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GEORGE MASON UNIVERSITY

George Mason University has pushed beyond the limits of traditional education whenever necessary to meet the needs of the Northern Virginia region. Free from the traditions binding older universities, George Mason has pioneered special areas of service for the state.

Today, the university is challenging the boundaries of conventional education more intensely than ever before. It is taking the lead among Virginia universities in exploring the electronic learning horizon, linking human creativity with advanced technology to create the most stimulating and efficient learning environments for the 21st century and beyond.

From an infrastructure linked by fiber-optics technology to innovative teaching methods, new arrangements of knowledge, and new roles for faculty and students, George Mason is fostering the kinds of innovations that are redefining higher education. No longer must "classrooms" be defined by four walls, course work by credit hours, or professors by lecture-hall presentations. Rather than a one-way flow of information from faculty to students, education is becoming the dynamic exchange of ideas appropriate for students today.

More than 21,000 students study in 110 degree programs at the undergraduate, master's, doctoral, and professional levels. By emphasizing high technology, public policy, and the fine and performing arts, the university has formed links with the community to meet its needs while taking advantage of the

best it has to offer in people and resources. Its innovative programs and visionary outlook have attracted a faculty that includes world-renowned scholars and teachers.

Both George Mason and surrounding Fairfax County have experienced phenomenal development over the past several years. From its beginning in 1957 as a two-year

branch of the University of Virginia, George Mason has grown into a comprehensive institution offering degrees through the doctoral level. From a rural suburb of Washington, D.C., Fairfax County has

developed into a center of high technology enterprise, promising to rival the West Coast's Silicon Valley and the Boston area's Route 128 corridor.

The university's growing stature and reputation are exemplified by the presence of an array of distinguished scholars, including Virginia's first Nobel laureate, economist James Buchanan, Pulitzer Prize recipient Roger Wilkins, and various winners of awards ranging from the Guggenheim Foundation and the National Endowments for the Arts and Humanities to Fulbright Awards and Mellon Fellowships. The university's full-time instructional faculty currently number 654.

Of particular interest to undergraduates are the

Robinson Professors, outstanding scholars in the liberal arts and sciences who have come to George Mason from prestigious positions elsewhere with a concern for broad and fundamental intellectual issues and commitment to undergraduate teaching.

Part of George Mason's rapid development has been a carefully planned building



program. The university's academic facilities include modern classroom buildings, state-of-the-art scientific laboratories and computer centers that support student class work and faculty research. Three new buildings are currently under construction and are expected to be completed by 1995: \$30 million University Center, \$11.7 million classroom building called Enterprise Hall, and a \$2.5 million facility for the newly created Krasnow Institute for Advanced Study.

Through its efforts to meet the needs of its region and its emphasis on excellence, George Mason continues to attract the attention of both the educational world and the general public.

The Nation's Largest Athletic Conference

Over 50 Years of Tradition, Pride, Diversity & Service

Founded in 1938, the Eastern College Athletic Conference is the nation's largest collegiate athletic conference with 271 member colleges and universities ranging from Maine to North Carolina in Divisions I, II and III. ECAC member institutions sponsor over 2,500 varsity teams involving 125,000 male and female student athletes.

The ECAC manages over 90 championships in 19 men's and women's sports for its membership and is responsible for over 20,000 officiating assignments, a public relations/news bureau and a legislative services department.

The ECAC headquarters, the Asa S. Bushnell Center, is located in Centerville, Mass., on Cape Cod. The business of this non-profit organization is conducted at its annual ECAC Fall and Spring Conventions. Over 300 athletics administrators annually attend the fall convention, which includes tournament and membership committee meetings, professional seminars, a schedule-making session and an awards luncheon.

A Conference of conferences, the ECAC includes within its organizational structure dozens of leagues and other organizations. Colleges and universities from the Atlantic 10, Big East, Colonial A.A., Ivy League, MAAC, North Atlantic, Northeast and Patriot League, along with schools from the Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York and Pennsylvania State conferences, all hold dual membership in the ECAC.

Over the years, the ECAC has exerted leadership not only at the regional level, but also on the national scale with the NCAA. With over 25 percent of the NCAA made up of ECAC members, the Conference plays a leading role in national athletics policy and action.

Several ECAC administrators have served as both NCAA and ECAC Presidents, including Bill Flynn of Boston College, John Toner of U. Conn. and Eppy Barnes of Colgate. Dick Schultz, former Executive Director of the NCAA, was a member of the ECAC Executive Council when he was AD at Cornell.

The ECAC was founded as the Central Office for Eastern Intercollegiate Athletics with a charter membership of 53 colleges. Under the leadership of Commissioner Asa Bushnell, the conference addressed the concerns of its members in much the same fashion as today.

Bushnell molded and guided the organization from its inception until his retirement in 1970, when his long-time associate George Shiebler was appointed successor. He retired in 1972 and Robert M. "Scotty" Whitelaw, who had joined the ECAC in 1960, was named commissioner and served in that office for 17 years. In 1989 he was succeeded by current commissioner Clayton Chapman, who began his tenure with the conference in 1971.

