ECAC History

Founded in 1938, the Eastern College Athletic Conference is the nation's largest collegiate athletic conference with over 270 member colleges and universities ranging from Maine to North Carolina in Divisions I, II and III. ECAC member institutions sponsor over 2,500 varsity teams involving 125,000 male and female student-athletes.

The ECAC manages over 100 championships in 19 men's and women's sports for its membership and is responsible for over 20,000 officiating assignments, a public relations/news bureau and a legislative services department.

The ECAC headquarters, the Asa S. Bushnell Center, is located in Centerville, MA, on Cape Cod. The business of this non-profit organization is conducted at its annual ECAC Fall and Spring Conventions.

A Conference of conferences, the ECAC includes within its organizational structure dozens of leagues and affiliate organizations. Colleges and universities from the Atlantic 10, Big East, Colonial Athletic Association, Ivy League, MAAC, North Atlantic, Northeast and Patriot League, along with schools from the Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York and Pennsylvania State conferences, all hold dual membership in the ECAC.

Over the years, the ECAC has exerted leadership not only at the regional level, but also on the national level with the NCAA. With over 25 percent of the NCAA made up of ECAC members, the Conference plays a leading role in national athletics policy.

Several ECAC administrators have served as both NCAA and ECAC Presidents, including Bill Flynn of Boston College, John Toner of Connecticut and Eppy Barnes of Colgate. Dick Schultz, former NCAA Executive Director, was a member of the ECAC Executive Council when he was AD at Cornell.

The ECAC was founded as the Central Office for Eastern Intercollegiate Athletics with a charter membership of 53 colleges. Commissioner Asa Bushnell molded and guided the organization from its inception until his retirement in 1970, when his long-time associate George Shiebler was appointed successor. Robert M. "Scotty" Whitelaw, who had joined the ECAC in 1960, was named commissioner in 1972 and served in that office for 17 years. In 1989 he was succeeded by current commissioner Clayton Chapman, who began his tenure with the conference in 1971.

One of the most significant events in ECAC history occurred in 1983 with the consolidation of the Eastern Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women into the ECAC structure. With the addition of women's sports, the ECAC doubled the number of its championships.

ECAC Membership Benefits

Championships - The ECAC manages over 100 championships in 19 men's and women's sports in all three divisions as well as eight affiliate championships, including the IC4A Track, EARC Rowing and the new ECAC Intercollegiate Football Conference. Some Championships such as Division I men's ice hockey and women's cross country receive automatic bids to the NCAA Tournament, while others like the ECAC Holiday Festival are special events.

Conventions and Meetings - The business of the ECAC is conducted at the ECAC Fall and Spring Conventions, which provides opportunities for the membership to discuss and vote on common issues and concerns, set regional direction and create a positive college athletic environment. The ECAC Fall Convention on Cape Cod is attended by 300 athletics administrators and includes committee meetings, seminars, schedule-making session, awards luncheon and a trade show.

Internship - The ECAC has established the prestigious Asa S. Bushnell internship program which provides recipients with a perspective on collegiate athletics, primarily through the daily operations of the public relations department and administration of its championships. Candidates must hold an undergraduate or graduate degree from an ECAC institution.

Legislative Services - The Conference maintains a legislative and compliance department to assist its membership in understanding NCAA and ECAC regulations. The Conference sponsors workshops and seminars, processes hardship waivers and administers the NCAA National Letter of Intent.

Public Relations - The ECAC publicizes its member colleges and student-athletes through weekly and postseason all-star awards and compiles weekly standings and statistics in football, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's ice hockey and baseball. The ECAC Service Bureau also sponsors postseason all-star teams in softball and publishes a quarterly ECAC Newsletter, a Directory & Record Book and football and ice hockey media guides.

Officiating - The ECAC provides its members with an opportunity to utilize its officiating assignment services. The ECAC assigns over 4,000 officials in 15 sports in all divisions including baseball, men's and women's basketball, fencing, football, gymnastics, men's and women's ice hockey, men's and women's soccer, wrestling and affiliate championships in crew, cross country, swimming and track.

