And... IT'S A PHOTO FINISH!

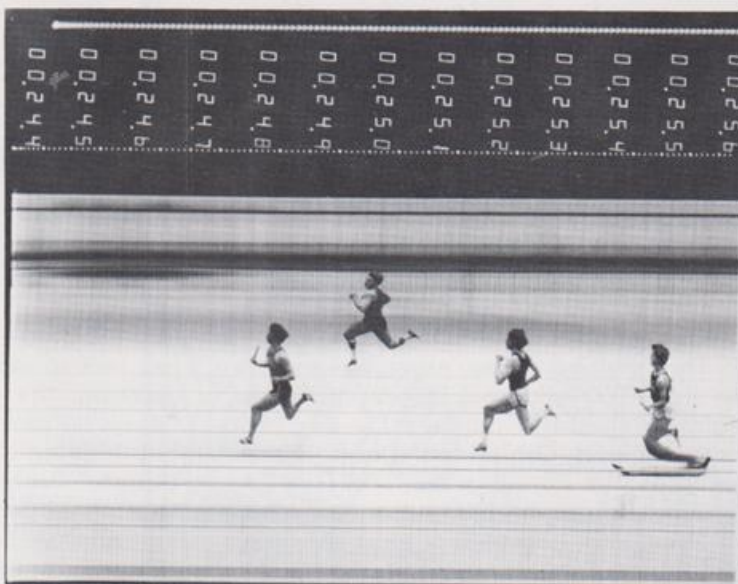
Have you ever wondered just how the judges sort out the order of finish of a 55 meter dash when every competitor seems to be finishing at the same time? Although the experienced judges perform a very credible job of placing the athletes, there are instances when the use of a picture of the finish, places the position of the athlete without much argument. The picture also has the fully automatic time for each competitor.

The phototimer is a special instrument manufactured in Texas under the name of ACCUTRACK. This sophisticated camera provides the judges, or rather the Photo Evaluators, with a picture from which can be determined the exact order of finish and the automatic times for each of the competitors to the nearest 100th of a second. (World records for races up to and including the 400 meter races are recorded in 100ths of a second).

This unit owned by Princeton University has been in use for five years, serving such meets as the Princeton Relays, the Millrose Games, the Vitalis/U.S. Olympic Invitational, the AAU/Athletics Congress Indoor Championships, the Penn Relays, the IC4A Outdoor Championships, the N.J. Olympic Track Classic, the Empire State Games, the Eastern A.I.A.W. Indoor & Outdoor Championships, the Colgate Games, the International Freedom Games as well as today's Indoor IC4A Championships.

As you watch today's races, focus your eyes on the people and apparatus in the finish line area. There are the judges and the timers and two ominous-looking grey tubes mounted atop small tripods at each side of the finish line. Behind the judges and timers is a three-story tower. On the second level is located the business end of the ACCUTRACK camera and the phototiming technician. The trackside tripods are wired to the camera.

To explain the workings of the phototiming system, three operations have to be mentioned separately. First, there is the timer start mode where the electrical impulse that starts the clock in the camera is transmitted along a wire from the little black box attached to the Starter's wrist near the



pistol. As the cartridge is detonated the percussion initiates an electrical impulse. Second, there is the finish mode where the light beams trackside send an electrical impulse to begin taking pictures. Third, there is the picture mode where the camera takes a picture of both the competitors and the time. The camera has a specially designed, moving film cartridge to accomplish this work. The Photo Evaluator then records and reports the results of each event.

The camera provides the Evaluator with a 4 x 5 Poloroid picture of the finishers of each race along with their respective times. The picture must be inserted in a frame and "read" by moving the slide so that the vertical line matches a runner with a timing dot. So that you may experience the work of the Evaluator, we have provided a sample picture (actual size) above. Using the edge of the opposite page of this program, try matching the runner with his time. Remember, the page edge must be perpendicular to the row of timing dots. The time can be read directly from the minutes, seconds and tenth of seconds shown as numerals on the photograph. The long row of dots under the tenth of second numeral represent the hundredth of second divisions, and each fifth one is slightly larger to aide in counting. When you match the torso of the runner with the timing dot, you then know the athlete's time for that race. Simple, is it not?

Andy Boyajian of Hasbrouck Heights, NJ can be found almost every weekend at the finish line of a major track meet serving as the chief phototimer. He's a veteran official of many big championships including the IC4A's and the Millrose Games.

It's spelled

"E-P-H-R-A-I-M S-E-R-R-E-T-T-E"

Now that he has firmly established himself as one of this country's top collegiate sprinters, Ephraim Serrette hopes people will start spelling his name correctly.

It's been a glorious winter for the Fairleigh Dickinson University junior who will be looking to defend his 60 yard dash crown at the IC4A Championships at Jadwin Gymnasium this weekend.

The Trinidad & Tobago native has won dash titles at the CYO Invitational, Philadelphia Classic, Knights of Columbus Invitational at Cleveland, Edmonton Journal Games and Ottawa Citizen Games.

Serrette is also the 1980 indoor New Jersey and Metropolitan Intercollegiate sprint champion. Last January, Ephraim took his specialty for the Metropolitan Conference All-Stars in a dual meet with the Greater Boston Conference at Harvard.

Despite all of his noterity, however, Serrette

still suffers from an identity crisis. Since coming to FDU, his name has been spelled 13 different ways.

