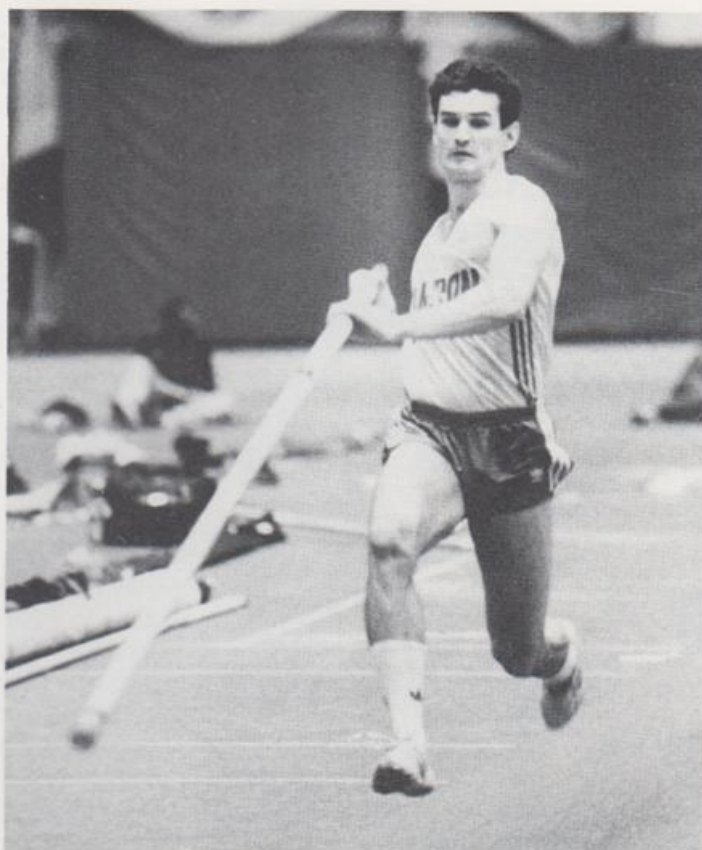

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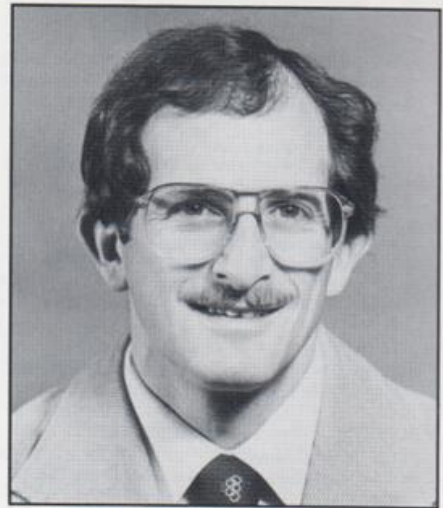

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Larry to Fred... the "baton is passed"

Fred Samara, Princeton

Probably the most exciting thing about this year's Super Bowl was the commercials. And of those elaborate advertisements the most intriguing was the series of spots featuring "Dan and Dave," and the showdown they are expected to have in the Olympic decathlon this summer in Barcelona. One reason for the success of Dan O'Brien and Dave Johnson and the resurgence of the United States as an international power in the decathlon is the often overlooked involvement of Princeton head coach Fred Samara.

Samara, himself an Olympian in the event in 1976, is the national decathlon chairman for The Athletic Congress, track & field's governing body in the U.S. Samara played an active role in developing the VISA sponsorship for American decathletes. Funding and programs sponsored by VISA have given American decathletes better opportunities to prepare for the Olympics and other international competitions, and it has already shown in the athletes' performances and scores.

As if coordinating the national decathlon program for TAC were not enough, Samara has recently taken over full head coaching duties of the Princeton track & field team, having previously been the head field events coach for the team. Longtime head coach Larry Ellis is still with the program, heading the cross country squad and helping out during the indoor and outdoor seasons.

A 1973 graduate of the University of Pennsylvania, Samara was a two-time All-America in the decathlon, and also won the 1975 AAU national title. He's been with the Princeton program for 15 years now, and over that time he has coached All-Americans in the throws and jumps. For more than a decade the Tigers have consistently placed among the top 10 teams in the IC4A championships. In 1982 the Tigers won the indoor title and three years later they finished second outdoors.

