COMMENTS FROM THE FEDERATION OF SPORTSMENS' CLUB MEETINGS

SOME OF THE MEMBERS OF THE DIFFERENT CONSERVATION CLUBS IN WRIGHT COUNTY, HAVE BEEN INVOLVED WITH INDEPENDENT BANDING OF PRIVATELY RAISED WATER FOWL. EARLY LAST WINTER, AT ONE OF THE MEETINGS OF THE FEDERATION, THERE WAS A REPORT BY A BUFFALO MEMBER THAT ONE OF HIS BANDED MALLARDS WAS BAGGED IN LOUISIANA.

SEVERAL WILD TURKEYS HAVE BEEN LET LOOSE IN THE COUNTY, AND I HAVE PERSONALLY BEEN LUCKY ENOUGH TO SEE THREE OF THEM.

ONCE AGAIN GUN CONTROL HAS BEEN A MAJOR ISSUE. THE FEDERATION HAS TAKEN A HARD STAND, WITH MANY LETTERS TO OUR POLITICIANS, AND GROUPS SENT TO THE CAPITOL, IN OUR EFFORTS TO SAVE OUR RIGHTS.

THIS PAST WINTER WAS A ROUGH WINTER ON SOME OF THE AREA LAKES. SEVERAL SMALLER LAKES WERE OPENED UP FOR PERMISQUIOUS FISHING, BECAUSE OF THE LOW OXYGEN CONTENT. LAKE MARTHA AND LITTLE MAPLE WERE INCLUDED IN THIS LIST OF LAKES.

CEDAR LAKE MADE IT THROUGH THE WINTER WITH A GOOD OXYGEN COUNT AND SUFFERED NO WINTER KILL. THE WATER WAS TOO LOW IN THE CREEK FOR OUR NORTHERNS TO GET UP TO THEIR SPAWNING BED AT SWART WATTS LAKE, BUT THAT DIDN'T STOP SOME PEOPLE FROM PICKING UP THEIR LIMIT ON OPENING DAY.

THE ONLY OTHER IMPORTANT NEWS OF LATE, IS THE INCREDIBLE AMOUNT OF DRAINING GOING ON IN WRIGHTLAND STEARNS COUNTIES. THERE HAS BEEN ENOUGH MARSH LAND DRAINED WITHIN THE LAST YEAR IN STEARNS COUNTY TO FILL TWO LAKES THE SIZE OF CLEARWATER LAKE, WRIGHT COUNTY IS ALSO BEING HIT HARD. THIS INFORMATION COMES RIGHT FROM DNR. WE WILL HAVE TO KEEP A CLOSE EYE ON THIS AND CONTINUE OUR FIGHT TO SAVE OUR WILDLIFE.

TO THE EDITOR:

WELL IT'S TIME AGAIN; THE GAME HOGS AND FISH POACHERS ARE AT IT AGAIN.

RECENTLY ON MY FIRST SUNFISH TRIP TO WRIGHT COUNTY, WEST OF MPLS, I STRUCK UP A TALK WITH A FELLOW FISHERMAN, A 7 YEAR OLD BOY WHO LIVES BY CEDAR LAKE, ALONG COUNTY ROAD 106 AND HE TOLD ME THAT TWO DAYS BEFORE A GAME HOG WAS OUT FISHING AND LANDED A 25 POUND NORTHERN RIGHT IN FRONT OF THE BOY, AND INSTEAD OF RELEASING THE NORTHERN BACK, THIS SO-CALLED SPORTSMAN KEPT IT. THIS NOT ONLY ROBBED THIS BOY OF A CHANCE TO MAYBE LAND A LUNKER LATER ON IN THE SEASON, BUT DESTROYED A PRE-SPAWN BIG FEMALE NORTHERN. FISH POACHING IN WRIGHT COUNTY IS REALLY BECOMING A PAIN IN THE NECK FOR THE SPORTSMAN WHO KEEP THE LAWS. SPEARING NORTHERNS IN STREAMS, OVER LIMITS OF CRAPPIES, LITTERING ALONG PUBLIC ACCESS, PEOPLE NOT BUYING LICENSES - THESE PROBLEMS ARE ALL OVER MINNESOTA NOW, AND WHAT WE NEED ARE HEAVIER FINES FOR THE GAME HOGS AND MORE ENFORCEMENT BY THE DNR.