"Listen, I'm not a publicity hound or anything like that," said Serrette, who represented his country at the 1979 Pan American Games in Puerto Rico. "But I just want to be recognized for what I do.

"Sometimes I have felt like wearing a sign on my back so people would know who I was," he went on. "It's really a very frustrating thing to always see your name destroyed."

"A couple of times at meets I haven't been able to distinguish my name when the public address announcers reads the finalists for a race," said Ephraim. "I just hope that my success this year will put an end to all of those problems. I know my name isn't as easy as Tom Jones but I don't think it's that hard to remember either."

Serrette attributes his impressive showing this season to a rigorous training program he began last September.

"My first two years here at FDU were kind of disappointing," said Ephraim who defeated 1976 Olympic 100 meter dash champion Hasely Crawford at the Trinidad National Championships as a high school senior. "I had one pulled hamstring muscle after another.

"I just had a problem adjusting to the weather in the States," he continued. "Back home it's 85-90 degrees every day and I found it hard to run when it's 30 degrees in the spring. But I think all of my misfortunes are behind me now."

After the IC4A's, Serrette's next major objective will be trying to win an NCAA title in Detroit, March 14-15. FDU Coach Russ Rogers feels his star pupil has as good a chance as anybody else.

"Ephraim certainly has the credentials, that's for sure," said Rogers. "He has beaten the best this winter. Ephraim has finished ahead of former Olympians Harvey Glance and Steve Riddick and Jerome Deal of Texas El Paso, who won the NCAA 100 meter dash title last year.

"All he really needed was confidence in himself and all his victories this season gave him that. He can more than hold his own in any race he runs."

For the present, however, Serrette's major concern is winning his second straight IC4A Championship.

"This weekend means a lot to me," said Ephraim. "Last year's title was my first big win and it always will be something special. I set a meet record in that race of 6.27 and I'd like to top that this year."

Serrette's best time this season is the 6.17 he registered in winning the Philadelphia Classic.

"My goal is to one day break the world record," said Ephraim. "I don't think it's out of reach either."

Who knows, if he does that maybe his name even will be spelled the right way.

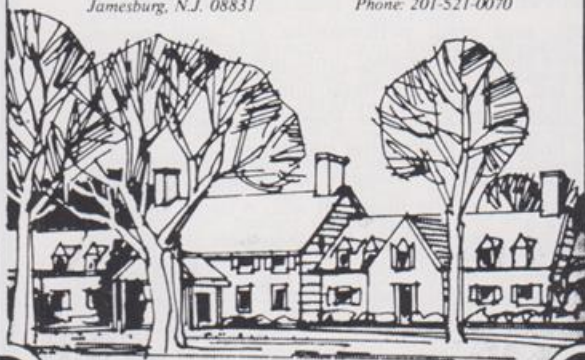

Princeton, in what had become the simplest of head-to-head competitions. Princeton, behind by 6 points, had to take first and second places to win, while Randolph had to break up that monopoly in any fashion to insure the Quaker victory.

With two jumps per competitor left, it was Brostrom in the lead, followed by Randolph and Gray. Gray came up with his best leap of the day, to take the lead, with 49' 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ ", putting the pressure on Randolph, who fouled on his second- to-last try. Then Brostrom, who had placed but not won in each of the last three meets, came up with his best performance of the year, 49' 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ", to regain first place and move teammate Gray to second. With all eyes on Randolph, the last jumper in the competition, readying for his last jump, he fell short of the two others - and Princeton had won by 3" over his best jump. The Tigers had claimed their first Heptagonals Indoor win, 56 $\frac{1}{3}$ to 55 $\frac{1}{3}$, while Navy took third in 41, Cornell 4th with 40 $\frac{1}{3}$, in a meet sure to be long remembered for both its thrilling climax, and exceptional performances.

Phil Ponebshek, a junior member of The Princeton Track Team from San Antonio, TX, is a student assistant in the Princeton Sports Information Office. He was one of five finalists in the selection for the representative of the State of Texas for the Olympic Torch carrier to Lake Placid in February.

FLASHBACK TO MASBACK

Princeton's Craig Masback '77, who won the AAU Indoor Mile last Friday at Madison Square Garden, catapulted himself into prominent position on the international track scene with a sensational summer of '79. Masback, studying on a Keasbey Scholarship at Trinity College, Oxford, England, lowered his personal best in the mile seven seconds, to 3:54.7 last June. Only 17 days later, when Sebastian Coe set a new world record in the Golden Mile, Masback finished third in 3:52.1. That time makes him the third fastest American miler of all time - only Steve Scott, in that same race, and former world record holder Jim Ryun have gone faster - and seventh best ever in the world. Then in August, when Coe set a new world record in the 1500 meters, Masback finished second in a personal-best time of 3:36.9. Masback still holds Princeton indoor and outdoor records for both the mile and 1500 meters. He set the indoor mile mark of 4:01.8 in the 1977 IC4A's.

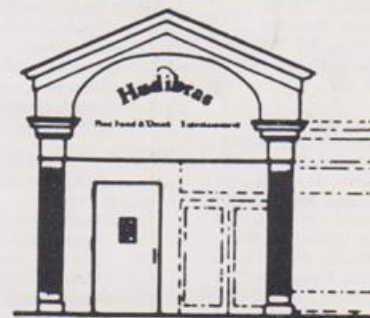
