CASUAL VOLUNTEER

Requirements:

- Commit to volunteering a minimum of 9 hours over a 3-month period, ie. 3 hours/month.
- Access to a computer/laptop, internet, and Google Documents.

CS will provide:

- Online/In-person Orientation meeting (15-30 minutes), including tasking based on your interests/skills set.
- Supervision and regular feedback on your work.
- Certificate of hours volunteered, upon request.
- Online/In-person Evaluation meeting of your performance (15-30 minutes), upon request.

VOLUNTEER INTERNSHIP

If you're looking for conservation career experience, or you want to make time to complete more in-depth tasks/projects, we invite you to join our CS Volunteer Internship Program (#VIP). The program runs annually from January to November. You may join at any time throughout the year, provided you serve the minimum 50 hours required to complete the program before November 30. To join you must have access to a computer/laptop, internet, and Google Documents.

CS will provide:

- As per the Casual Volunteer Program (above).
- Assignment of in-depth tasks/projects, based on your interests/skills set. Depending on your tasks, we may also connect you with our network of experts in the field of conservation.
- Upon completion of your internship, a Thank You packet including limited-edition CS Tee & Tote Bag designed by a local artist, and Certificate of Completion.
- Feature in our social media #VIP campaign, celebrating our volunteer interns for the year on International Volunteer Day, December 5.
