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Bob Giegengack

FOR GOD, FOR COUNTRY, FOR YALE— AND THE I.C.A.A.A.A.

This is Robert F. Giegengack's last I.C.A.A.A.A. indoor track and field championship meet in the capacity of athlete or coach. But as Gieg himself said, having the Last Word at "An Evening with Gieg" at Yale on February 22, "I am not about to leave you physically, and I will never leave you spiritually."

We reprint the following tribute from the program of that "Evening with Gieg" to outline a most memorable career:

Christian. Husband. Father. Teacher. Coach. Patriot. Philosopher. Wit. Debater. Positive Thinker. Counsellor. Leader. World Traveler. Fighter. Idealist. Yale Man.

On July 1, 1975, Bob Giegengack will retire as Track and Field Coach after 29 years at Yale. The impact that Gieg has had on the many young men who have come under his tutelage cannot be measured. His approach to both athletics and to life itself has been felt not only at Yale, but throughout the world. We do honor to this man who has done so much for so many.

A native of Brooklyn, New York, Gieg attended Brooklyn Prep and thereafter graduated Magna Cum Laude from the College of the Holy Cross. He taught Latin and coached track at Brooklyn Prep for eight years where his teams enjoyed seven undefeated dual meet seasons, seven consecutive Penn Relay titles and set a world interscholastic two mile relay record. In 1938, at age 31, Gieg became the youngest head coach ever appointed to a major university when he took over the track program at Fordham. In his first year his runners set three world indoor records and finished second in the IC4A Championship, a title which Fordham captured two years later.

During World War II, Gieg served as a Lieutenant Commander in the United States Navy returning to Fordham in 1945. The next year Gieg came to Yale.

While Gieg has coached at Yale his teams have scored 183 dual meet victories against 108 defeats. At one point they were undefeated in dual meet competition for four consecutive years. Under his tutelage Yale teams have won four IC4A titles, thirteen outdoor and four indoor Heptagonal championships. Olympians Vic Frank, Jim Fuchs, Wendell Mottley, Jay Luck, Frank Shorter, Rich MacDonald and Kwaku Ohene-Frempong were all members of his Yale teams. Two of these, Jim Fuchs and Wendell Mottley, were world record-holders.

Gieg was the assistant coach of the U.S. Olympic team in 1956 at Melbourne, Australia and head coach of the Olympic team that competed at Tokyo, Japan in 1964 - the most powerful U.S. team ever. He was the head coach of the U.S. Maccabiah team in 1969, and the first recipient of the Walter Brown Award in 1966 at the Boston Knights of Columbus meet. An Olympic Committee member since 1954, Gieg is now serving his second term as chairman of the U.S. Men's Olympic Track and Field Committee and is a member of the Board of Directors of the U.S. Olympic Committee.

Throughout this illustrious career Gieg has been proudly and ably assisted by his wife Lucie and his children Lucie, Mary, Jane, Robert, Richard, Edward and their families.
