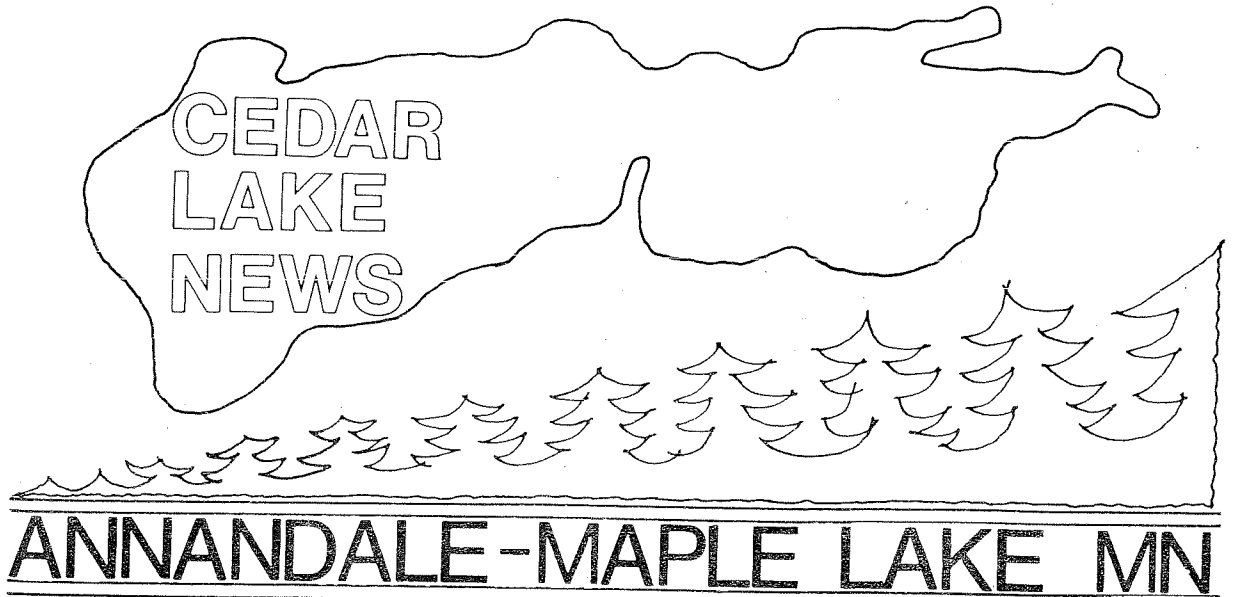

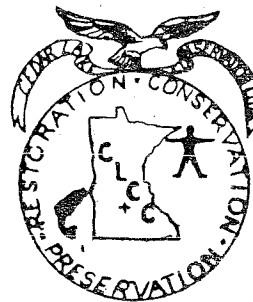

THERE ARE TWO KINDS OF FISHERMAN: THOSE WHO FISH FOR THE SPORT OF IT, AND THOSE WHO CATCH SOMETHING.

WHO GETS A FREE FISHING LICENSE? ? ? ? ? ?

ARE YOU ENTITLED TO A FREE FISHING LICENSE?

COULD BE, ACCORDING TO BOB WELLS, LICENSE SUPERVISOR FOR THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

WELLS SAID THE DEPARTMENT IS RECEIVING NUMEROUS CALLS THESE DAYS FROM PERSONS WHO HAVE HEARD THEY MAY BE ABLE TO OBTAIN A FISHING LICENSE WITHOUT COST OR AT A REDUCED RATE.

THESE ARE THE FACTS, HE SAID:

1) RESIDENTS OF MINNESOTA UNDER THE AGE OF 16 ARE NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE AN ANGLING, SPEARING OR NETTING LICENSE.

2) A CITIZEN OF MINNESOTA RECEIVING SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME FOR THE AGED, BLIND OR DISABLED WILL BE ISSUED A FISHING LICENSE WITHOUT CHARGE.

3) MINNESOTA RESIDENTS SERVING IN U.S. MILITARY OR NAVAL FORCES OR RESERVES, STATIONED OUTSIDE THE STATE, MAY FISH WITHOUT A LICENSE WHEN IN MINNESOTA ON LEAVE PROVIDED THEY HAVE THEIR LEAVE OR FURLOUGH PAPERS ON THEIR PERSON.

4) A PERMAENT LICENSE TO TAKE FISH WILL BE ISSUED AT THE PREVAILING FEE TO ANY CITIZEN OF MINNESOTA 16 YEARS OR OLDER WHOSE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN FURNISHED PROOF OF MENTALLY RETARDED DISABILITY TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR OR LICENSE AGENT. A PERMANENT LICENSE IS VALID FOR THE LIFE OF THE HOLDER.

5) A PERMANENT LICENSE TO TAKE FISH WILL BE ISSUED TO MINNESOTA VETERANS HAVING A 100 PERCENT SERVICE CONNECTED DISABILITY.

