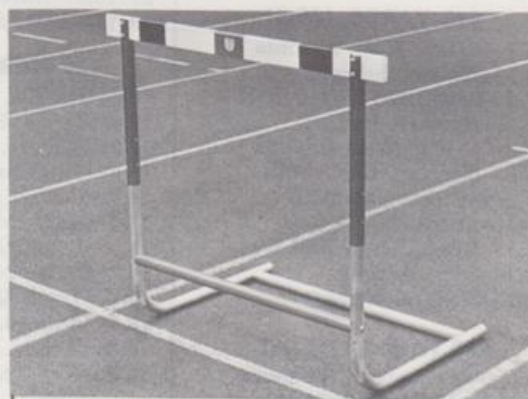
