

ATTENTION: MILFOIL SEARCH ON CEDAR LAKE, June 8.


Don Badger and Jerry Bowdin, Coordinators will need volunteers to help the annual search for milfoil. You may call them if you would like to help or see them at the Annual Pot Luck Party on Friday, June 7.

Below is some information regarding Eurasian water milfoil. Please read it and memorize the differences. We must be aware that this weed is still a threat to our lake.

What Does it look like?

Eurasian water milfoil may be identified by:

- long stems with feather-like leaves attached in whorls of four;
- · leaves typically having nine to 21 pairs of leaflets;
- flowers appearing terminally on the stem above the water;
- · formation of mats at the surface.

Confusing Look-alikes

Northern water milfoil (Myriophyllum exalbescens) is very similar in appearance, but typically has seven pairs of leaflets and a maximum of 11 pairs.




Leaf whorl arrangement

Coontail (Ceratophyllum demersum) is also often mistaken for Eurasian water milfoil, but coontail doesn't have individual leaflets.



REMEMBER! (PFD) Personal Flotation Devices, Life Jackets must be on board and **readily accessible.** You will receive a warning, however, next year you will receive a citation from the water patrol if you have not complied with the new law.

This Federal regulation is now law and we all must have wearable PFD's for each person on board. Cushions will no longer be acceptable as a primary lifesaving levise. You should have a throwable cushion or ring buoy for each craft.
