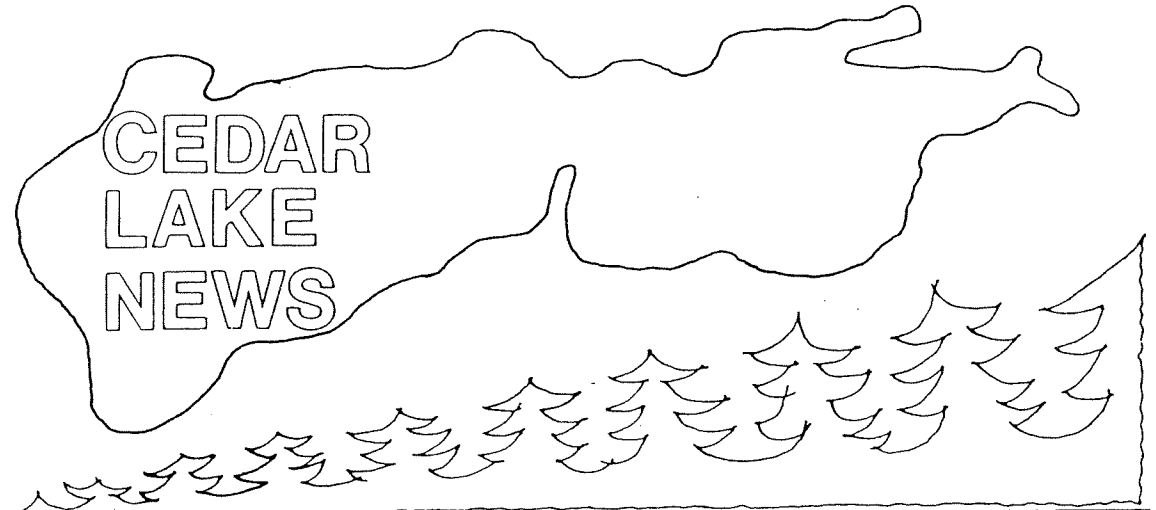

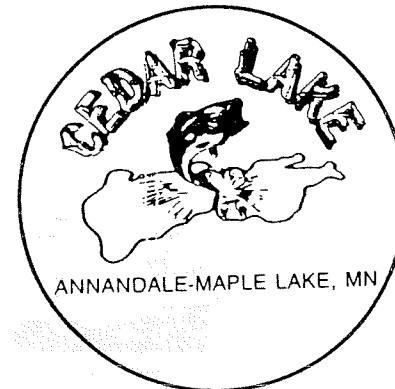


On behalf of the Turn In Poachers Board of Director's, we wish to express our appreciation for your support. We are honored to have you as a member of TIP.

During the last nine years, since TIP's inception, we have grown to an organization with a membership of over 20,000. We have paid out rewards totalling over \$199,000 and only 40% of people turning in poachers want a reward. The total number of arrests in the last nine years totals 3,131. Our conviction rate in 1990 on arrests was 99%. These are figures you can be proud of! 

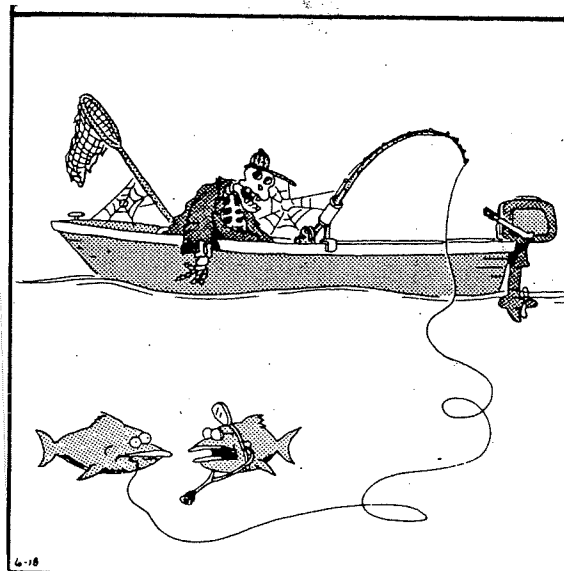

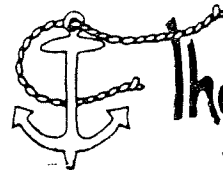

MINNESOTA SONGBIRDS IN DECLINE Part 3 of 8

Black-throated Green Warbler

Among the most colorful and distinctive of Minnesota's woodland songbirds is the black-throated green warbler. It is one of the most common warblers in balsam fir and spruce forests in northeast Minnesota.

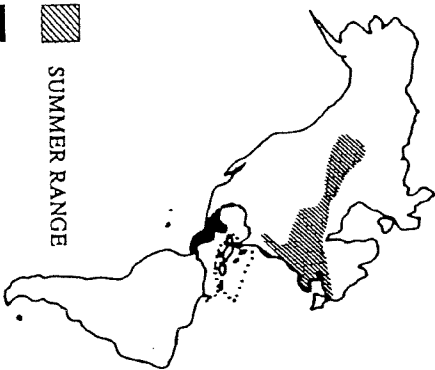
This warbler winters in forested highlands from southern Mexico south to Panama in Central America.

John R. Sauer and Sam Droegge of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service have reported that black-throated green warbler numbers have declined 3.2 percent per year during the ten year period from 1978 to 1988.

The reason for the decline of the black-throated green warbler is unclear. Donations to the Nongame Wildlife Fund on Minnesota tax forms can help biologists with the Department of Natural Resources to study our forest songbirds so we can learn how to improve our management of their habitat and prevent further population declines.
