MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The Del Paso Boulevard Partnership Board of Directors meeting for Thursday, November 29, 2018, was called to order by the Chairman, Shane Curry at 8:40am. The meetings were held at Artspace1616, 1616 Del Paso Boulevard, Sacramento.

ROLL CALL

Staff - Executive Director, David Plag and Communications Director, Larry Groves were present.

CONSENT CALENDAR

The Board moved and seconded a motion to approve the minutes for October 10, 2018. The vote was unanimous.

AGENCY UPDATE REPORT

Sacramento Police Department Update

Lt. Rudy Chan talked about the effort by the City and Fire to shut down Poly Urban Studios and the uptick in the number of cars burglaries in the area. He also talked about a shift change in January for the Police.

Paladin Private Security

Matt Carroll discussed the stats for the district, which compares the month of October 2016 to October of 2018. There was a noteworthy decrease in calls for serve and officer initiated response for Lewd Conduct, Suspicious Circumstances, Disturbed Persons. There was a noteworthy increase in Fights, Intoxicated Persons and Theft. Overall, most stats are down.

Oversight Board RASA and Mitigation Fund Request

Leslie Fritzsche was unable to attend the meeting. The Partnership has requested \$50,000 in mitigation funds from Councilmember Warren.

PRESENTATION

A presentation was made by Larry Lee, with the Observer Newspaper. The newspaper will move from Oak Park to Del Paso Boulevard, the old Tabor Building. They are planning to start remodeling the building in January and hoping to open by mid-April.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

Executive Director

David gave his Executive Director's report and talked the success of the Fall Street Faire, the distribution of City Sponsorship funds and the closing down of the Poly Urban Studios.

David gave an update on the development of businesses and property on the Boulevard, as well as the cannabis grow facilities in the PBID/BIA, and an update to the temporary homeless shelter on Railroad Avenue.

The Board moved and seconded the Executive Director's report. The motion was approved with an unanimous vote.

INFORMATION ITEMS

David talked about some of the 25 Information Items in the packet, including the Camp Fire Benefit Concert at the Stoney Inn and the Christmas on the Block at That Guy Eyewear.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. Treasurer's Report

David did a review of the three PBID bank accounts. The PBID has approximately \$31,240 on hand with all bills paid.

Mina Perez talked about the December 8th Christmas in the Neighborhood event.

Noelle Davis mentioned the Craft Faire on the Boulevard in December.
