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Shooting for Five:

C.W. Post's Ace Triple Jumper Frank Alston

While eastern track powers Maryland, Fairleigh Dickinson and Villanova fight it out for the team title, it is almost certain that C.W. Post, a Division II school from Greenvale, Long Island, will earn ten points in the team standings, thanks to All-American triple jumper Frank Alston. While the crowd at Jadwin Gym is entranced by the explosive style of John Gregorek and the smooth effortless grace of Solomon Chebor, Alston will be quietly moving toward his fifth IC4A title.

It may seem strange that such a talented athlete chose such a relatively anonymous event as the triple jump. After all, the 21-year-old senior from New Rochelle, N.Y. was an All-State wide receiver for state champion New Rochelle High School.

"I started working out in the long jump following my sophomore football season just to stay in shape," recalls Alston. "I became interested in the triple jump soon after and realized that the event helped my football ability."

At first, Alston was leaping 34 feet for coach Soprano, but began to show vast improvement in each meet. By the end of his sophomore season, he had cleared 41-8.

In 11th grade, Alston became a starter for a 5-5 football team and placed second in New York in the triple jump with a 46-11 leap.

Frank gained national attention from football recruiters when he starred for an unbeaten New Rochelle in his senior year. Over 100 colleges courted Alston following the fall campaign, including powers Pittsburgh, Miami and Syracuse.

However, in the spring season of his senior year, Alston decided to put his entire efforts into the triple jump. It was at the New York State Championships at C.W. Post that he met Vin Lananna, former assistant coach at Post, now head cross-country coach at Dartmouth.

"Our first meeting was not overly cordial," said Lananna. "I told him that he could not wear his spikes on our track. He grimaced, changed his shoes and finished

second in the States with a 48-1 jump."

Alston was taken aback with the beautiful Greenvale campus, and two weeks later called Lananna to see whether he could attend

America's Top Coach —

Princeton's Larry Ellis, 1984 Olympic Leader

Last fall, Princeton Track and Cross Country Coach Larry Ellis had a week that's worth a lifetime.

"October 29th was my birthday," he recalls. "The next day the team won the Heps (Princeton blazed to a 24:30.5 five-man average at Van Cortlandt Park, the best ever for a team in one meet there until Providence eclipsed the record three days later at the IC4A's) and two days after that I found out that the selection committee had named me head coach of the Olympic Team." Ten days later another dividend came his way, his first grandchild.

After years of athletic and administrative work, Ellis has reached the top of his profession. Last fall, his name was one of nearly forty suggested by college and club coaches around the country to TAC (The Athletics Congress) to lead the U.S. team at the 1984 Olympics in Los Angeles. A subcommittee narrowed the field of candidates to nine, and at the TAC staff selection committee meeting on November 1st, he was proposed as their final choice.

Things weren't all wrapped up there, however. It was a close election at the TAC meeting in December, between Ellis and Jim Bush, who would have been a sort of "home coach" as head of the UCLA track program. After a number of votes Ellis was finally ratified, though, for what he calls "the best and most prestigious assignment a coach could have."

That honor, and the whole week of special happenings, were the capstone of 23 years of work, combining careers as a coach, an administrator, and a dedicated family man. In each field he has shown remarkable success. Five years ago, he took over Princeton's reins as head coach, his team won the school's first Heps cross country title ever, and continued its success with victories in four of the next five years. In 1980 his track team won Princeton's first ever Heptagonals indoor track title, and in 1981 its first Heps outdoor title since 1938.

As an administrator, he has a range of credentials, from former chairman of Princeton's Minority Affairs Committee, to

founding the successful Princeton Indoor Relays, to serving as President of the IC4A Coaches Association.

As a family man, Ellis has raised and sent three daughters through college (to Suffolk University, Wellesley College, and Emerson College in Boston) and his son is presently a philosophy major at North Carolina-Chapel Hill.

In 1953 he began his career in education, teaching in a Harlem all-boys junior high. After earning his Master's in Secondary Education, Ellis was set to re-enter athletics. He moved to Jamaica High School in Queens where he took over as track and cross country coach.

There, Ellis began to show his flair for organizing a strong program, and motivating athletes. Taking over a team with less than 20 members, he built it to almost one hundred by 1965. His teams compiled dual meet records of 26-6 in cross country, and 62-8 in track and numerous Invitational meets.

During that time he also cultivated his involvement on the AAU level, as a coach for the NY Pioneers Track Club, and on the managing level as President of the Queens HS Track Coaches Association.

When Peter Morgan retired as Head Coach at Princeton in 1970, the athletic department underwent an extensive search for his replacement. After Ellis was named, despite his qualifications a furor arose when one rival for his job cried "reverse-discrimination" to the press. As the first black head coach in any sport in the Ivy League, newspapers focused more on his color than his record; as he told one reporter, he was "definitely in the middle" of a "pressure" situation.

Fortunately, the Princeton track teams showed a marked improvement in his first year, tying for third in the Heps Indoor Championships, and placing second outdoors - its best finish in over two decades. After his second year, when his cross-country, indoor and outdoor track teams all placed in the top four teams at the respective Heps championships, and he founded the Princeton Relays as a major Indoor meet, people finally began taking note of Ellis for his success and work. In the winter of 1973, he was named as an alternate to the U.S. Olympic Committee for Track and Field. Things began to happen fast, as he was named an assistant coach for the U.S. men's team for an indoor dual meet with the USSR that March, and then that summer he was picked to head the U.S. team for the Pan-Pacific games.

Ellis' reputation as a coach grew with the increased success of his cross country and track teams, and as an administrator with the rise of the Princeton Relays, and his fine work in many areas. At the University, his service on Minority Affairs and Special Education committees emphasized his dedication to public service, which had begun with his work in Operations Crossroads Africa and the Office of Economic Opportunities "Operation Champ" while teaching at Jamaica HS. Nationally, his stature in the AAU was boasted by his work on the U.S. Olympic Development Committee, the USOC Athletics Committee, and the AAU Track and Field Rules committee. In 1978 he was the head coach for the U.S. track and field squad in its dual meet against the Soviet Union, as our national team came out on top for the first time since 1969.

With that victory, he gained his first real national attention, and in 1980 he was elected President of the IC4A Coaches Association. His term in office was a rocky one, with conflicts over the dilution of the IC4A track quality with top schools like Rutgers, Penn State and West Virginia leaving the ECAC in a revenue dispute. Through petitioning of the coaches, and bargaining with the outside schools, Ellis presided over the return of the IC4A's to its previous status as one of the finest championship meets in the country.

Ellis' biggest coaching assignment came last summer before he got the tap for the Olympics. As coach of the U.S. team to the World University Games, he made many of the intricate planning and organizational decisions of an overseas trip by a U.S. team. Even here he had already gained experience from his Princeton tenure, having taken a combined Princeton-U.S. Military Academy team to compete against Oxford and Cambridge in England the previous summer.

As he admits, though, the Olympics position is his finest success. At this point Ellis, as Head Track Coach of one of the finest non-scholarship programs in the country, is firmly fixed as a man at the top of his field, with his new appointment to the U.S.'s most coveted coaching spot.
