Prominent Omega men include jazz musician William "Count" Basie, college president and bank chairman Dr. Walter E. Massey, civil rights activists Jesse Jackson and Roy Wilkens, poet laureate Langston Hughes, and entertainers Steve Harvey and Tom Joyner, attorneys Vernon Jordan and Ben Crump, and businessmen-athletes Michael Jordan and Shaquille O'Neal.

Nu Chapter was established in 1921 at the Pennsylvania State University. Nu Chapter was the first black organization at the University. Distinguished Nu Chapter Alumni include football stand-out and businessman Lydell Mitchell, U.S. District Judge the Honorable Julian Cook, engineer Benson L. Dutton and businessman Ronald Ross Davenport. Nu Chapter has been an active community leader, presenting health care, civic, educational activities, and fraternity mandated programs including but not limited to:

- **ACHIEVEMENT WEEK** is observed each November and is designed to recognize those individuals at the local level who have contributed to community uplift. A National High School Essay Contest is held in conjunction with Achievement Week.
- SOCIAL ACTION PROGRAMS where Chapters undertake activities that will uplift their communities. Events include

 charitable organizations.
