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THE I-C's LIKELY SHOW-STEALER

This weekend's 53d annual Intercollegiate A.A.A.A. indoor track championships present this Hollywood script:

Two boys from County Cork in Ireland, one of whom emigrated to Kearny, N.J. at the age of 5, the other recruited as a Villanova student, are seniors at Manhattan and Villanova, respectively, who have won four I.C.4-A. titles apiece, have beaten each other three times in I.C.4-A. championships and now go head-to-head again as champion and chief challenger in the 2-mile run, again as mile anchor men of their distance medley relays on Sunday in New Jersey's most prestigious track meet of the year.

Mike Keogh is the Irish-American who wears Jasper silks; John Hartnett is the Irish Irishman in Villanova's Blue and White.

Hartnett, enjoying his finest season, is the hottest racer in the I.C.4-A. this year. He ran the fastest 2-mile by an I.C.4-A. man when he clocked 8:26.6 to win the K. of C. last month. He posted a meet-record 8:33.6 in taking the Cleveland K. of C. 2-mile. Shifting to the mile and metric mile, Hartnett posted his best indoor mile, 4:02, behind Tony Waldrop, Marty Liquori and Dave Wottle in the Philadelphia Classic, then shattered the American indoor 1500-meter record too with 3:41.5, behind Byron Dyce's 3:40.7, in the U.S. Olympic Invitational. Then to prove a point he won the Toronto mile in 3:59.6, beating Dyce, New Zealand's blue-ribbon Johnny Walker, Liquori, Olympic champion Pekka Vasala of Finland in his first sub-four-minute indoor mile. Outdoors last summer Hartnett had run 3:54.7, one tenth behind Liquori's fastest on Villanova's all-time list.

Keogh is just rounding into top shape after licking a nagging foot injury suffered during cross-country. He's ready to take on his fellow Corkonian.

Their fortunes against each other have had their ups and downs. In their freshman year, 1970-71, Hartnett was second in the I.C.4-A. frosh cross-country run; Keogh 10th. Freshmen were not eligible in the 1971 indoor I.C.4-A. meet. In the 1971 outdoor championships, with freshmen now eligible, Keogh was 2d in the three-mile and 5th in the 6-mile; Hartnett was third in the 3-mile.

In their sophomore year, 1971-72, Hartnett was 5th, Keogh 10th in cross-country; Hartnett was second in the indoor 2-mile; Keogh, with an ailing foot, anchored the Jasper distance medley which didn't place; in the outdoor I.C.4-A. Keogh was an upset winner of the mile in 4:01.6, his best ever in a race he rarely runs except in relays, while Hartnett won the 3-mile.

In their junior year, 1972-73, Keogh won the I.C.4-A. cross-country and set a course record of 24:03.4, with Hartnett third; in the indoor I.C.4-A. Keogh won the 2-mile in 8:43.8, with a sub-par Hartnett fifth, then Keogh ran the anchor mile on the winning distance medley; in the outdoor I.C.4-A. Keogh won the 3-mile after placing third in the 6-mile; Hartnett won the 6-mile and also the steeplechase. As seniors last fall Hartnett won the I.C.4-A. cross-country and broke Keogh's course record with 24 minutes flat, while Keogh, on a tender foot, placed 11th but helped his team to victory.

Keogh has won one National AAU title, taking the 5,000 meters in 1972. Hartnett has yet to win a National (i.e. U.S.) AAU title, though he is Ireland's champion. Both represented Ireland in the Munich Olympics where Keogh was faster than Hartnett, both eliminated in their trial heats.

That should be quite a showdown between them when they take off in the I.C.4-A. 2-mile Sunday at 2:50 p.m. And if their teammates send them off within reasonable distance on the distance medley anchor mile, they'll have another brilliant duel.

Jumbo Jim Elliott, Villanova coach, in nominating Hartnett as well as Kevin McCarey in the 2-mile, figures Hartnett can win the longer race. The Wildcat coach nominated Tom Gregan and Eamonn Coghlan in the mile, reckoning that either may win the mile against defender Denis Fikes of Penn, outdoor mile champion Tony Colon of Manhattan, and Duke's oft-injured Bob Wheeler, 1972 Olympian. Gregan and Coghlan are both Irish imports. Gregan, clocked in 4:04.3 this winter, is running his best since he posted his 4:01.9 behind Keogh's 4:01.6 in the 1972 outdoor I.C.4-A. championships. Coghlan, a sophomore, has run 4:04 this winter as well as 8:47.2 in the 2-mile.

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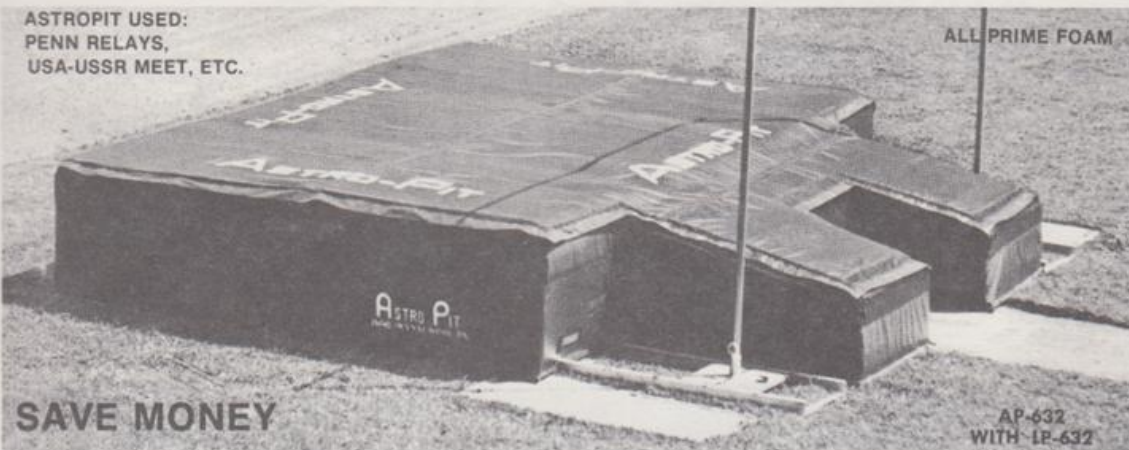