There is a group of current Princeton athletes who could propel their team to high finishes this year and have the potential to make an impact on the NCAA level. Omar Simmons is the defending IC4A 800-meter champion, having won last year's title in a then-school record 1:50.35. Already this season he has lowered that mark with a 1:49.70 against Harvard and Yale. Teammates Jay Richards and Kevin McGuire are among the best in the East in the high jump and pole vault, respectively. Richards has been consistently over seven feet this season and looks ready to approach his personal best of 7'3". No stranger to NCAA competition, he competed at both the indoor and outdoor championships last year. McGuire cleared 17'3" last summer, making him the East's second best pole vaulter behind World Championships silver medalist Istan Bagyula of George Mason. McGuire has been injured this winter and will be focusing on the outdoor IC4As to be held at Northeastern University, May 22-24.

Having been both a competitor and coach in the IC4As, Samara is very enthusiastic about the tradition and competitiveness associated with the meet. "When I was in college and I went the IC4As I looked forward to competing against people from other parts of the country," he said. "The great thing about this meet is that it brings in so many different teams. Southern teams and teams like Notre Dame really add to the flavor of the meet. We have a lot of recognizable schools here." His experiences with the U.S. decathlon program have left him eager to take advantage of the IC4A membership's visibility in promoting the meet.

One factor that will certainly help intensify an already high-quality meet will be the new look Jadwin Gym is sporting this year. The old track and runways have been replaced with a new, softer surface. The wider radius of the now 200 meter oval will also make it easier to run around. "The old track was a great track," Samara noted, "but it had definitely seen better days."

As if all this was not enough to keep Fred Samara's hands full, he will also be coaching the decathletes and throwers in Barcelona this summer. While he admits he is constantly on the go, he certainly does not regret the extent of his involvement in the sport. "You have to seize the opportunities when you can," he said.

So when Dan and Dave are slugging it out in Stadio Olimpico this summer, you can be sure Fred Samara will be keeping busy behind the scenes.

Profile of a Champion: Cover Story - Istvan Bagyula

The seven year old boy leaned against the fence and watched, enraptured by the sight of strong young men racing down a runway, planting a pole into a box and soaring high into the air. Day after day he returned. Finally one of those daring young men came over and asked the boy if he'd like to try it. He nodded, "Yes." Thus was launched the pole vaulting career of Istvan Bagyula, George Mason's six-time All-American, four-time NCAA and IC4A champion, silver medalist at the 1991 World Championships and the #2 ranked vaulter in the world. "I don't remember what was the first height I ever cleared," but I do know my personal best at the end of the year was 1.92m (6'3.5). He's gotten a little better.

"In the beginning I didn't take it too seriously," he remembers. "It was fun, something to do but did I think it would lead to this? No, nothing like that." By the time he was twelve Bagyula began to realize he was something special. "I was a lot better than the other kids my age." He began vaulting seriously. He became a member of the Csepel Sports Club where he met the man who would be the force behind his success, Endre Gagyí. Gagyí has been Bagyula's coach since the beginning. However, the relationship has not always been without its perils. Gagyí defected and moved to Sweden. Their friendship continued and in 1987 Gagyí wrote a letter to George Mason University asking if they would be interested in acquiring his protegee as a student. Joe Showers, then an assistant at Mason recalls, "Sure we were interested but there were so many obstacles. His transcripts were in Hungarian, he hadn't taken the SAT's, there was a language barrier, all sorts of stuff." But GMU acted while others hesitated. "We felt he was a tremendous prospect and worth the effort," Showers continued.

Meanwhile Bagyula kept getting better. In

1984, at age 15, he cleared 16', the following year, 17' and in 1986, the seventeen year old went over the bar at 18'0.5! (NOTE: The American record for age 17 is 17'6 held by Brent Burns of Lafayette, California.) In 1988, competing at the World Junior Championships in Sudbury, Canada, Bagyula engaged in a titanic struggle with Maksim Tarasov of what was then the USSR with the young Hungarian winning at a World Junior record of 18'6.5. Ironically Tarasov has been the King of the indoor vault this season twice besting Bagyula, both clearing 19'1 at the Millrose Games, with Tarasov coming out on top due to fewer misses and at the Mobil 1 meet at George Mason where Bagyula could only manage 18'8 to Tarasov's 19'1.

Showers went to Sudbury to make sure the recruiting process was going smoothly. Earlier it hadn't. Bagyula had to take the SAT tests, an NCAA requirement, before he could enter George Mason. Arrangements had been made for him to travel from his home in Budapest to Vienna, the European testing site. As luck would have it, there was a huge traffic tieup at the border and by the time it cleared it was too

late, the test had begun. A lesser school might have thrown in the towel but John Cook hasn't built a dynasty by luck. But it's helped. Bagyula had qualified for Hungary's Olympic team and would compete in Seoul. This prevented him from entering Mason and gave him additional time to take the required SAT's. He took them, scored amazingly well for someone with a limited command of English, and entered GMU in January '89.

