RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 1. Eligibility: Entry is open to all youth of Florida, Alabama, and Georgia.
- 2. **Age**: All participants must be at least three years old by January 1, 2025, and not have graduated from High School.
- 3. **Registration and fees:** All entry registration will be done online with the Showman App. Regular registration will be open until October 31st. Late entries will be accepted through November 7th. Registration is \$25 per animal. Late entries are \$35.
- 4. Exhibitors will be responsible for the care, feeding, and watering of their animals for the entire time they are on the showgrounds. All animals must have access to feed and water for the duration of the exhibition at the Expo. Failure to comply with these rules will result in forfeiture of all prizes and awards.
- 5. All goats must possess milk teeth to be eligible to show.
- 6. All Goats must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within 30 days of the show date and a Scrapie premise number (ear tag). The state of Florida rules for livestock exhibition will be followed. LINK https://www.fdacs.gov/Agriculture-Industry/Livestock/Animal-Movement
- 7. Injured or diseased animals, as determined by the JCYLEA committee or state health inspectors, will not be allowed to unload at the Ag Center and will be ineligible for participation in the Show.
- 8. Youth are not limited to the number of animals they can bring. However, the animal must be shown by the exhibitor unless there are two (or more) animals in the same class.
- 9. The judge will place entries. Classes will be established by weight at the committee's discretion.
- 10. No minimum weight. No maximum weight.
- 11. All goats are released and need to be removed from the premises following the

conclusion of the goat show.

12. Any grievances must be submitted in writing to the JCYLEA committee and must be accompanied by a \$100 fee.

SHOWMANSHIP: All exhibitors must use their own animal for the showmanship competition. Excluding Pee Wee, they can use an animal that is registered at the show, provided the owner agrees.

Pee Wee Assisted- Age 3-4

Pee Wee Unassisted- Age 5-7

Junior Showmanship – Age 8 -10 years of age as of January 1, 2025. **Intermediate Showmanship** – Age 11-13 years of age as of January 1, 2025.

Senior Showmanship – Ages 14-18 years of age as of January 1, 2025.

CATEGORIES: Competition is for Market Meat Goats. All breeds and crossbreeds are eligible for competition. Market Doe Classes will be broken down by weight. With an Overall Grand and Reserve Market Doe. Market Wether classes will be broken down by weights, with an overall Grand and Reserve Market Wether. The JCYLEA committee will determine classes and weights.

*Bucks are not permitted in the show.
