

Amarillo Gun Club - 2026 Summer Skeet League

Duration – 8 Weeks

Starting – Thursday, June 18, 2026

Time – Club Open Hours (All weekly scores must be turned into the clubhouse counter before Wed. 9:00 am)

Location – Amarillo Gun Club

Cost – \$25 Per Shooter paid to Don Porter or Paul Pedri. Shooters will cover the cost of their targets via club count-down card.

Prizes –All money taken as entry fees will fund the prize money to the following three individuals.

- High Overall Shooter (Raw Score)
- High Overall Handicapped Shooter (Handicapped Score)
- Lucky Draw Shooter (High Overall Raw & Handicapped winners will be disqualified from the Lucky Draw)

Divided Prize money will be to the nearest \$5 with any prize money not divisible by \$5 will be awarded to High Overall Shooter (Raw Score).

Schedule:

- We encourage all shooters to take advantage of the social aspects of shooting skeet; however, we understand that we all have our own unique schedules. Therefore, participants in the Amarillo Gun Club 2026 Summer Skeet league will be allowed to shoot their weekly targets during any OPEN club hours.
- The duration of the Amarillo Gun Club 2026 Summer Skeet League will be eight weeks ending August 19, 2026. It will be the shooter's responsibility to have all scoresheets turned into the clubhouse with their names and dates shot clearly indicated.

Scoring:

- Current NSSA Skeet Rules will apply on scoring and conduction of shooting regular American Skeet.
- There will be two Summer League Score Boards tabulated. One will contain the "Raw" scores of each participating shooter, and the second will contain the participating shooter's "Handicapped Score".
- Handicapped scores will be calculated as follows,
 - If a shooter scores a 48, a 49, or a 50 for their weekly raw score, then these scores will carry over to the handicapped scoreboard.
 - Handicap calculation: (48 minus the average of the shooter's weekly scores) times 90%. Then the calculated handicap is added to the current week's raw score. Handicapped Weekly Scores are then capped to the value of 48. Therefore, a shooter can only achieve a score on the handicap scoreboard of 48 or higher only if the shooter shoots a score of 48 or greater.
- Weekly shoots will consist of 50 targets (two normal skeet games) per week.
- All shooters are encouraged to "shoot-ahead", or bank weekly scores.
- A maximum of ten (10) weekly scores will be accepted to be compiled to the best 8 of 10 weekly scores for a total of 400 targets.
- It will be the shooter's responsibility to clearly indicate on their extra (banked) weekly score sheets as to whether the scores are extra by designating the scores with a "**B**" for banked scores.
- If a shooter misses turning in their weekly score by Wed. 12:00 pm the following week, their weekly score will be the **greater of**; the shooter's average score minus two targets, or a previously banked score.
- If a shooter misses three consecutive weeks, the league coordinator will return the shooter's entry fee and remove the shooter from the competition.

- Weekly score boards will be published containing raw and handicapped scoreboards.
- At the end of the Summer Skeet League season, the league coordinator (Don Porter) will use any banked scores to replace up to two of the shooter's lowest weekly scores. When banked scores are used to replace previous scores, handicaps will **NOT** be recalculated.

Rules

- The Amarillo Gun Club 2026 Summer Skeet League is open to members and non-members of the Amarillo Gun Club. All non-members joining the Skeet League will review and agree to abide by club safety and conduct rules. All participating non-members will need to sign a hold-harmless agreement.
- Sign Up & Safety Briefing for the Amarillo Gun Club 2026 Summer Skeet League will begin on Thursday, March 12 at 3:30 PM at the AGC Clubhouse. Attendance with this initial signup is NOT mandatory.
- Shooters cannot score for themselves; Either a league member, club member, or club employee may enter the score sheet.
- **Extra (banked) Weekly scores are highly encouraged.**
- There is no limit to the number of individual shooters for the Amarillo Gun Club 2026 Summer League.
- Ties
 - All ties for HOA will be broken via shoot off (Doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5 with miss and out) to be scheduled on Thursday August 20, 2026, at 4:00 pm.
 - Ties for Handicapped HOA will be resolved by shoot-off in the same manner as above.
- All shooters will need to have an AGC Countdown Card to pay for their respective targets. The AGC Countdown Card can be obtained at the AGC Clubhouse during normal business hours.

Summer Skeet League 2026 Bonus

When a league member shoots for weekly score, if there are three or more on the squad, the member shooter will receive a bonus-point added to their handicap score for the week. Squad members do not have to be league members. Therefore, dates and times need to be clearly indicated on the score sheets.
