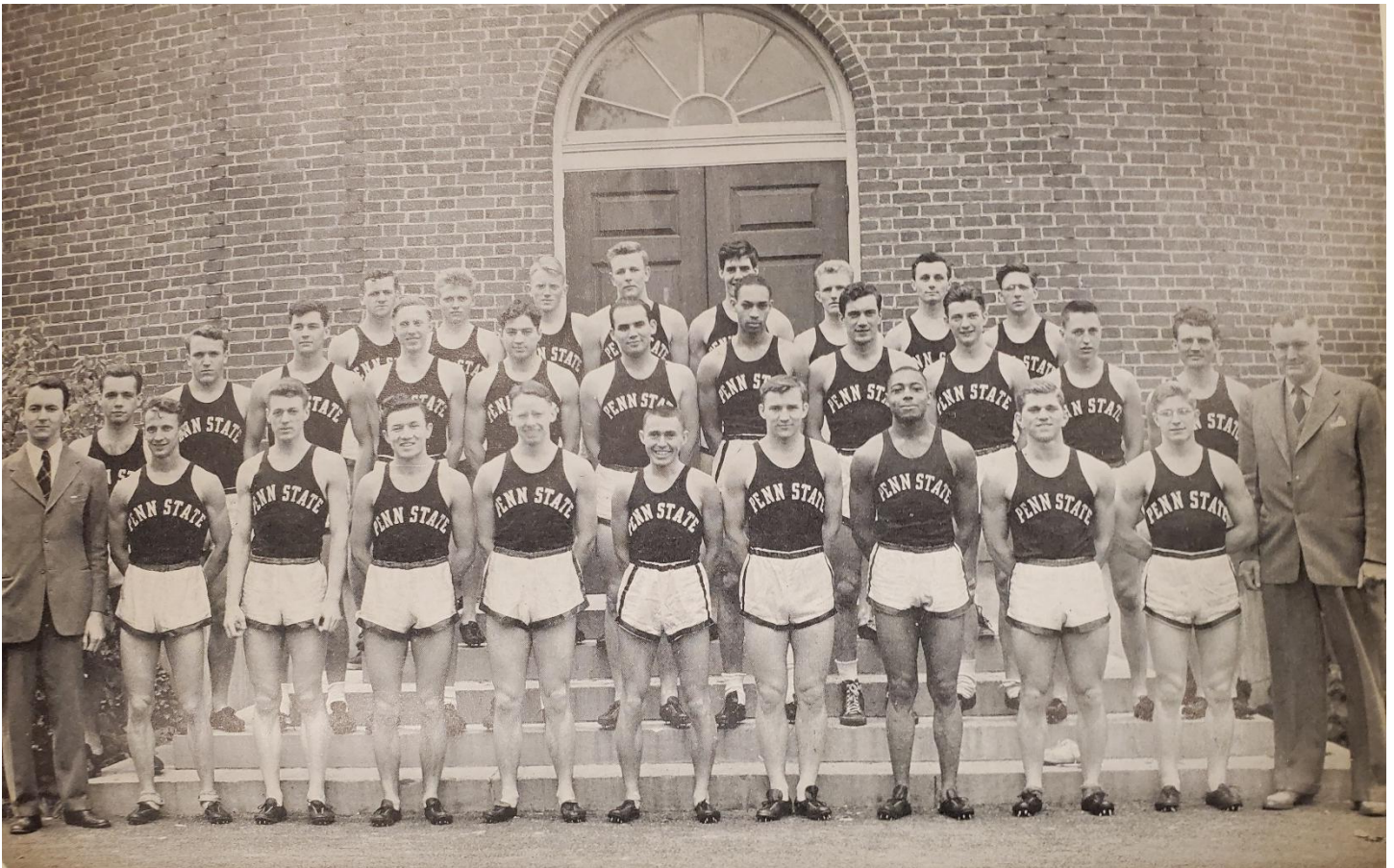