One of the most significant events in ECAC history occurred in 1983 with the consolidation of the Eastern Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (EAIW) into the ECAC structure. With the addition of women's sports, the ECAC doubled the number of its championships.

Some of the more recognizable ECAC and Affiliate championships include the Chemical Bank/ECAC

Holiday Basketball Festival at Madison Square Garden in New York City, IC4A Track, Rowing Championships of the EARC and IRA and ECAC Men's Golf Tournament. Also included are the Women's Cross Country and Men's Ice Hockey Championships, each of whose champions receive automatic NCAA Tournament bids. The ECAC also offers the only Women's Ice Hockey League and Championship in the nation, a college division men's and women's crew regatta and the new ECAC Intercollegiate Football Conference for Division I-AA and II members.

The ECAC also offers championships for its members in Division I, II and III in baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, fencing, field hockey, football, men's and women's golf, men's and women's gymnastics, men's and women's ice hockey, men's and women's lacrosse, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's swimming and diving, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's track and field, and women's volleyball.

The ECAC assigns over 4,000 officials in baseball, men's and women's basketball, fencing, football, gymnastics, ice hockey, men's and women's soccer and wrestling, as well as affiliated championships in crew, cross country, swimming and track.

The Conference office maintains a legislative services department for its membership, responding to questions on eligibility, interpretations of NCAA and ECAC regulations and letters of intent. The office also sponsors legislative workshops and seminars.

Through its public relations and service bureau departments, the ECAC assists in the promotion of its members' athletics programs and student athletes through weekly and seasonal player and team awards, selection of all-star teams, compilation of statistics and championship publicity. The conference also publishes a Directory and Record Book and media guides in football and hockey.

The ECAC is currently staffed by 20 full-time employees with an additional staff of 21 part-time employees who serve as supervisors of officials and directors/coordinators of ECAC Tournaments.

GEORGE MASON'S GUTHRIE USES A MULTIPLE APPROACH

In a day and age when the numbers of coaches and the amount of track & field scholarships have been reduced to their smallest levels ever, wouldn't it be nice to have someone who can help fill both of those voids at once?

In a way, that's what George Mason gets from junior Diane Guthrie. The 1992 NCAA third-place finisher in the heptathlon, a former Pan American Games long jump champion, and an eight-time ECAC titleist across her three-year career, Guthrie gives the Patriots solid point production everywhere she competes. But according to 18th year head coach Norm Gordon, the Santa Cruz, Jamaica native provides the Patriots with more than just athletic ability.

"The amazing thing about Diane is that she is very analytical about the sport of track and field," said Gordon. "She understands many events well...not only her own stuff, but her teammates' as well. It's almost like having an additional coach on board. She's very supportive of others and she can speak from very high-level experiences."

Despite the fact that Guthrie has won her share of ECAC titles, she never seems to tire of the competition it delivers.

"She still understands the importance of the ECAC to our program," added Gordon. "Even though she has competed well at a high national level, she still enjoys competing at the ECAC meet. At the ECAC's there are always people who can challenge—and beat her—in any event that she does. She enjoys that challenge."

For Guthrie, a 1990 graduate of St. Elizabeth Technical High School, her climb back into the limelight has been remarkable. As a freshman at George Mason in 1991, she burst onto the collegiate track and field scene when she won both the indoor and outdoor NCAA long jump titles, as well as being named the Penn Relays "Outstanding Collegiate Female Performer" after winning the heptathlon there. In her sophomore season she finished third at the outdoor NCAA's in the heptathlon and the long jump. During that span she won three ECAC outdoor titles (1991 heptathlon, 1992 long jump and high jump), to go along with three indoor ECAC championships.

Last year she had to sit out both the indoor and outdoor season with an injured right ankle. This past October, in fact, she had to have that ankle operated on to repair damage caused by a mishap in the high jump.

Three months later this past January, she scored 4,347 points in the indoor pentathlon which was far superior to Sharon Jaklofsky's (LSU) 1992 collegiate record of 4,212 points. It

was not recognized as a collegiate record, however, since the ECAC hurdle distance of 55-meters does not correspond with the international IAAF distance of 60-meters. Guthrie, who finished third to Jaklofsky in the 1992 NCAA Championship heptathlon in Austin, TX., is looking for more titles to punctuate her comeback.

"It's nice to have an athlete who has ECAC scoring potential in so many events, as well as being a top multi-event threat," added Gordon. "She gives you a lot of options to do a lot of things. As a coach you kind of plan around what she can—and wants—to do. Then you fill in around her in several areas. She not only motivates others through her support, but she is a motivating factor for others on the team. They all know that with her abilities, if they chip in, everyone has a really good shot at doing good things. At the same time, of course, we have to be careful not to overuse her. She has great capabilities at the NCAA level and don't want to compromise her chances there."

To show how potent Guthrie's talents are, in the first four seasons that she competed in a Mason uniform, the Patriots were 4-0 in ECAC indoor and outdoor track competition. This year she won two events at the indoor championships (she won the long jump and the pentathlon), and finished third at the NCAA Indoor Championships in the long jump.

