Representatives from MTC recently came to the center to congratulate us on the center being ranked **19th** in the nation for Job Corps centers.





Have you ever wondered what it would be like to be an aspiring diesel technician?

If so come along with us on a journey through the UAW-LETC Medium/Heavy truck repair program. In this program aspiring technicians receive hands-on training along with complex lectures in the art of truck repair. Students perform routine maintenance all the way to the most advanced diagnostic repairs.

Learning the systems and how they interface with each other is half the battle, the other half is the hands on repair of these systems.

Our students recently found out that a simple repair is not always so simple. A 2015 Volvo VNL came in with a complaint of a squealing belt, upon inspection it was determined that the idler pulley and tensioner were also in need of replacement. Combine this with the fact that the hood and radiator had to be removed for access and you've got yourself a real job. Our students tackled this with great enthusiasm and vigor!!