KEEP UP YOUR FIGHT AGAINST THE NATURE FAKERS AND GAME HOGS WHO ARE TRYING TO TAKE EVERYTHING AWAY FROM US.

JULY 1 IS DEADLINE FOR UPGRADING
SEPTIC SYSTEMS ON CLEARWATER LAKE

ALL CLEARWATER LAKE PROPERTY OWNERS HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED BY A NEWSLETTER DISTRIBUTED BY THEIR ASSOCIATION THAT ALL INDIVIDUAL WASTE TREATMENT SYSTEMS WHICH DO NOT MEET THE NEW STANDARDS WILL BE IN VIOLATION OF COUNTY AND STATE LAWS AFTER JULY 1, 1977. THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION RECENTLY:

RESOLVED, THAT ALL PROPERTY OWNERS RESIDING ON CLEARWATER LAKE BE, AND THEY ARE HEREBY URGED TO BRING THEIR INDIVIDUAL WASTE TREATMENT SYSTEMS INTO CONFORMANCE WITH COUNTY AND WATERSHED DISTRICT REGULATIONS AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE DATE IN ORDER TO REDUCE THIS SOURCE OF POLLUTION OF THE LAKE TO AN ABSOLUTE MINIMUM.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT ALL LAKESHORE RESIDENTS BE, AND THEY ARE HEREBY URGED TO USE ONLY PHOSPHATE-FREE DETERGENTS AND TO REFRAIN FROM THE USE OF LAWN AND GARDEN FERTILIZERS ON ANY LAND FROM WHICH STORM WATER DRAINS INTO CLEARWATER LAKE.

IN ORDER TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW, OWNERS OF NON-CONFORMING SYSTEMS MUST HAVE DONE THE WORK NECESSARY TO MEET THE NEW REQUIREMENTS OR HAVE TAKEN PRELIMINARY STEPS, SUCH AS APPLYING FOR A PERMIT BY JULY 1.

55 PROPERTY OWNERS HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED BY WRIGHT COUNTY, THAT DUE TO LOW ELEVATION OF THEIR LOTS, THEY MUST INSTALL HOLDING TANKS. NOTIFICATION LETTERS WILL SOON GO OUT TO 160 MORE WHOSE SYSTEMS WILL HAVE TO BE MODIFIED, ACCORDING TO CHARLES DAVIS, WRIGHT COUNTY SANITARIAN.

YOU MAY NOT HAVE HEARD, BUT WILLIAM HANKE SR. DIED EARLIER THIS SPRING. MR. HANKE WAS A LONG TIME RESIDENT OF CEDAR LAKE. HE WILL BE GREATLY MISSED BY MANY FRIENDS OF THE CEDAR LAKE CONSERVATION CLUB. OUR SINCERE SYMPATHY IS EXTENDED TO HIS FAMILY.

YOUTHFUL MINNESOTA BOATERS WITH DREAMS OF OPERATING MOTORBOATS HAVE TWO ALTERNATIVES: HOMEWORK OR FEWER HORSES.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TODAY REMINDED YOUNGSTERS 13 THROUGH 17 YEARS OF AGE THAT A WATERCRAFT OPERATOR'S PERMIT IS REQUIRED BEFORE THEY CAN OPERATE A MOTORBOAT OF MORE THAN 24 HORSEPOWER, UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT. THOSE LESS THAN 13 MUST ALSO BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT WHILE OPERATING BOATS OVER 24 HORSEPOWER.

ALTHOUGH 24,000 PERSONS HAVE OBTAINED OPERATOR'S PERMITS SINCE THE PROGRAM WENT INTO EFFECT IN 1975, MANY MORE YOUNGSTERS SHOULD BE TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS, ACCORDING TO KIM ELVERUM, BOAT AND WATER SAFETY COORDINATOR.

PERMITS ARE OBTAINED BY TAKING A STUDY COURSE AT HOME, WHICH INCLUDES AN 84 PAGE MANUAL, WORKBOOK AND TEST. THE WORKBOOK AND TEST ARE RETURNED TO THE DNR FOR SCORING AND THOSE ACHIEVING A PASSING GRADE ARE ISSUED A PERMIT.
