WHAT HAPPENED IN 1968

IN THE MUD and RAIN of the Van Cortlandt Park course, Steve Stageberg, Georgetown senior from Eugene, Ore., reversed the 1967 result and defeated Arthur Dulong, the Holy Cross junior, in the 60th annual University Division championship of the I.C.A.A.A., held on Nov. 18.

In 1967, young Dulong, then a sophomore, broke the meet record by turning in 24:04.4 seconds for the five-mile course, leading Stageberg over the line by 24.6 seconds. But last Fall it was all Stageberg as the Oregon runner passed Dulong and a few others at the 1½-mile mark to a splashing win by 60 yards.

He was clocked in 24:32.4, almost 12 seconds better than Dulong's 24:44. Richard Buerkle, Villanova senior, finished third, thereby leading the wildcats to their third straight team title. Jerry Richey of Pittsburgh was fourth and Frank Shorter of Yale fifth. Villanova had a comparatively easy time taking the team crown, the Wildcats totalling 63 points by placing third, sixth, 11th, 20th and 23rd in the scoring. Georgetown had 86 as its second point scorer, Gregory Ryan, captured the 15th spot.

DESPITE THE WEATHER, this 60th championship drew more than 1,000 athletes from 69 campuses. The college division winner was a sophomore, Ronald Stonitsch, of C.W. Post, and he scored even more impressively than Stageberg had in the university division—at least in margin of victory. The Long Island youth posted 25:48.2 for the five miles after holding a lead of more than 200 yards at the three-mile mark. Ben Wilson of M.I.T. was second in 26:30, or 41.8 seconds behind. He had finished fourth in 1967. Third was Thomas Ratliffe of Gettysburg, followed by James Andrews of Colgate and Joe Ryan of LaSalle in fourth and fifth, respectively.

M.I.T. took the college division team title, scoring 73 points to Springfield's 103 with Colgate third with 130, Lafayette fourth with 135 and Lehigh fifth with 189.

IN THE TWO FRESHMAN events, at three miles, Penn State's Gregory Fredericks won the university division run by one-tenth of a second from Villanova's Don Walsh and the college division event was taken by 10.4 seconds by Lehigh's Timothy Steele, who scored over Dale Keenan of Lafayette.

Team titles were captured by Villanova, with a scintillating 27 to Penn State's 99 in the university division and by Lehigh's 38 to Lafayette's 53 in the college division.

I.C.A.A.A. CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP CUP

Cornell University won the inaugural I.C.A.A.A. championship trophy in 1913 with five victories in six years. It took twenty-three meets before Michigan State captured the second trophy in 1937. Michigan State retired the third championship cup in 1957 with a record of five triumphs in 1948, 1952, 1953, 1956 and 1957. A new cup went into competition with the fiftieth annual varsity run in 1958.

The Spartans with thirteen team championships from 1933 through 1961 are out in front in total team victories and Cornell is second with nine, from 1908 up to 1921. Penn State with seven and Manhattan with five follow in that order.
