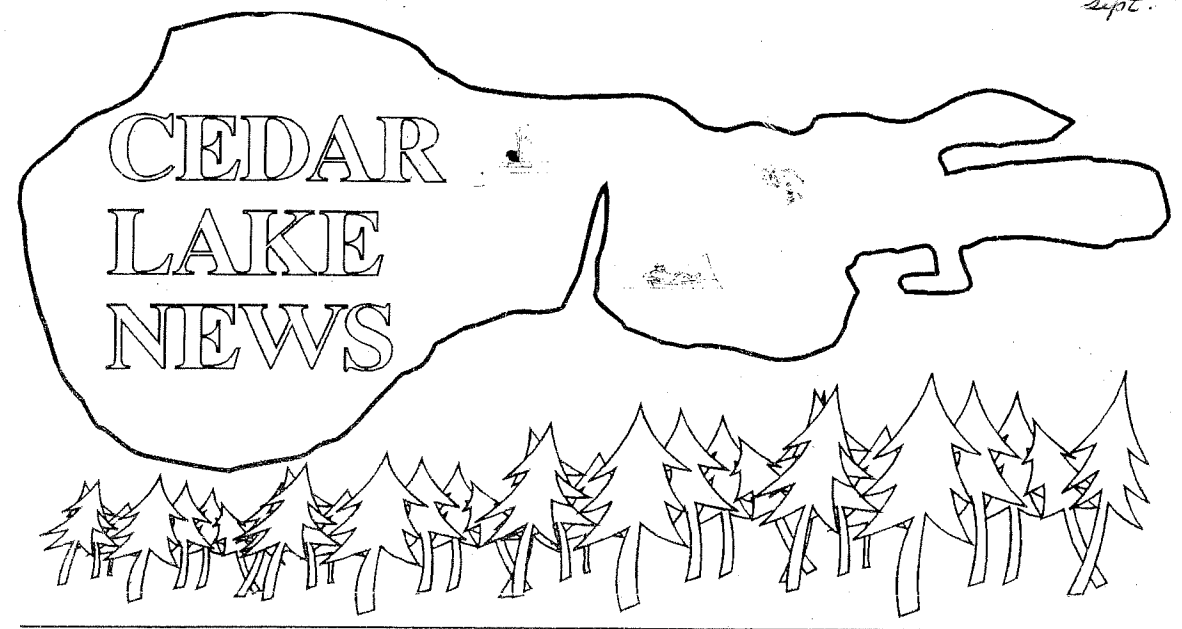

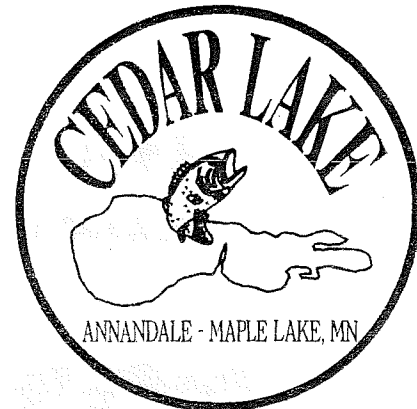
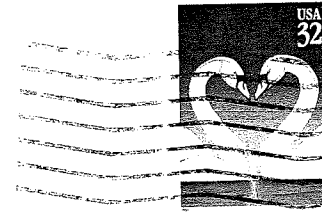

Recommended amendments:

Article IV Sec. 9

Signatures of either the Treasurer or President will be required on all checks.

Article VI Sec. 2

The Board of Directors shall consist of not more than twelve members, elected annually by the voting members at the annual meeting. Three new Board Members shall be elected each year and will serve for a term of 4 years. No director may be re-elected to the board until having been off the board for at least one year, unless appointed by the board, except in the case of the president who must serve on the board one full year after completing his/her term as president.

Article VII Sec. 4

Nominations will be accepted in writing for board members no later than 2 weeks prior to the annual meeting.

The recommendations will be presented to the entire membership at the Spring 98 meeting.

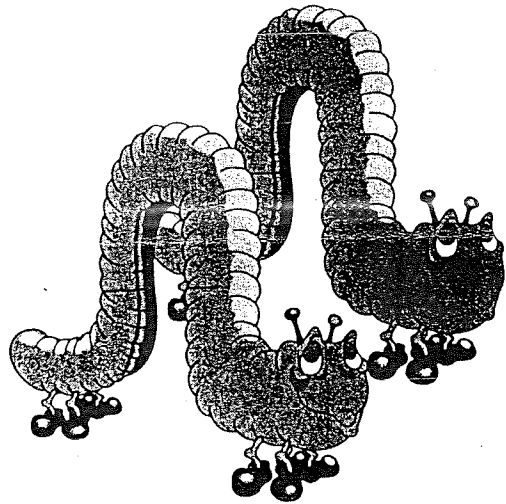
