Geography connects ideas, people and places – and links to every subject in the curriculum.

## ENGLISH



Develops reading, writing, speaking and listening through real-world contexts.

**Geography connection:**  
Stories, reports, persuasive writing, fieldwork, place descriptions.

## MATHS



Uses mathematical skills to explore data, patterns and relationships.

**Geography connection:**  
Interpreting maps, graphs and statistics, measuring, scales, coordinates.

## SCIENCE



Explores the natural world, processes and changes in environments.

**Geography connection:**  
Weather, climate, ecosystems, rivers, rocks, soils, natural hazards.

## HISTORY



Examines events and people in the past and how places change.

**Geography connection:**  
Historical settlements, land use change, maps, exploration and trade.

## CITIZENSHIP / PSHE



Develops responsible citizens who understand diverse communities and global issues.

Human rights, sustainability, fairness, global inequality, community issues.

## COMPUTING



Uses technology to find, analyse and present information.

**Geography connection:**  
Digital maps, GIS, data handling, research, presentations.

Encourages communication and understanding of other cultures.

Learning about countries, traditions, languages and global perspectives.

Inspires creativity through landscapes, environments and cultures.