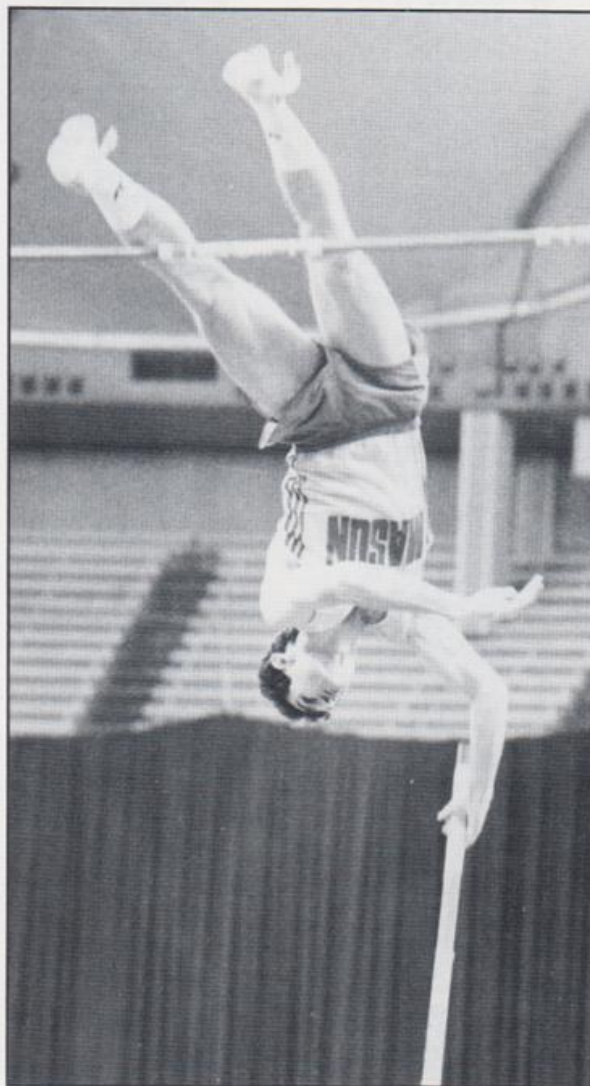
Accompanying him was his friend and mentor Gagyí who became parttime assistant at Mason. Their progress continued and the youngster moved up the ranks of world-class vaulters. In 1991, he set an NCAA indoor record of 19'0.75. He topped that by setting a new collegiate outdoor mark of 19'5 while competing in France. From there he went to the World Championships in Tokyo as a contender. The bar reached 19'4.25 and Bagyula cleared, the only man in the competition to do so. Old rival Tarasov failed as did defending champion and world record holder Sergey Bubka on his first, and only, attempt. Bubka was in deep trouble and knew it. He passed his final two attempts at 19'4.25 choosing to make an all or nothing effort at 19'6.25. He missed his first try. Bagyula knew that one more failure by Bubka and Hungary would have her first World pole vault champion. But you don't tug on Superman's cape and you don't mess around with Sergey. He brushed the bar, Fate smiled, the bar stayed on and Bagyula had to "settle" for second.

After a few weeks off to rest, the #2 vaulter in the world returned to practice. Bad move. While working on a technique drill, quick-stepping over hurdles with the top bar removed, Bagyula tripped and smashed his nose on the naked hurdle post. The break was severe enough to require surgery and forced Bagyula to miss four weeks of practice.

While recuperating he spent time coaching the young Mason vaulters. "He's probably the nicest guy on the team and he's got a great sense of humor," commented Braxton Davenport, a freshmen vaulter on the GMU squad. Stu Shepard, another young vaulter, added, "For a guy who's so great he's quiet, almost humble, but confident." "Very confident," echoed vault

official Jim Keyes.

What does the future hold for him? Bagyula shrugs, "I can't see into the future, if I could I wouldn't be here talking to you, I'd be someplace filling out lottery tickets." Will he stay in the United States after graduation? "No," he replies firmly, "I'm going home." Hungary's gain will be a loss to America, a big loss. A century ago people like Istvan Bagyula came to this country and helped make it the greatest nation in the world. Let's hope that Bagyula changes his mind, we need people like him. If not, well, after four IC4A victories, a possible fifth today and maybe number six this spring, Bob Hope said it best, "Thanks for the memories."
