Hello, I'm the new editor of the Cedar Lake Newsletter. This is going to be a big jab to fill the shoes of Shirley Cook, our former editor.


I will need your help! I need news items, cartoons, quips, etc. Also, if you have something for sale, send me a note. Our next newsletter should be in the Spring.

Dear Member,

On behalf of the Turn In Poachers Board Of Director's, I wish to express our gratitude and appreciation for your support. We are honored to have you as a member of TIP.

Since TIP's inception in 1981, we have grown to be an organization of over 20,000 concerned conservationists. We have paid out rewards totalling \$245,000.00 and only 40% of peopie reporting poaching violations request a reward. The total number of arrests in the last twelve years was over 4,100. Our conviction rate in 1993 was 99%. These are figures you can be proud of! Poaching is a nationwide problem, we have a long way to go, but we in Minnesota have made an impact, thanks to YOU!

The public support throughout Minnesota, the widespread knowledge and growing acceptance of our objectives, and the enthusiastic endorsement by our statewide conservation organizations, have all been most gratifying. The overwhelming support of the TIP-sponsored Restitution Law demonstrates your desire to provide additional protection to our priceless wildlife and fisheries, from criminals who scorn our state laws. Between January 1991 and February 1994, \$220,000 has been raised from restitution penalties. This money goes to the DNR game and fish fund for replacement, propagation and protection of "wild animals." Finally, criminals are paying to replace what they took illegally.

Again, our heartfelt thanks for your contribution and positive support of the Minnesota TIP program.

LEGISLATION ON PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES

At the next session of the Minnesota Legislature, the DNR will ask to amend the rules on personal flotation devices, (PFD's) to comply with Federal regulations which have already been adopted by our five neighboring states.

This change does not require the wearing of Pfd's (life jackets) but requires them to be on board and readily accessible.

Boats less than 16 feet in length, canoes and kayaks regardless of length, will need to have a Type I, II or III wearable PFD for each person on board. Type IV cushions will no longer be acceptable as a primary lifesaving device.

Boats 16 feet or more in length (except canoes and kayaks) need to have a I, II or III wearable PFD for each person on board plus one Type IV throwable cushion or ring buoy for each craft.

At this time it apprears that the effective date of Minnesota's rules on PFD's will probably be May 1, 1995.


