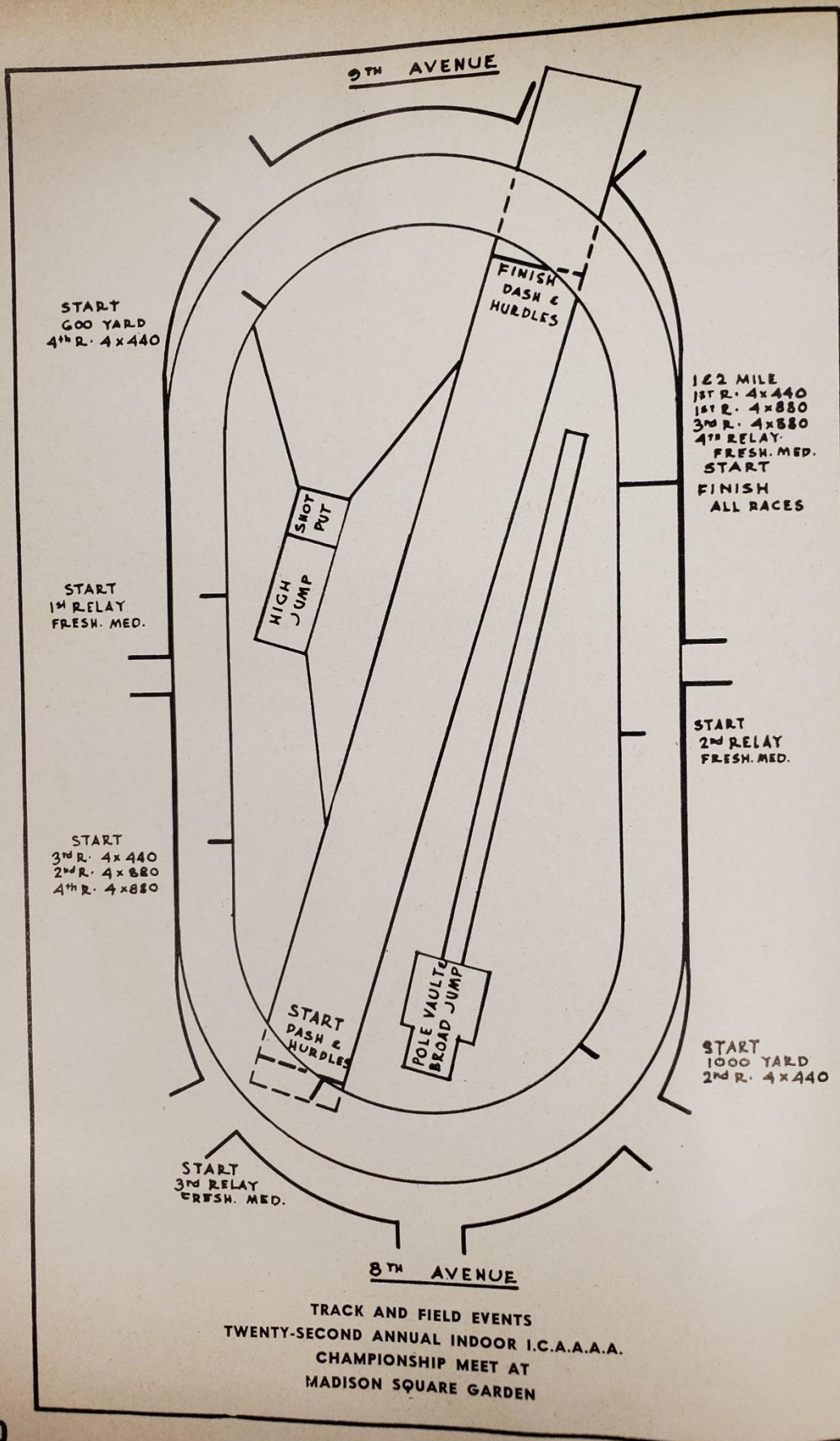


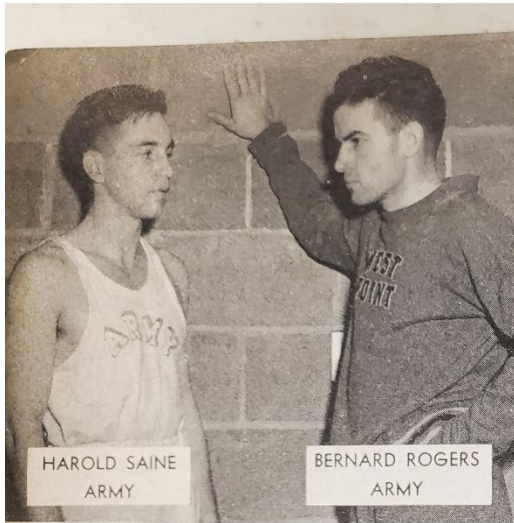
ON THE COVER
