How To Legally Transport Fish



- Fish must be packaged so they can be easily unwrapped, separated, identified, and counted.
- Fillets must have a 1-inch-square patch of skin with scales intact from a portion of the body other than the belly.
- One of the easiest ways to transport fish so they can be counted and identified is in clear plastic freezer bags.

MINNESOTA SONGBIRDS IN DECLINE Part 5 of 8

Bay-breasted Warbler

The bay breasted warbler is a distinctively marked bird found in forests of spruce and fir in far northern Minnesota.

This species has richly-colored chestnut markings on its head, throat and sides. It can become extremely abundant during outbreaks of spruce budworms because budworm caterpillars are one of their preferred foods.

There may be as many as three pairs of bay-breasted warblers nesting per acre during budworm outbreaks.

Bay-breasted warblers winter primarily in mature lowland tropical rainforests from Costa Rica to Panama, northwestern Colombia, and extreme western Venezuela.

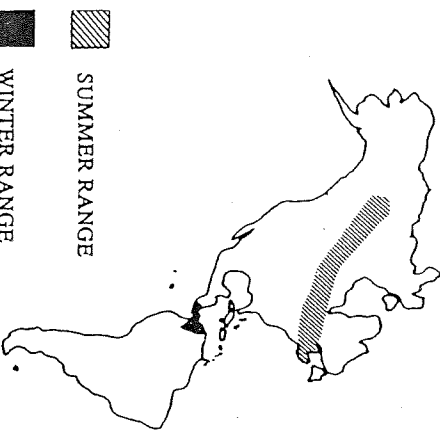
John R. Sauer and Sam Droege of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service have reported that bay-breasted warbler numbers have declined a dramatic 12.1 percent per year during the ten year period from 1978 to 1988.

Although populations of this bird normally fluctuate in response to spruce-budworm outbreaks, this 10-year decline is unexplained.

Donations to the Department of Natural Resource's Nongame Wildlife Program on Minnesota tax forms can help biologists learn more about declining songbirds like the bay-breasted warbler. Checkoff donations can be used to help identify the survival problems of declining species and determine what habitat management strategies can help prevent further declines.
