Masks.. a Tool for Evangelism

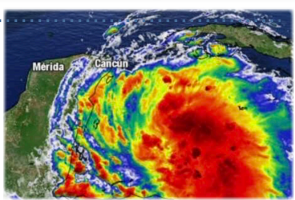

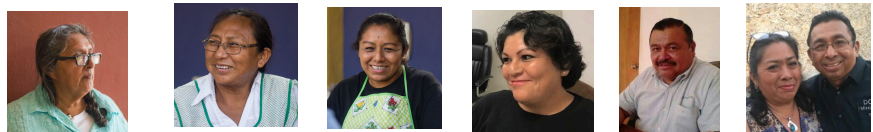
Bill's surgery in Mexico.