Sponsorship - The ECAC seeks corporate sponsorship to provide membership benefits such as discounted rates, championship products and sponsorship of conference events and activities. Current major sponsors include Budget Rent a Car, Chevy Dealers of New England, Chemical Bank, Holiday Inn, Ricoh, Spalding and US Air.

Television - Beginning in 1993-94, the Conference resumed an "ECAC Basketball TV Game of the Week", carried on SportsChannel, for both men and women and expanded its TV programming in 1994-95 to include both an ECAC Football and Ice Hockey Game of the Week to be carried regionally and in some cases nationally.

NAJUMA FLETCHER

Najuma Fletcher's accomplishments in amateur track and field are endless. A 1992 Olympian from her homeland of Guyana, she is a 13-time All-American, a 15-time Big East champion, and a two-time NCAA indoor national champion. Entering last week's Big East Outdoor Championships, she was a five-time winner of the conference's Outstanding Field Performer Award.

Sound too good to be true? Read on.

The University of Pittsburgh senior has managed her time well enough to maintain a 3.19 grade-point average in mechanical engineering. She also started tinkering with the violin at age 11, and eventually traveled to Barbados with the National Princeville Orchestra shortly thereafter. How she is able to organize her busy schedule and still attain the level of success she has might be difficult for many to imagine, but to Fletcher, it's no big deal.

"It's probably good that I have so many things to do," she explains. "When you're in college, everything is still more or less structured for you. You have classes to go, studying to do, and tests to take. Since you're required to be places and to do things, it actually makes it easier. If I had so much free time on my hands, I probably wouldn't have been able to do most of the things I've done."

What makes Fletcher's career so noteworthy is that she's done so much of it so far from her home in South America. Although English is the language of Guyana, being away from home for the first time can still be a difficult adjustment for any 18-year-old. But Fletcher has gone about her business with impressive poise and dignity.

"She has the heart of a lion," says the man who has been as close to her as anyone these past four years, Pitt Head Track and Field coach Steve Lewis. "With Najuma, you know you are always going to get the very best effort she has -- and then some -- in whatever she's doing."

While some may consider her trip to the 1992 Olympics in Barcelona, Spain, a crowning achievement in and of itself, Fletcher admits to certain feelings of awe at her inaugural trip to the Games.

"The Olympics are what all the top athletes and

competitors strive for," she says. "Winning an Olympic Gold medal is what you want more than anything. It's very special. There's a certain aura surrounding the Olympics, so in 1992, it was a little intimidating. It's hard not to get caught up in all the things going on around the actual competition."

Along with competing as a heptathlete in the 1992 games, Fletcher lists her NCAA Indoor titles -- 1995 triple jump and 1996 high jump -- as the top athletics achievements in her career, but is especially proud of the honors she received during the annual Senior Awards Banquet in Pittsburgh on April 9. It was there where she received not one, but two prestigious individual awards. Each year Pitt bestows what are known as the Panther Award and the Blue-Gold Awards in recognition of outstanding athletic and academic

achievements. And for the first time in the 57-year history of the awards, one individual -- Najuma Fletcher -- received both awards.

"Receiving those two awards are probably the highlights of my career," she admits. "That was very special to me, and I am very honored and grateful to have been recognized that way."

For the record, past winners of these two awards include the likes of Mike Ditka, Roger Kingdom, Ralph Cindrich and Tony Dorsett.

When Fletcher concludes her collegiate career early next month at the NCAA Outdoor Championships in Oregon, she will be faced with the decision confronting thousands of other college seniors -- What next? For Fletcher, whose name will be etched in stone along Pitt's famous campus landmark, the Varsity Walk, her future isn't (etched in stone).

I have already applied to graduate school, so first I'll have to see if that comes through," she said. "I'm going to miss the lifestyle in college, though. It's somewhat carefree. It's not like you have to report to work at eight o'clock every day. There are still a lot of pressures and responsibilities, but they're of a different nature."