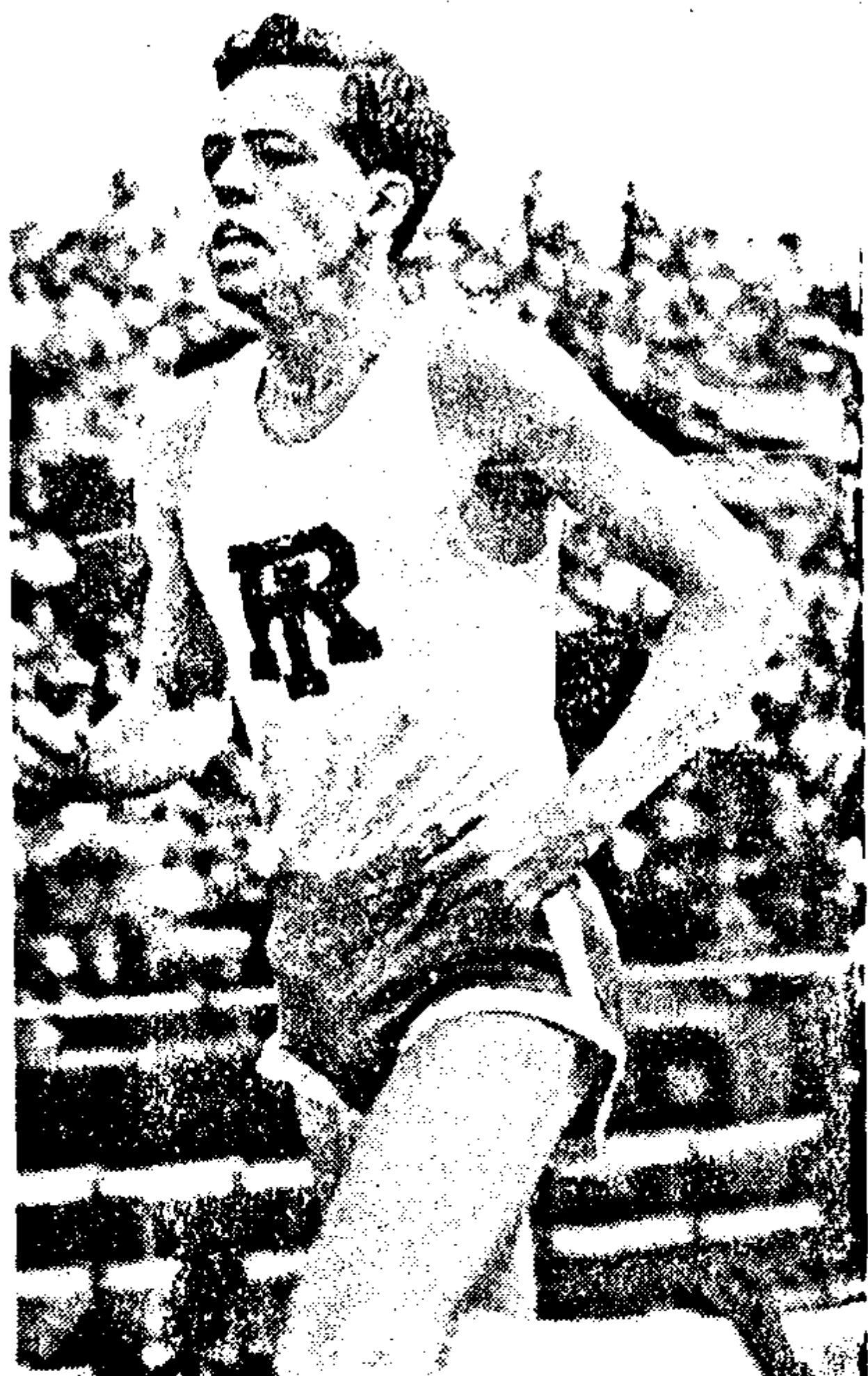
THE RACE OF THE YEAR
