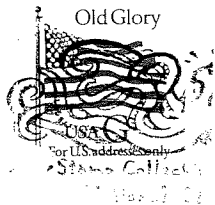
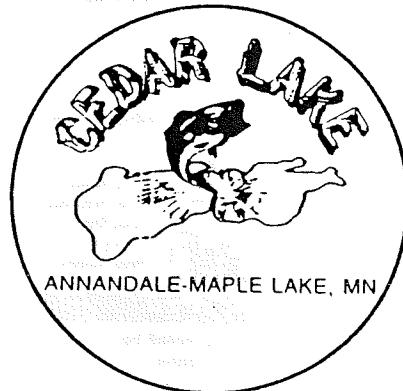

New Regulations For On-Site Septic Systems

Two new laws concerning on-site septic systems have recently been enacted. The Sewer System Disclosure law, is a mandate from the State of Minnesota and took effect August 31, 1994. Basically, this law requires that a seller must disclose in writing to the buyer information about the status and location of individual sewage treatment systems on the property or serving the property. This disclosure must be done prior to the signing of agreements for the sale or transfer of real property. Unless the buyer & seller agree otherwise in writing, a seller who fails to disclose the existence or known status of an individual sewage treatment system at the time of sale, and who knew or had reason to know of the existence or known status of the system, may be liable to the buyer for costs relating to bringing the system into compliance. Such liability will exist for two years from the date on which the property was closed. While this legislation does not mandate that sewer systems be conforming at the time of sale or transfer, it does require the seller of a property to disclose known information about the sewer system's location and status, thereby raising the issue of system compliance.

The other law passed concerning on-site septic systems comes from a new County ordinance, The Point of Sale Certification Ordinance For On-Site Septic Systems. This was passed by the County Board in January of this year and will take effect county-wide beginning August 1, 1995. This law requires that upon the transfer or sale of all properties which have or are required to have an on-site septic treatment system, those systems be certified, upgraded or installed on or prior to the date of closing. The intent of this new law is to protect both water quality and the buyers of real property in Wright County by mandating sewer system compliance at the time of a change in ownership.

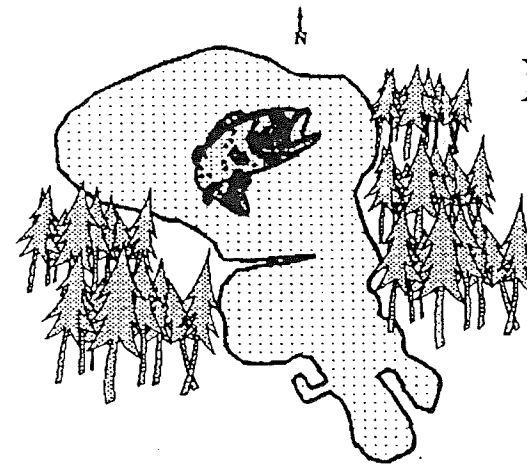

You may enter walleye, northern, bass, crappie, sunfish and bullhead. Prizes for 1st and second place in each category.

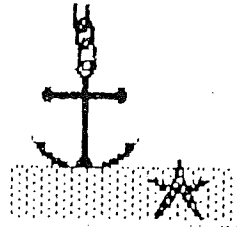

PERSONAL FLOATATION DEVICES MUST BE VISIBLE IN YOUR BOAT!

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 1995 Minnesota boat owners must comply with Federal Regulations which requires personal floatation devices (Pfd's) to be visible. This means on the floor or seat or bench. You cannot have PFD's in the storage box under the seats. They cannot be wrapped or stored in a plastic bag. **They must be readily accessible!**

Boats less than 16 feet in length, canoes and kayaks regardless of length, will need to have **wearable PFD's** for each person on board. Cushions will no longer be acceptable as a primary lifesaving device

Boats 16 feet or more in length (except canoes and kayaks) need to have a wearable PFD for each person on board plus one throwable or buoy for each craft.

THE SHERIFF'S water patrol and the Department of Natural Resources will be spot checking boats to see that they comply.

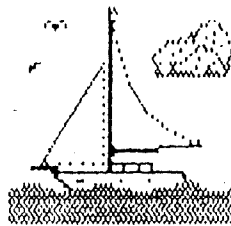

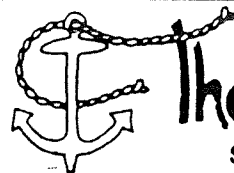

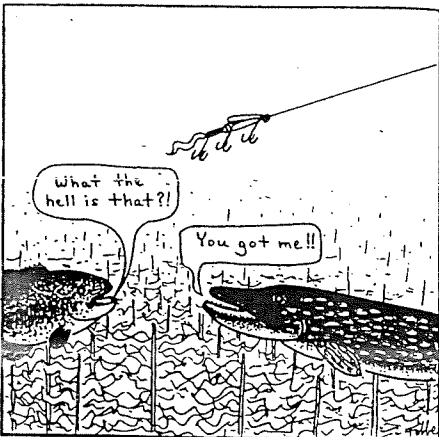
