WHAT HAPPENED IN 1967

FOR THE SECOND straight year, the I.C.4-A. meet record was broken as Arthur Dulong, Holy Cross sophomore, turned in the crackling time of 24 minutes 4.4 seconds in winning the 59th annual university division championship at Van Cortlandt Park last Nov. 20. In cold and windy weather, the young Crusader finished the five-mile grind 4.6 seconds in front of Stephen Stageberg of Georgetown. But it was Villanova's well-balanced squad, which included the 1966 individual champion, that won team laurels for the second year in a row by posting an aggregate of 47 points, almost 100 points better than second-place Georgetown's 144.

Sophomores haven't won too many I.C.4-A. varsity cross country titles, but Dulong, a psychology major, began to get stronger as the race progressed and before heading into the hills for the second time he began to pull away from his toughest rival, Stageberg, whom he beat by about 100 yards.

Thomas Donnelly, the first Villanova runner to finish, placed third in 24:52, while Terry Donnelly of William & Mary was fourth in 25 minutes flat and Raymond Smith of Penn State fifth in 25:04.

Villanova's team triumph in the university division run, its third in the history of the organization (the Wildcats previously had won in 1962 as well as in 1967) was one of the easiest in I.C.4-A. history, even though its 1966 individual champion, Charles Messenger, who had turned in a record 24:15.6 in winning two years ago, could do no better than eighth last year.

The Wildcats had tremendous team strength and balance. In addition to Donnelly in third place and Messenger in eighth, they placed Dave Patrick in the seventh spot, Ian Hamilton in 11th and Richard Buerkle in 18th (in the team ranking). Even their sixth man, Frank Murphy, was credited with the 22nd spot.

THE COLLEGE DIVISION individual race provided a repeater and also a new record. Wesleyan's Ambrose Burfoot, a senior, covered the five-mile course in 24:25.4, bettering his own mark of 24:40.7, which he had set in 1966. Burfoot's victory was even easier than Dulong's, for he defeated Sebsibe Mamo of Colby, an Ethiopian exchange student who had won the freshman race in a record 14:14.4 the year before, by almost 53 seconds. Mamo was clocked in 25:18 and he was followed by William Mahoney of Temple in 25:40, Ben Wilson of M.I.T. in 25:52 and Joe Ryan of LaSalle in 26:07.

In the battle for the college division team championship, the victor also had an easy time of it. Springfield scored its first triumph in the sixth year of this competition by putting together a total of 46 points to 115 by Temple, the 1966 winner; 142 by LaSalle, victor in 1963; 161 by Colby and 166 by M.I.T.

IN THE TWO FRESHMAN events, at three miles, Villanova's Martin Liquori won the university division individual title in 14:20.8, a new record, just nosing out Jerry Richey of Pittsburgh, who turned in 14:22, with Charles Shrader of Maryland third in 14:58. The old record was 14:28.4, set by Holy Cross' Dulong the year before.

Georgetown won the team title by a point, posting 109 to Pittsburgh's 110, with Northeastern third with 126.

I.C.A.A.A. CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP CUP

Cornell University won the inaugural I.C.A.A.A. championship trophy in 1913 with five victories in six years. It took twenty-three meets before Michigan State captured the second trophy in 1937. Michigan State retired the third championship cup in 1957 with a record of five triumphs in 1948, 1952, 1953, 1956 and 1957. A new cup went into competition with the fiftieth annual varsity run in 1958.

The Spartans with thirteen team championships from 1933 through 1961 are out in front in total team victories and Cornell is second with nine, from 1908 up to 1921. Penn State with seven and Manhattan with five follow in that order.
