Dartmouth was victor in '43, Navy in '44, Army in '45, New York University in '46 and Michigan State in '48. Five legs are necessary for permanent possession.

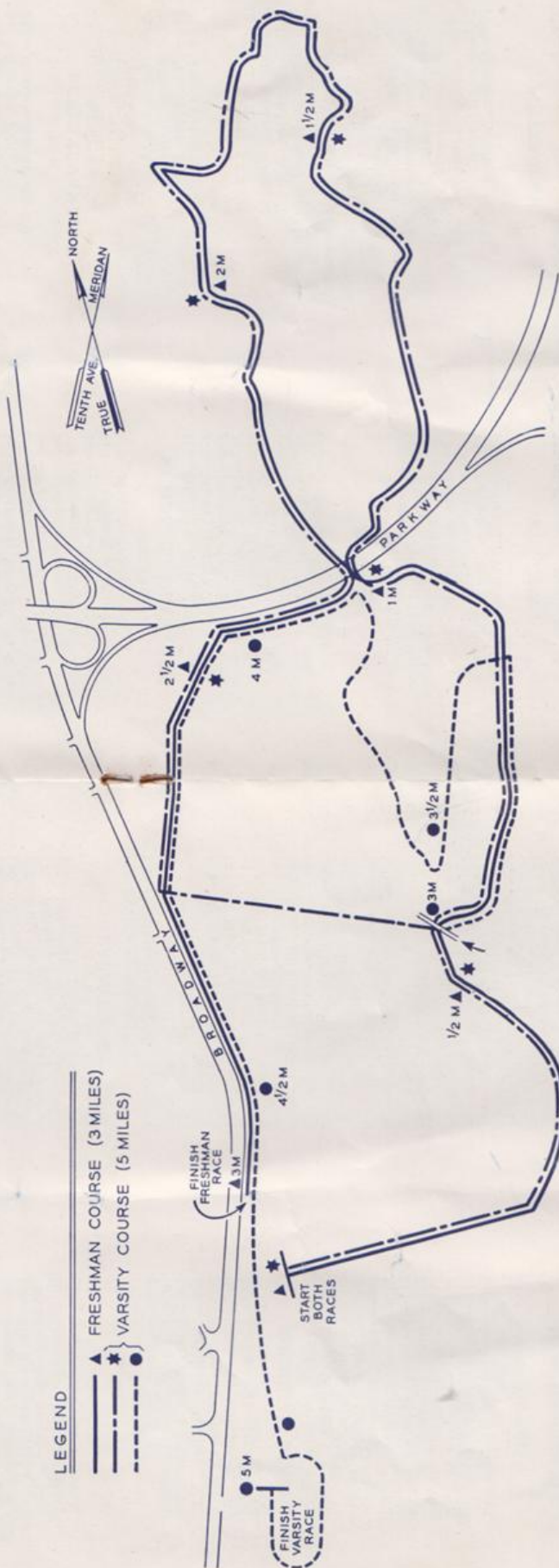

- ▲ FRESHMAN COURSE (3 MILES)
- ★ VARSITY COURSE (5 MILES)



1949 VARSITY CHAMPIONSHIP RACE (FIVE MILES)

To be run over the varsity course, as shown above. The race's first lap is indicated on the map by the dot-and-dash line and by stars (★). This course is marked at frequent intervals by distance posts and direction signs, all *Red* in color. The second lap of the race is indicated on the map by the dotted line and by large dots (●). Its permanent distance posts and direction signs are *Blue* in color.

Varsity competitors should follow *Red* signs from the start of the race for approximately three miles and they should follow *Blue* signs for the remaining two miles to the finish line, which is in Van Cortlandt Stadium, Broadway and 242nd Street, as shown above.

1949 FRESHMAN CHAMPIONSHIP RACE (THREE MILES)

To be run over the Freshman course, indicated on the map by the solid line with distance points designated by triangular marks. The course is marked at frequent intervals by distance points and direction signs, all *Red* in color.

Freshman competitors should follow the *Red* signs from the start of the race to the finish, which is at the southwest corner of the parade grounds as shown above.

REVIEW OF VARSITY CHAMPIONSHIP

Last year Michigan State triumphed in the Varsity I.C.A.A.A. run with a score of 51 points, with Penn State, second; and Army, third. Rhode Island's Bob Black, defending titleholder, won the individual championship in 25:00.4.

Cornell with nine championship teams is well out in front in total team victories since the inaugural I.C.A.A.A. race was held back in 1908 at Princeton. Michigan State is second with six, while Manhattan, Penn State and Syracuse each have four.