But regardless of what the future holds for one of Pitt's best-ever student-athletes, rest assured she will always give her very best effort -- and then some.

GREG HAUGHTON

Many accolades have been written about Greg Haughton, and many laurels have been cast upon his shoulders - all deservedly so. For few runners have achieved his level of achievement at such a young age.

Haughton, a 22-year old senior from St. Andrew, Jamaica, came to the campus of George Mason in the fall of 1994 already an accomplished 400-meter runner at the international level. As a 19-year old freshman at Central Arizona Junior College, he placed sixth in the outdoor World Championships of Track and Field in Stuttgart, Germany. He ran so well that year, that he was ranked in the top ten in the world in the 400 by *Track and Field News* magazine. That was just a prelude of things to come for the Jamaican wunderkind. The crux of this sensational season was a recruiting call from nearly every college coach at major track & field programs in the United States. However, the persistence of recruiter extraordinaire and fellow Jamaican Dalton Ebanks ensured that Haughton would be donning the green and gold of the Patriots for at least two years.

After the debate on college was decided, Haughton got down to the serious business of proving that 1993 was no fluke. Since there were no major international championships at which for him to prove himself, Haughton concentrated on the collegiate season, where he won his first collegiate title in a seasonal best time of 44.96. Due to the lack of serious international competition, Haughton failed to earn a world ranking for the year. However, this would only motivate him for the upcoming 1995 season, his first at George Mason.

When Greg came to the Fairfax school, he was already a proven talent, but he still needed to polish his skills. At George Mason, he hooked up with Coach Ebanks who converted him from a potential superstar to a current great. The fruits of their union showed almost immediately. In Haughton's second indoor race ever - and first on a banked track - he shattered the collegiate record of 45.72 set by Tyrone Kemp of Florida in 1991 with a time of 45.66. In his next race, he placed second at the NCAA Indoor Championships, losing to Baylor star Deon Minor by one hundredth of a second. Coincidentally, this was the second time that Haughton finished second to Minor in a major championship 400, having previously played second fiddle to him at the 1992 World Junior Championships, in Seoul, South Korea.

Still, that was the last time Haughton would play second fiddle to Minor or any other collegiate

athlete in the 400. Since then, he has been on a tear, proving beyond a shadow of a doubt that he is the best 400 meter runner in college. He won the NCAA Outdoor Championship in a then personal record, 44.62. In between, he picked up an IC4A title in the 200 meters in a personal best time of 20.74.

Although Haughton and Ebanks were secure with their decision, many people felt that he ran the 200 to duck Seton Hall stalwart Kevin Lyles, who won the 400 for the third consecutive year. Coach Ebanks afterwards refuted the notion claiming that "the 400 wasn't in the plan. We were prepping for the NCAA's. Greg had nothing to prove." Furthermore, Haughton dispelled any notions of ducking when he handled Lyles and the rest of the NCAA field rather easily in winning his first NCAA title. He then thrilled the crowd in the 4x400 final as he took a banged up George Mason relay team, and brought them within a hair's breath of knocking

off favorite Baylor, anchored by Haughton's recently deposed nemesis Deon Minor.

After the collegiate season, Haughton's star really shined. He was selected to compete at the World Championships in Goteborg, Sweden for his native Jamaica in the 400 and as a member of the 4x400 relay. In the open 400, he upset all the form charts by grabbing a bronze medal. He also anchored the relay team to a stunning runner-up finish. He went on to be ranked No. 4 in the world by *Track & Field News*.

Indoors this year, Haughton quickly picked up where he left off last summer, recording the second fastest indoor collegiate time ever in the 400 (45.69), and advancing to the NCAA Championships. There, he again proved his collegiate invincibility by cruising to a 45.87 victory over Baylor Sophomore Marlon Ramsey. Outdoors, Greg is looking to expand his sphere of influence by defending his IC4A

200 title and mounting a serious campaign in the 400. He then plans to run both the 200 and 400 at the NCAA Championships. After that, he has the same aspirations as any college senior has - make the Olympic final and win a medal!