6) RESIDENTS OF MINNESOTA WHO HAVE ATTAINED THE AGE OF 65 MAY TAKE FISH BY ANGLING OR SPEARING WITHOUT A LICENSE, BUT MUST CARRY PROOF OF AGE AND RESIDENCE ON THEIR PERSON.

7) RESIDENTS RECEIVING AID UNDER THE RAILROAD RETIREMENT ACT OF 1937 OR WHO ARE FORMER EMPLOYEES OF THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE AND RECEIVING DISABILITY PAY MAY TAKE FISH BY ANGLING OR SPEARING WITHOUT A LICENSE.

8) PATIENTS OF A U.S. VETERANS ADMINISTRATION HOSPITAL MAY FISH WITHOUT A LICENSE SO LONG AS THEY ARE PATIENTS.

(WHO GETS A FREE FISHING LICENSE? CON'T)

9) PATIENTS OR INMATES OF A STATE MENTAL OR CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION MAY FISH WITHOUT A LICENSE SUBJECT TO THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE INSTITUTION.

WELLS ADDED THAT INFORMATION ON FREE FISHING LICENSES OR PERMANENT LICENSES IS FOUND ON PAGE 3 OF THE 1978 FISHING REGULATIONS, OBTAINABLE AT LICENSE AGENTS, COUNTY AUDITORS AND DNR OFFICES.

YOUNG WILDLIFE SHOULD BE LEFT IN THE WILD

PEOPLE WHO PICK UP YOUNG WILD ANIMALS ARE IN MOST CASES REDUCING THE ANIMALS' CHANCES FOR SURVIVAL IN THE WILD AND ARE IN VIOLATION OF STATE REGULATIONS, ACCORDING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

EVERY SPRING DNR OFFICES ARE FLOODED WITH CALLS FROM PEOPLE WHO HAVE PICKED UP YOUNG WILD BIRDS AND ANIMALS. MOST CALLERS ARE CONVINCED THAT THE YOUNG HAVE BEEN ABANDONED BY THEIR MOTHERS OR THAT THEY WILL MAKE GOOD PETS.

WILDLIFE OFFICIALS SAID THAT THESE PEOPLE ARE OFTEN WRONG ON BOTH COUNTS. WILD ANIMALS ARE RARELY ABANDONED BY THEIR MOTHERS, AND SELDOM MAKE GOOD PETS.

FINDING A YOUNG WILD CREATURE ALONE IN FIELD OR FOREST DOES NOT NECESSARILY MEAN IT HAS BEEN ABANDONED, SAY WILDLIFE SPECIALISTS. THE MOTHER MAY BE NEARBY WAITING FOR PEOPLE TO LEAVE SO THAT SHE MAY RETURN TO TAKE CARE OF HER OFFSPRING.

FOR SOME YOUNG WILD ANIMALS, GETTING PICKED UP BY HUMANS WHO KNOW LITTLE ABOUT THEIR SPECIALIZED REQUIREMENTS MEANS AN EARLY AGONIZING DEATH.

LESS SPECIALIZED ANIMALS, WHICH LIVE IN SPITE OF THEIR CAPTIVE CARE, MAY GROW FROM THE CUTE AND CUDDLY STAGE TO BE NUISANCES -- VICIOUS AND EVEN DANGEROUS TO THEIR CAPTORS.

UNFORTUNATELY, THE SLIGHT TAMENESS AND DEPENDANCE ON HUMANS LEARNED IN CAPTIVITY ALMOST PRECLUDES THEIR SUCCESSFUL RETURN TO THE WILD.

DO WILDLIFE A BIG FAVOR, SAID OFFICIALS. REMEMBER THAT YOUNG WILD ANIMALS SHOULD BE LEFT IN THE WILD AND SHOULD NOT BE PICKED UP BY PEOPLE.

ENFORCEMENT DIRECTOR EARL LHOTKA POINTS OUT THAT POSSESSION OF PROTECTED WILDLIFE SPECIES OUT OF SEASON IS A MISDEMEANOR AND PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF UP TO \$500.

RHUBARB JAM OR CONSERVE.....

- 5 CUPS RHUBARB
- 3 CUPS SUGAR
- 1 LB. CANDY ORANGE SLICES (CUT UP)
- 1 CUP MARASCHINO CHERRIES (CUT UP)
- 1 SMALL CAN CRUSHED PINEAPPLE

CUT UP RHUBARB AND POUR OVER SUGAR. LET STAND OVER NIGHT. IN THE MORNING, BOIL TOGETHER FOR 15 MINUTES. ADD THE CANDY ORANGE SLICES, MARASCHINO CHERRIES AND CRUSHED PINEAPPLE. BOIL 15 MINUTES, STIRRING CONSTANTLY. PUT IN STERILIZED JARS.
