Phi Kappa Psi, TEP Win in Gridiron Action

Paul Oves was the big gun offensively for SPE, running ten yards for a touchdown in the first half, and throwing a ten-yard TD pass to Fred Skinka in the second period. He also booted one extra point.

Triangle smothered Alpha Phi Chi, 20-0, in the first period. Quarterback Ken Brown threw touchdown passes to Bob Dobrowski and Frank Williams. However, neither PAT's were converted.

Later in the first half Triangle scored a safety on a lead snap from Alpha Phi Chi's center.
