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The IC4A Launches 2nd Century of Track

In the Souvenir Program of the I.C.4-A's Centennial celebrated on Franklin Field a year ago, it was written:

"Nothing can happen in the 100th outdoor championships to alter the standing (in a listing of colleges which had won the most team titles--indoor, outdoor and cross-country-- in the first century of the I.C.4-A.) unless Pennsylvania, the host, were to achieve a near-miracle upset of Seton Hall, Villanova and Maryland, and thereby vault over Harvard into fourth place."

As it happened, after much excitement, Maryland won the team title with 94 points--on a 10-8-6-4-2-1 scoring system which had been adopted in 1975. Maryland, though, was the only team that stood between Penn and the "near-miracle upset".

True, the Quakers were 25 points from the championship, but Ed James' stunning sprint double and Howie Schwab's 18 hurdles points spearheaded the second place finish for Penn ahead of Seton Hall's 59, Villanova's 52 and Northeastern's 43.

Jim Tuppeny justifiably was elated. The Penn coach made a special visit to the Press Box as soon as the meet ended to chide the author of the paragraph above: "We almost gave you that near-miracle."

Well, if that was a gentle reminder from Tuppeny to take nothing for granted in the I.C. 4-A., we are not about to forego a lifetime habit of trying to anticipate results in the venerable Intercollegiate.

It may not take a miracle to dethrone Frank Costello's Marylanders who are in quest of their fifth outdoor I.C.4-A. trophy. But it will take a more astounding effort than we can foresee from Villanova, the I.C.4-A. indoor champion and 11-time outdoor champion, to win this meet for the first time since 1971.

We base our calculations on what's been happening this spring.

Maryland, in winning the Atlantic Coast Conference title for the 22nd straight year, produced the "best-ever performance" by a Maryland track team. So said Costello, who wasn't necessarily suggesting that his Terrapins would perform as well in the I.C.4-A. A 67-college meet like the I.C.4-A. is something else again.

Maryland, however, is fully prepared for the assignment. The College Park troops, typically, are loaded in the field. Of their field scorers a year ago who accounted for 79 of the total 94 points (we assign the decathlon to the field

events), all but two-- decathlon winner Al Hamlin and long and triple jumper Neville Sinclair, who bagged 12 points--are back again. That leaves 57 returning points. Jim Kirby won the javelin, Tom Andersson the shotput with a fourth in the discus, John Davenport and Dennis Ivory were one-two in the long jump, Scott Hersh second in the discus, Brian Melly third in the high jump and Larry Long sixth in the triple jump.

All of them return to Franklin Field with performances this spring better than last year and have that valuable asset of experience. Kirby, a senior whose victory last year redeemed his failure to qualify as a sophomore, has the biggest bulge on his I.C.4-A. rivals of any of the competitors here. His 262-6 toss to win the A.C.C. title last month set an I.C.4-A. collegiate record, he won at the Penn Relays and he has been in the 250s consistently. No challenger reached 240 until Yale's Kent Womack unfurled a 242-9 in the Heptagonals.

In the mid-May listing, nine Marylanders in seven events had registered marks better than anyone else in the I.C.4-A. set. The "seeded" men don't necessarily win, but the credentials are persuasive for Kirby, 262-6 javelin; Ivory and Davenport, 25-4½ and 24-9¾ long jump; Melly, 7-2 high jump, Brad Turley, 16-0½ pole vault, Ian Pyka and Andersson, 61-5½ and 60-1½ shotput, Hersh, 176-5 discus, and Greg Robertson, 13.6 high hurdles. Pyka, then a transfer, Turley and Robertson did not score a year ago. They represent reinforcements to replace Hamlin and Sinclair. Kirby, Davenport and Andersson were winners a year ago; Ivory, Pyka and Robertson were winners in the indoor I.C.4-A. last March when the team title went to Villanova. What moves Maryland up and Villanova down in the switch to outdoors is two additional field events, notably the javelin and discus. Additionally, the fitness chart favors Maryland. Villanova's Don Paige, who won the 1000 indoors, is not entered, a victim of a stress fracture for the second straight outdoor season. Villanova's Nate Cooper, who bounced back from an injury for a surprising victory in the indoor triple jump, pulled again a month ago and will have to bounce back again, while Greg Eckman, a member of the indoor mile relay winners, also is hurting. He can be replaced in the 1600-meter relay, but not in the 400-meter hurdles.

Balance between track and field is useful if not always essential in the I.C.4-A. Villanova has won I.C.4-A. team titles without field points, and Maryland, it is

apparent, could have won the outdoor team title last year without its track points. Costello would rather not rely on doing that again. He is looking for points from Robertson in the hurdles, from sprinter Andre Lancaster and quarter-miler Gerald Johnson perhaps, from his 400 and 1600-meter relays and anything at all in longer races.

Villanova as usual will make its run for the I.C.4-A. Cup with Jumbo Elliott's blue-chip racers, who are not dominant in the style to which Wildcat followers are accustomed. Even Mark Belger, the bell-wether 'Cat from North Bellmore, L.I., who had lost to no one, as we write this, in the half or 1000 this year, faces formidable opposition in quest of his first outdoor I.C.4-A. title. (Now a junior, he won his first indoor 880 in March). Bucknell's Tom McLean, coming off the basketball court late in the indoor season, has kept a low profile to date, running relays mostly. Remember, though, that his I.C.4-A. championship and collegiate record 1:45.3 beat Belger in the 800 last year, and McLean repeated in the N.C.A.A. Can McLean come back to that 1972 form? In any case, the McLean-Belger duel, plus Northeastern's Mark Lech and Fordham's Jim DeRienzo among others, looms as one of the highlights this weekend.

If Belger is Villanova's best bet, what are Elliott's chances of picking up his 12th outdoor and 33rd overall I.C.4-A. team title? Jumbo has strong contenders in defender Tim Dale and Glenn Bogue in the 400 (where Adelphi's Kevin Price is the chief threat--all three ran 45 and change in relay stints at the Penn Relays); Tiny Kane in the 1500 meters (against Princeton's indoor I.C.4-A. mile champion Craig Masback and Duke's Richie Schwartz); Ed Takacs, who won the I.C.4-A. 880 two years ago; freshman Derrek Harbour, who could be a factor in the sprints and is a 24-foot long jumper besides. Villanova has the two fastest relays to date. It is vulnerable to Cornell, Seton Hall, Fairleigh Dickinson and Adelphi in the 400; all but impregnable in the 1600 against Adelphi's challengers. John Burns and Dean Childs are Villanova prospects in the distance races.

In sum, not enough Belgers to make Villanova a winner against the Maryland whales and leapers, but if anyone is going to frustrate the Terrapins it will have to be the Wildcats.

Villanova's gold-medal streak, however, is almost certain to continue. For 22 consecutive years, at least one Villanova has turned up as a champion in this outdoor gala.
