





Secretary Report: It was moved to approve the minutes of the last annual meeting as printed in the newsletter. Motion was seconded and carried.

At our Annual Dinner Meeting, the membership voted on the following amendments to our by-Laws

#### AMENDED BY-LAWS OF THE CEDAR LAKE CONSERVATION CLUB

#### Article IV Sec. 9

The Treasurer shall have custody of the funds of the organization. He shall prepare and sign checks as authorized by the Board of Directors or the president. Both signatures of the President and Treasurer will be required on all checks.

#### AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE IV SEC. 9

Signatures of either the Treasurer or President will be required on all checks. \* \* \* \* \*

#### Article TV Sec. 2

Consecutive terms of officers shall be limited to two terms per person for any one position. At least one intervening term shall elapse before that person may again be elected to that office, unless the Board of Directors by three-fourths vote of the total Board waives these conditions.

#### AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE IV SEC. 2

The Board of Directors shall consist of not more than twelve members elected annually by the voting members at the annual meeting. Three new Board Members shall be elected each year and will serve for a term of 4 years. No Director may be re-elected to the board until having been off the board for at least one year, unless appointed by the board. Except in the case of the President who must serve on the Board one full year after completing his/her term as President.

### Article VII Sec. 4

Additional nominations may be made from the floor ar the annual meeting.

#### AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE VII SEC. 4

Nominations will be accepted in writing for Board members no later than 2 weeks prior to the annual meeting.
