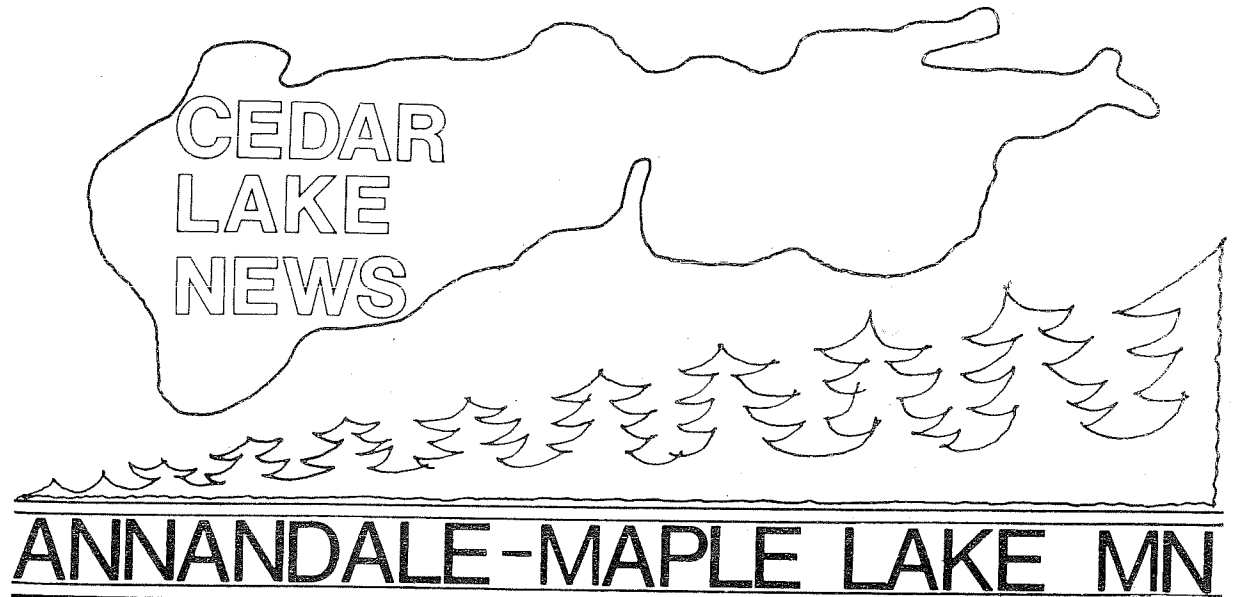

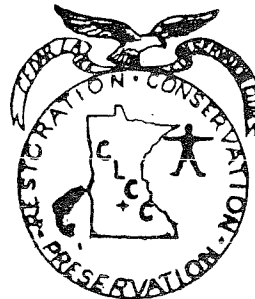

COMMENTS FROM THE FEDERATION OF SPORTSMENS CLUBS

OUR WALLEYE POND LOOKED GOOD EARLY LAST SUMMER AS WAS REPORTED IN THE LAST ISSUE OF THE PAPER. HOWEVER, BECAUSE OF THE UNUSUAL DRY SUMMER THE FINAL RESULT WAS NOT THE BEST. THE SIZE OF THE STOCK WAS GOOD, BUT THE QUANTITY COULD HAVE BEEN BETTER. THE WALLEYES RAN EIGHT TO A POUND, AND THE HAWL WAS SEVENTY ONE POUNDS. THIS AMOUNT WAS DISTRIBUTED INTO CEDAR, SUGAR, AND CLEARWATER LAKES. BECAUSE OF THE DRY SUMMER MANY PONDS DRIED UP COMPLETELY.

THE FINAL REPORT AS TO THE COST OF THE ADDITION TO THE SPORTSMAN'S BUILDING AT THE WRIGHT COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS WAS \$1800 PLUS.

A COMMITTEE OF FOUR WAS CHOSEN TO GO TO ST. PAUL TO FIGHT SPANOUS GUN CONTROL. EXPENSES OF THIS COMMITTEE TO BE PAID BY THE FEDERATION. WHAT THE FEDERATION WANTS IS CRIME CONTROL NOT GUN CONTROL. THE FEDERATION ALSO VOTED TO DONATE TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS TO THE LOBBYISTS FIGHTING GUN CONTROL. THE FEDERATION WAS ALSO REPRESENTED AT A MEETING IN BUFFALO TO LET THE WRIGHT COUNTY REPRESENTATIVES TO THE LEGISLATURE KNOW HOW WE FELT ABOUT THE ISSUE, AND TO BRING IT UP AT THE STATE LEVEL.

* Unrestricted allows the individual to hunt, fish or trap within the Leech Lake Indian Reservation. The Veteran 100% Total Disability and the MSA 98.47, Subd. 15 licenses are issued on a restricted basis only. These are permanent licenses and if an individual wishes to pursue angling on the Leech Lake Indian Reservation he must purchase a \$2.00 stamp to affix to his license.

