DNR urges new approach to lakeshore landscaping

Manicured bluegrass to the water's edge and a sandy swimming beach seem ideal to many lakeshore owners, but this landscape has liabilities. The grass requires constant mowing and treatment with fertilizers and herbicides that wash into the lake. Geese and ducks are attracted to the short grass and sandy shore where they graze, or loaf and defecate until the area is unfit for human use.

Nongame Wildlife Supervisor Carrol Henderson has a better idea. It's called lakescaping for wildlife, a landscape design that saves labor, reduces the need for fertilizer, and uses native plants to create beauty while accommodating the diverse needs of people and wildlife. Call Henderson at (612) 296-0700 for a story about lakescaping.

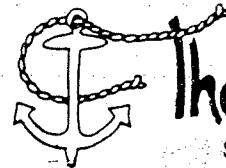

MINNESOTA SONGBIRDS IN DECLINE Part 7 of 8

Northern Oriole

One of the most beautiful and popular songbirds in Minnesota is the northern oriole. Their bright orange bodies, black wings, and black heads make them quite distinctive in a backyard setting. They readily come to large nectar feeders, orange halves, and grape jelly feeders that people place for them. They are characteristic of our hardwood forests and woodlots throughout all of Minnesota except the arrowhead region of the northeast.

Northern orioles winter from the southern half of Mexico through Central America and northern Columbia.

John R. Sauer and Sam Droegge of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service have reported that national breeding bird surveys have shown an average decline of 2.2 per cent per year for northern oriole populations from 1978 through 1988.

The reason for the decline is unknown. It could be related to the use of pesticides on their insect prey, habitat loss, nest parasitism by cowbirds, or loss of wintering habitat.

The Nongame Wildlife Program is dedicated to helping preserve and manage our nongame wildlife populations. However, donations on the Minnesota state tax forms are needed to carry out the research that is necessary to identify both their survival problems and management strategies for helping them.
