

NEWS FROM YOUR FEDERATION RESPRESENTATIVES - AL JOHNSON & BOB KOHONEN

IN ONE OF THE PREVIOUS ARTICLES IN THE CEDAR LAKE NEWS, I MENTIONED THAT THERE WAS A LARGE INCREASE IN THE DRAINING OF SLOUGHS AND MARSHES IN CENTRAL AND WEST CENTRAL MINNESOTA. THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE STATE AND ESPECIALLY THE SOUTH WEST CORNER ARE VIRTUALLY ALL TILED OUT. THE TILING CONTRACTORS HAVE MOVED NORTH IN SEARCH OF NEW SALES TEPPITORY. AT THE FEDERATION MEETING IN HANOVER, I HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS THIS MATTER WITH A CONCERNED DAR OFFICIAL. HE INFORMED ME, THAT LAST SUMMER 70% OF ALL THE MARSH LAND IN STEARNS COUNTY WAS DRAINED AND THEY WERE FIGHTING TO SAVE THE LAST 30%. THIS IS AN ALARMING STATISTIC, NOT ONLY FOR WATERFOWLERS, BUT FOR ALL CONSERVATIONISTS. THE ECOLOGICAL IMPACT OF THIS HABITAT REMOVAL IS NOT ONLY CRITICAL FOR WATERFOWL. UPLAND GAME, FUR BEARERS AND MAYBE MAN HIMSELF WILL SUFFER IN THE LONG RANGE CONCLUSIVE OF THIS PROFIT MOTIVATED HOGGING OF THE LAND. I DO NOT LIKE TO DWELL ON ONE SUBJECT, BUT I THINK THIS IS A MORE IMPORTANT ISSUE AT THE PRESENT TIME THAN THE BULL HEAD COUNT ON CLEARWATER LAKE.

MARY'S BAIT SHOP AND H & H SPORT SHOP: 4LB 7 OZ W, 5 LB 7 OZ W, 7 LB 7 OZ W, 4 LB 2 OZ B, 3 LB 8 OZ B, 9 LB 2 OZ N, 11 LB 8 OZ N, AND A 6 LB 9 OZ N. THERE HAS BEEN LOTS OF OTHER NICE FISH TAKEN, INCLUDING TWO ADDITIONAL 10 LB NORTHERSN AND SEVERAL LARGE WALLEYES WHICH I HAVE PRESENT TIME, FISHING SEEMS TO BE DOWN, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CRAPPIES, WHICH ARE RUNNING BETWEEN 1/2 and 3/4 OF A LB.

TO THE WRIGHT COUNTY SPORTSMAN'S FEDERATION? I WOULD VENTURE TO SAY "NOT MANY". THROUGH THE YEARS, WITH THE EFFORTS OF PEOPLE LIKE ART WOHLER, GEORGE PLANER, AND BOB KOHNONEN WE HAVE MAINTAINED OUR CLUB AS A UNIT OF THE SPORTSMEN"S FEDERATION. WITHOUT PARTICIPATION IN THIS ORGANIZED GROUP OF CLUBS, WE STAND AS A LONE GROUP, OUT OF TOUCH WITH LOCAL AND STATE CONSERVATION ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS. BECAUSE MOST OF OUR MEMBERS DO NOT LIVE IN THIS AREA, I CAN UNDERSTAND THE OBVIOUS LACK OF INTEREST. WHILE OTHER CLUBS TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THEIR AFFILIATION WITH THE MEDERATION, CEDAR LAKE CLUB STANDS BY WITH APPARENTLY NO INTEREST WHAT SO STEED.

THE BUFFALO CLUB TOOK A SPECIAL INTERESIT IN A WATERFOUL AREA, AND WITHIN A WEEKS TIME, THEY HAD THIS AREA DESIGNATED A DUCK LAKE. THIS

GIVES THE DNR MORE THOUGHT, TO PROTECT AND SAVE THIS BODY OF WATER. WITHOUT FEDERATION MEMBERSHIP AND THE OUTSPOKEN VOICE OF A LARGE NUMBER OF CLUBS, THIS MAY NEVER OF HAPPENED. IN OTHER WORDS, THERE IS POWER IN NUMBERS.

MINTESOTA LEADS NATION IN NUMBER OF LAKES

ACCORDING TO A SURVEY CONDUCTED BY JOHN B MOYLE, RESEARCH COORDINATOR FOR THE MINNESOTA DIVISION OF GAME AND FISH, AND REPORTED BY HIM IN NATURAL LAKES OF THE UNITED STATES, SPECIAL PUBLICATION NUMBER 51, MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION, THERE ARE A TOTAL OF 69,938 NATURAL LAKES LARGER THAN 10 ACRES IN THE UNITED STATES AND PUERTO RICO. TOGETHER THESE LAKES HAVE A TOTAL AREA OF 21,032,059 ACRES (MEAN SIZE 301 ACRES). THE AREA OF THESE LAKES IS EQUAL TO 0.88% OF THE ENTIRE LAND AREA OF THE UNITED STATES. OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF LAKES, 80.1% ARE REPORTED AS BEING WATERS THAT REGULARLY SUPPLY SPORT FISHING.

MINNESOTA REPORTED THE LARGEST TOTAL NUMBER OF LAKES -- 12,034, COVERING 3,000,000 ACRES--FOLLOWED BY ALASKA (11,840) AND WASHINGTON (7,864). MINTESOTA RANKED THIRD IN TOTAL NUMBER OF FISHING LAKES (5,000)-- BEHIND ALASKA (10,440) AND FLORIDA (7,272).

FOUR STATES--DELAWARE, MARYLAND WEST VIRGINIA, AND KENTUCKY -- REPORTED HAVING NO NATURAL LAKES.
