Lt Smith resumed patrols of the district looking for any security issues. During the hour I patrolled zones 1-4 and found the following issues.

- -At the Library I found 1 black male loitering, see photo. I advised him he needed to vacate and he left without incident.
- -At the vacant wall by the library I found what looked like new grafitti, see photos.

-At 2419 Del Paso I found a black male with no hair, a black shirt, dark pants hunched over against the wall. I tried for several minutes and was unable to wake the individual. Due to him being non responsive I contacted Sacramento PD non ermegency line. They sent out EMTs who were able to wake the gentleman later identified as Leonard. He has an injured leg though they were not able to transport him at this time. Leonard was able to call his fiance veronica, who stated she was unable to assist however she insisted that he needed to go to the hospital as he has a history of mental related conditions. I advised Leonard he needed to go to the hospital and he again refused. I told him he would then have to leave the property. At approximately 1015pm he was able to get up and vacate the property.

Suspicious Vehicle Homeless/Vagrant Medical Services Called Law Enforcement

Lt Smith resumed patrols of the district looking for any security issues. During the hour I patrolled zones 1-8.

-At the dollar tree parking lot I found a white Chevrolet Van parked with a male adult in the passenger seat, see photos. I recognized the van from my previous shift last week suggesting it had not moved. The individual in the van did not wake up, and I proceeded to contact sacramento police department and await their arrival who I called at 223am. Sacramento Pd arrived onscene at 243am and I advised them of the situation. The officer began trying to wake the subject who was not responding. At this time, three additional Sacramento police officers arrived on site and they all began shaking the vehicle and knocking on the windows, trying to get a response from the individual in the passenger seat. They were unsuccessful, at which point they proceeded to break the driver's side window of the van, unlock the doors and remove the individual as gently as possible and lay him on the ground. After laying him on the ground, they began doing what they could to wake the individual and provide whatever medical aid they were able to do. At approximately 3am the EMTS with Sac Fire arrived and began applying medical aid for the unknown male. By this point, there were six Sacramento police officers, one Sac Pd supervisor and sacramento fire all on property. They did what they could to wake the subject unsuccesfully, provide him.medical aid and then transport him to a hospital. The Sacramento Police Department then requested a tow company be contacted to have the vehicle removed from the property due to the liability of it being unsecured and unsanitary. HB towing was contacted and Sac PD requested we remain with the vehicle. The final sacramento, police vehicle vacated the property at approximately 330am and I awaited the tow truck.

HB towing arrived at 353 and began the process of towing the vehicle. They removed the vehicle at 415am without incident.