An additional 50¢ issuing fee is to be charged on all licenses except the four deer licenses to which an additional 75¢ issuing fee is charged.

BOAT LICENSES TOP HALF MILLION MARK

MORE THAN ONE HALF MILLION WATERCRAFT ARE NOW LICENSED TO OPERATE IN MINNESOTA, THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES REPORTED TODAY.

THE DNR'S LICENSE CENTER IN ST. PAUL SAID IT WAS THE FIRST TIME THAT STATE BOAT REGISTRATIONS HAD REACHED THE HALF MILLION MARK.

ROBERT WELLS, LICENSE CENTER SUPERVISOR, SAID THE TOTAL WAS 503,344 ON JAN. 20TH. HE NOTED THAT BOATING REGISTRATIONS ARE CONTINUING TO CLIMB WHILE SNOWMOBILE REGISTRATIONS ARE SHOWING A DECLINE.

WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU DO NOT LOSE OR DESTROY YOUR FISHING LICENSE.

DUPLICATE LICENSES

ANY LICENSEE WHO LOSES OR DESTROYS A LICENSE MAY SUBMIT A SIGNED STATEMENT TO ANY AGENT GIVING THE DATE AND PLACE OF ORIGINAL PURCHASE AND THE REASON WHY A DUPLICATE IS REQUIRED. A DUPLICATE LICENSE AT THE FULL ORIGINAL PRICE OF THE LOST OR DESTROYED LICENSE MAY THEN BE ISSUED. THE APPLICANT MUST PAY THE FULL PRICE OF THE DUPLICATE LICENSE.

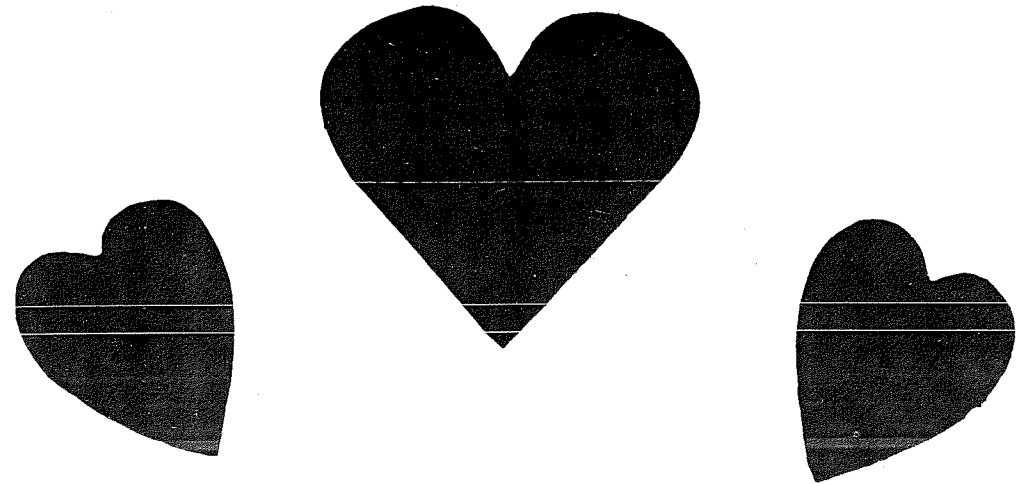

CHOCOLATE DATE ELEGANTE

MIX 12 CREAM FILLED CHOCOLATE COOKIES (CRUSHED) WITH 1 TBSP. MELTED BUTTER. RESERVE 1/4 CUP CRUMBS; PAT REMAINDER INTO 8X8 INCH PAN. COMBINE IN SAUCEPAN 8 OZ. PKG PITTED DATES, CUT UP (1 CUP) 3/4 CUP WATER AND 1/4 TSP SALT. BRING TO BOIL OVER MEDIUM HEAT; REDUCE HEAT AND SIMMER 3 MIN.. REMOVE FROM HEAT. ADD 2 CUPS MINIATURE MARSHMALLOWS. STIR UNTIL MELTED. COOL TO ROOM TEMPERATURE. STIR IN 1/2 CUP CHOPPED WALNUTS. SPREAD OVER CRUMBS IN PAN. WHIP 1 CUP WHIPPING CREAM WITH 1/2 TSP. VANILLA. SPREAD OVER DATE MIXTURE. SPRINKLE WITH RESERVED CRUMBS. CHILL OVERNIGHT. SERVES 9.

CHOW MEIN NOODLE COOKY

MELT 2 CUPS CHOCOLATE CHIPS AND 2 CUPS BUTTERSCOTCH CHIPS (NOT CARAMEL) IN DOUBLE BOILER. POUR OVER 2 CUPS NUTS AND 2 CUPS CHOW MEIN NOODLES. STIR AND DROP ON WAXED PAPER. COOL. KEEP IN REFRIGERATOR.