Having the 1991 Pan Am Games heptathlon runner-up (Sharon Hanson) to train with, has helped her return to the multi-event scene. Hanson, a graduate of California Poly, San Luis Obispo, currently lives and trains in Northern Virginia as a part of the George Mason University Track Club. Hanson finished second to Guthrie in the event in a meet indoors.

"Sharon actually started before me in the fall," said Guthrie, "and we train together occasionally. It is an added motivation to have her to train and compete with because she is on my level and our goals are similar (both are shooting for the 1996 Olympic heptathlon)."

For now, Guthrie is just happy with her return to the collegiate scene where she is one of the most talented—and knowledgeable—athletes on the circuit. At this weekend's ECAC Championships you are likely to see her competing in several areas either on the track or in the field.

But no matter how busy she gets, Guthrie will no doubt take the time to assist a Patriot teammate or two.



BEATING THE ODDS...AS WELL AS THE COMPETITION

When Barrington Campbell transferred to George Mason University from Central Arizona Junior College in the fall of 1991, little did he know that a routine physical exam would change his life.

In fact, until a heart murmur found during his physical turned out to be the result of a defective aortic valve, the 23-year-old Jamaican not only had no idea he had a potentially life-threatening condition, but he was able to compete at a world-class level.

Now, 27 months after undergoing surgery to replace the valve, Campbell is set to compete at the IC4A Championships.

"It's absolutely stunning, there's no other way to describe his condition," said Dr. Frank Pettrone, the chief consulting physician for the university's athletic department. "To our knowledge, no one has ever come back from this kind of surgery to compete at such a high level of competition. Normally, you see this condition in people in middle age and beyond, who can go back to walking or jogging, but nothing like this."

Even more amazing, said Pettrone, is that Campbell showed no symptoms of heart disease, despite having suffered from rheumatic fever as a youngster.

"I've seen only one other case like this in 10 years of practice," said Dr. John Johnson, an internal medicine specialist familiar with Campbell's condition who also consults with the university's athletic department. "It's fairly rare, and is considered life-threatening. The life expectancy of someone who suffers from this condition and doesn't have surgery is normally about 50 percent over five years. And that's for someone who's not a world-class athlete."

Campbell, who will run the lead leg for the Patriots in the 1,600 meter relay at the IC's, says he felt perfectly fine before learning of his condition.

"Other than suffering from a lot of (ham-string) muscle pulls, I felt great," he said. "I had no idea there was anything wrong with me at all."

Despite the problem, Campbell earned junior college All-American honors at 400 meters, and won both silver and bronze medals at the Penn Relays while running for Vere Technical High School in Manchester, Jamaica.

After undergoing several months of tests,

Campbell underwent surgery in February of 1992. Three days after the operation, he was able to take a few steps. A year later he returned to competition, running strictly on the relay team that finished second at the IC4A Outdoor Championships in 1993.

This winter, Campbell has again concentrated on relays, helping George Mason qualify for the NCAA's with a time of 3:08.80, second-fastest in the country this season. However, plans call for him to run open races in both the 200 and 400.

"Privately, I was hoping he wouldn't want to run again," said George Mason men's track coach John Cook. "Nothing was ever said about him ever coming back to compete following the surgery. Our plan was for him to remain in school on scholarship. We never encouraged him, it just sort of happened gradually."

The first time Campbell ran in a race following the operation, both Cook and his assistant coach Dalton Ebanks were admittedly nervous.

"I had an ambulance waiting at the gate when he ran," said Ebanks, who works with sprinters and jumpers. "I don't think I

saw anyone else the whole time."

Campbell, on the other hand, wasn't the least bit concerned.

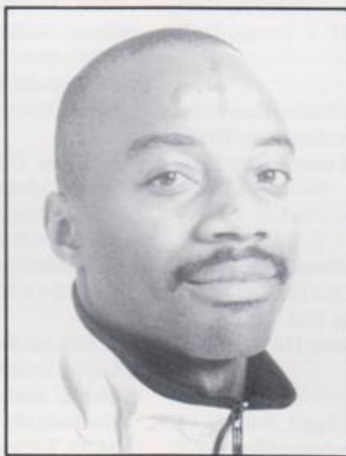
"Everyone worries about it more than I do," he said. "It doesn't bother me at all. My family is supporting me in this, and my coaches and teammates have been fantastic."

Still, there are constant reminders of the surgery. Besides a foot-long scar that runs down the middle of his chest, Campbell has to take Coumadin — a blood-thinner — daily, which keeps him from playing contract sports and requires a blood test every six weeks to adjust the dosage.

In addition, he has to undergo two full-scale physical exams each year, and can't eat certain things, such as broccoli and kale, which can affect his medication.

A deeply religious person, Campbell credits his faith for pulling him through.

"I'm not afraid of dying," he said. "If it's time for me to go, then so be it. I believe in God and feel that there's a reason for everything that happens. If my experience can help someone else, then it's been worth it to me."
